WAR OF 1812

A good deal of the settlement of the states bordering the original thirteen colonies followed the War of 1812 and as ex-soldiers were often given preference for this new land it is useful to know if your ancestors served. The following is a list compiled from the material that has been sent in to the Whitlock Family Association files. It is by no means complete but hopefully will lead to additional information. It is not clear how much personal information can be obtained if you have a name and regiment number but there are certainly muster rolls available and in one case the date of death was recorded in the pay files. All names were Whitlock so only first name is used:
