

KENTUCKY LAND GRANTS & WARRANTS

The following detail was sent in by Arvilla Heard Corey and was extracted from a publication by Jellison. I have also added some addition detail from the material sent in by Pearl Olsen (R78/540). The two sources may have been the same. All the Grantees are Whitlocks so only first names are used.

It is not clear what the numbers in the third column relate to, possibly the number of acres involved. Land documents often are very useful in connecting different parts of families together. In the above list we know that Thomas, Wm. R. and Benjn. R. who all had land on Greasy Creek were a father and his two sons. We also know the Chas. and Wm. with land in Adair County were brothers. It will be interesting to determine if other relationships can be established. We do not have copies of any of the original documents so they may also give additional information.
