

JOHN WHITLOCK & HANNAH BURKETT OF VA

Know all men by these presents, that we, John Whitlock and James Kinney are held and firmly bound into Thomas W..or M...Randolph Governor of Virginia and his successors, for the use of the Commonwealth, in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars; to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 13th day of August, A.D.1821.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas a marriage is shortly intended to be solemnized between the above bound John Whitlock bachaelor and Hannah Burkett spinster of Augusta County; it therefore, shall be no lawful cause to obstruct the said marriage, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue,
