

REUNION 1990

Planning a trip to Britain in 1990? Plan to include the Whitlock Family Reunion at Plymouth, Devon in your itinerary. We are looking at the end of July, beginning of August 1990. Location, Plymouth and area. Proposed itinerary:

Day 1: 12:00 to 4:00 Buffet lunch and get together. Review of display material. Optional rivertrip up the Tamar, past the Dockyards and warships as far as Calstock in Cornwall. Refreshments served on board.

Day 2: Coach trip to Exeter Record Office. Afternoon free to tour Exeter, the Cathedral, Museums, shops etc.

Day 3: Coach tour of Whitlock areas of Devon, Langtree, Frithelstock, Warkleigh etc. Jim and I will provide a running commentary giving the background of the places visited. Tour will be whole day with pre-arranged stops for meals.

Day 4: Coach tour of places of interest in Cornwall, St. Austell, Stratton etc. arriving back in Plymouth by 6:00pm Guided again by Jim and I and meals provided.

Day 5: Free day to sightsee in Plymouth area. Farewell dinner in evening and optional tickets to a summer variety Theatre production.

So far the costs are working out at 60-80 pounds (\$140-\$160). Plymouth has plenty of quality accomodation and we can arrange for a block of rooms if required. Plans will evolve over the next few months and we will provide further details in the September issue. Ideas and suggestions greatly received.
