

# DIARY OF RICHARD ELLIS, 1870

The above diary contains several references to members of the Whitlock family including following one sent in by Douglas L. Whitlock. Reverend Allen Whitlock (1823-1875) was the son of John and Keturah (Quine) Whitlock.

June 19, 1870

Sabbath. Went to Church today and heard Allen Whitlock preach. Liked him very much. Mamey McMeen is in my class and I'm sorry because Dock and Ann dislike me and think I couldn't teach anything. My experience with him as a physician taking care of Lucy does not speak well for him either. He never graduated from school and never looks at a book. He and Ann were the only two who objected to our marriage. But Ann is dear Lucy's sister and I must not allow hate in my heart.
