

Dear Family and Friends

This will be my last Newsletter in this format as Tom Roach has persuaded me to upgrade my Annual Newsletter to a Quarterly and combine it with the Whitlock Gleanings Newsletter. Tom has been very involved with a Newsletter for the State of Tennessee and two other Family Newsletters so approached me in January to see if I would be willing to take over. Well....you live once!

From the Family Newsletters I have seen over the years I feel there are three essential ingredients. Firstly they must contain information that relates to "my" family. Secondly they should have articles of general interest to "my family" and lastly they should contribute to preservation of "our family's" history as a whole. The first two points are largely related to your participation so I am hoping for lots of input from you. Written articles are always hard to come by so in most cases just photocopies of Family Bibles, documents, photographs etc. will enable me to put together something on your family. The more I receive the more will show up in the Newsletter and the wider the network of research on your section of family will be. The third item I feel will come from the files I have built up since taking up this research in 1968. Other than the basic source notes and documents the files contain chronological indexes of Births, Marriages and Deaths (about 10,000 entries). My first aim has been to print the Marriage Index as a tool for all researchers. As they are done the pages of this index will be included as a pull-out in the Newsletter and will eventually build up to be a book.

Another feature that can be built up into a research book is borrowed from the Penn Pals Newsletter. Main Lines - lists of direct lines that can be photocopied and sorted by area and family. I also plan to continue the idea of printing the "Additions" lists as it allows you to pick out items of interest and request copies as well as enabling me to thank those who have contributed to the files.

Unfortunately I cannot afford to do all this without charging a subscription and based on the current costs of printing and postage I have decided to use a single rate of \$6.00 per annum. Subscriptions will be on a calendar year basis, renewable every January.

This Newsletter is your family's so please support it with your subscription as well as your ideas and contributions of material.

This year...the influx of information about the Whitlocks of Australia due to the efforts of Margaret Cohoe and Adrienne Campbell has been terrific. Hopefully I have been able to help a few of you. I have added quite a few more families to the computer files which enables me to make copies easily and to update each family as new information is received. A list is enclosed with this Newsletter. The "Additions" lists this year are as long as ever with some terrific items coming in this year. As usual there was a gem from Jean Cole in the Marriage Agreement of Elston Whitlocke 1700. The 226 pages of research from Pearl Olson via Richard Price is actually the 1981-1984 additions that I had not had a chance to even look at until I had catalogued the first 557 pages received in 1981. This year saw the completion of the 557 pages as well as the 226 pages so all that terrific material is now cross-referenced in the files - the hundreds of English and American wills included this collection are an invaluable research tool to a wide section of the family. Our debt to Pearl for sharing this information is enormous as the amount of duplicate research that can be prevented by a prior search of our files is now substantial. I have just finished cataloguing the St.Catherine's House Marriages 1871-1883 contributed by Janis Kirby of London, Ontario. Janis took up my offer to anyone with access to the St.Catherine's House records, either personally or on microfilm, to add another five years to our files. Our thanks to Janis for what I know is a very boring job but adds a bit more of a terrific source to our files. We now have Births 1837-1870 and Marriages 1837-1883 - anyone willing to do a five year period please let me know. The American files continue to grow with quite a bit more Loyalist information from Jerry Gower and Cuma Schofield and a terrific collection of American Census extracts from Charles Whitlock Rockett.

One thing I did do this year was hold an Open House in July. Only one family came but

hopefully I sparked a little interest in the family through the contact I made with the local Whitlock and Whitelocks letting people know about the event. Cuma Schofield and Pam Hallock visited during the summer and hopefully found it interesting going through the files. I realize it is not much help to those of you half a world away but the files are open to anyone so feel free to visit if you are passing through Vancouver. I am sure some of you will be tempted to attend the World's Fair in Vancouver in 1986. Maybe the chance to have a good snoop through the Whitlock files might help you make the decision to attend.

It has been a very busy year as usual but for the first time in ten years I had the cataloguing up to date. For about a week I had time to sort out a few things on the computer before packages arrived from Cuma Schofield and Pam Hallock both on the same day. Hopefully things have gone well with each of your families and each of your research efforts. My thanks to all who contributed to the files and shared their efforts with us all. I have great hopes for 1985 and the new Newsletter format and hope you will all support it.

I hope you all have a Merry Christmas and Best Wishes for a Happy New Year.
