

# TEXAS PENSION APPLICATION

Robert Whitlock, Liberty Co., Oct. 1870, approved. Age 71 in 1883. In Sep 1835 until Jan 1836 he served in Capt. Briscoe's company. In Mar 1836 he enlisted in Capt. Wm. M. Logan's company of the 2nd Regt. of Col. Sherman and was on detail during the battle of San Jacinto.

Franklin Hardin and Cornelius Devore, Liberty Co., affirmed service. L. C. Chambers and J.N. Dark affirmed affidavit. Whitlock was still living in Liberty Co. in May 1883. A letter to the Comptroller dated Jan 1878 concerning W. Whitlock's pension said that he had been nearly blind for 6 or 7 years and was unable to work and had lost his wife in September 1868.
