WHITLOCK/BOOTH(BOOTHE). Need proof of parentage of Winfrey Whitlock, Sr. b.8/1763 King William Co., Va. d.3/7/1839 Edgefield Dist., SC mc1789 Elizabeth Booth b.4/1772 Goochland Co., Va d.7/21/1860 Edgefield Dist., SC Winfrey Whitlock, Sr. was on the 1790 census in Edgefield Dist., SC Undocumented information from unknown original source gives Winfrey Whitlock's father was William Whitlock d.1808 Edgefield Dist., SC m. 4/22/1760 in Goochland Co., VA to Sarah Jordan d.1789 as parents of Winfrey Whitlock. Additional wife of William given as Penelope (possible maiden name Robinson - Allen/Allan Robinson possible relative). Need proof of this parent-child connection and of Virginia names, dates and places.

BOOTH/BOOTHE/WHITLOCK. Wish to correspond with anyone researching Booth(e)s in Virginia prior to 1800. Elizabeth Booth (dau. of James Booth) b.4/1772 Goochland Co., Va d.7.21/1860 Edgefield Dist., SC mc 1789 (ch.b.1791) in Edgefield Dist., SC Winfrey Whitlock. James Booth in Edgefield Dist., SC by 1788 was a neighbour on 1790 Edgefield Dist., SC census to Winfrey Whitlock. Undocumented information from unknown source gives James Booth b. 1752 Louisa Co., Va d.7/15/1822 Edgefield Dist. SC m.? to Sarah ?? Aaron Boothe (father of James) d.1792 m.? to Ruth Elizabeth. Need proof of Virginia names, dates and places.

The *Whitlock Family Association* files show the following:

Penelope was the eight child of Robert Robinson of Edgefield Co., SC who died about 1802. There is record of the administration of his estate on file at Edgefield County. Penelope is shown as the wife of William Whitlock of Madison, Florida. Allen Robinson the second child of Robert Robinson is shown married to Miss Chapman of Baldwin Co., Georgia. Allen died in Morgan Co. (will there) Other children are Richard Robinson of Alabama, Isham Robinson, married Mary Wilson; died 1824 Edgefield Co., Elisha Robinson died Edgefield Co. (will recorded), Thomas Robinson, married Sally Lewis, Butts Co., Georgia, Randall Robinson, married first Lydia Walker, second, Phereby Hill, Frances Robinson, died unmarried. Adminstration of William Whitlock's estate granted Aug.14,1808 at Edgefield District to Penelope Whitlock. Also bound with Penelope are Samuel Crafton and Allen Robinson. Inventory of estate sold Oct.6,1809 shows purchasers, Penelope Whitlock, Harrison Monday, Allan Robinson, John Delaughter, Henry Briggs and Penny Whitlock. Most items were purchased by Penelope Whitlock, sale proceeds totalled \$1932.27 Source:(REF1089)
