

WHITLOCK FAMILY NEWSLETTER

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Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II is a Whitlock descendant!! You can imagine my surprise when I received an email from Chuck Rockett advising me of this connection. The email showed a listing by professional genealogist, Will Johnson, that connected me to the website of Leo van de Pas. Will Johnson has been working for years tracing the mediaeval ancestors of Princes William & Harry and adding them to Leo's site. Leo quotes Gerald Paget's 1977 book *The Lineage and Ancestry of H.R.H. Prince Charles, Prince of Wales* where the Queen Mother's ancestors are traced back through the Bowes-Lyon and Cavendish-Bentinck families to the Wellesley family and from there through the Hill family to the Mostyn family that are descendants of Sir James Whitlock's eldest daughter Elizabeth Whitlock born 1603 who married Sir Thomas Mostyn. I will put together more detailed information on this connection for the September issue of the Newsletter.

Strangely I also found on Leo's website that my own family is also connected to the Queen Mother's through the Pakenham family. My great-uncle Frederick Cour-Barron who married my Grandfather's sister Charlotte Agnes Whitlock is related by marriage to the family of Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon. Frederick descends from Helen Pakenham whose sister Kitty married Arthur Wellesley, the Duke of Wellington. Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon descends from Arthur's brother Richard Wellesley.

In other news, we have now received the results from the first of the WHITLOCK02H the Whitlocks of Wokingham, Berkshire family DNA tests and the exciting news is that 36 of 37 of the markers match with those of Whitlocks of Virginia. This means that the WHITLOCK02H family and the WHITLOCK85, WHITLOCK33 and WHITLOCK25 families all match within one marker and WHITLOCK23 matches within two markers. While not proof, this is a very good indication that these families all have a common origin. In contrast the WHITLOCK01 family, the Whitlocks of Alwington, Devon only matched on 6 of the 37 markers with the Virginia line, indicating they likely have quite different origins. Unfortunately for many of these lines we only have one or two test results and will need many more before we can come to any definitive conclusions.

Included in this issue is a transcript of the will of Richard Whitlock of Wokingham, Berkshire. This is one of the wills recently made available through the Internet by the Wiltshire Record office. This will is important because it not only confirms information shown in printed sources but it gives us a date of death for this Richard (1556) and even more importantly, it tells us the name of his wife, Jane Grove. This information was missing from Sir James Whitlock (1570-1632)'s *Liber Familicus*, a family history he began in 1609. James knew his grandfather married a Grove but he did not know what his grandmother's given name was. Unfortunately this will is very hard to read and even words I would expect to be obvious were not clear so there are quite a few blanks. Hopefully I have been able to transcribe enough of it for you to make sense of it. As Richard Whitlock and Jane Grove are ancestors of Princes William and Harry, I was able to add this information to Leo van de Pas' collection.

This issue also contains a transcript of one of many great documents sent in by Duane Whitlock regarding the Whit(e)locks of Maryland. Duane is working hard to determine how his ancestor Samuel Whitlock (b.1770-80?) might fit into the main section of the WHITLOCK57 chart. The documents he has added to our collection R2764-R2775 shed new light on the family of Charles Whitelock and Jane Welsh who were married about 1734. In addition the documents R2778-R2783 give useful new information about Samuel Whitlock and his family.

Other items listed in this issue include a set of comics whose hero is Witlock the Robot R2776 and an interesting set of old Whitlock Pickle labels from New Zealand R2777. The miscellaneous section contains many obits including several more Kentucky ones from the tireless Karen Jorgensen who has contributed countless Kentucky obits to our files.

There are also the latest additions to our Ontario certificate collection from Lawrence Otis CERT1445-CERT1453 and some great Quebec entries from Gord Bulger CERT1457-CERT1460. The latter eliminated some confusion that still existed in this Loyalist family from Connecticut. These round out our additions for this issue. Many thanks to all who contributed their finds.

Our first email issue was not without some hitches and I am still working on making it work easier. I will continue to advise you by separate email that the Newsletter has been sent. If you don't receive it, please let me know. Thanks to everyone who has renewed their subscription - we now have 110 subscribers so are within the range of the past several years.

I have made considerable strides in the scanning of our collection. I have most of the Miscellaneous section still to work on although much of the later items in that collection are email messages which are easy to recover. I am about half way through the Reference section with 1100 to 2499 still to be scanned. Everything else is completed. The Birth Register is now computerized to 1879 with parent information completed to 1869. I have also finally taken the time to figure out how to download data from the Family Search program and have been working my way through this information updating our files where I come across information not in our files. Lastly I have been working with the Ancestry.com programs to update our census collection. It is probably time I subscribed to this service. I had been delaying this as I had so many other projects underway, I was hoping to complete some of them before taking on something new but I think the time is right, this is such a useful service for anyone using the census records. I have already noticed some mistakes and as with any transcriptions, the trick is to find a particular family that has to be there but does not show under the correct spelling. The most obvious Whitlock ones are Whittock and Whillock but some are more inventive, like indexing the family with the surname of the family above it - it would take some tricky searching to pick that one out!!

As most of my charts are still in Word Perfect, I have been working on collecting GEDCOM files from those who have entered their information into genealogical programs. I can't emphasize enough to ensure your data is backed-up off site. I have had two incidences myself where my back-up copies saved me losing years of work. I have also been able to restore data to several persons who lost their information but had placed a copy in our files. From time to time feel free to download a GEDCOM file of your charts to me - the likelihood of needing it at sometime in the future is greater than you might think.

One issue has come to light that I need to correct. I was doing some work on the early Whitlocks of Virginia and reviewing some of the old wills that have been in our files for some years. I realized I had made a mistake relating to the James Whitlock whose father only left him a book on filial duty. I was mistaken in thinking this was the James Whitlock who heads the WHITLOCK23 chart, when in fact it was the James Whitlock who married Agness Christmas who we now think was the former James Whitlock's father. This bequest is contained in the 1736 Will of James Whitlock who married Frances (Jones?) and the errant son is the James Whitlock who married Agness Christmas. It has still not come to light what the falling out related to and we will likely never know but at least I have it straight in my mind which James was which. Sorry if I confused anyone.

I hope you enjoy this issue - it has been an interesting one to put together!!

Item I bequeath to Jerome my son after the decease of me & Jane my wife & the longer lyed of us both that my tenement of Whitemarsh in the Countie of Oxford cauled fullres & there lands thereunto apptayning d...h th...pp ... to him & his heirs for ever Item I bequeath to Jon H...ij Ke.. to be delivered xij monthes after my decease & then I will that Jane my wife whom I have made my sole & full exequatrix to fulfill all things according to the ... to h...if she will the said ij Item I bequeath to my daughter Alice v after the decease of me & Jane my wife Item I bequeath to Willm my son x£during his natural life to be paid out of the land cawled pipands... & after his decease to ...John my son Item I will that after the decease of me & Jane my wife & the longer lyved of us that John my son shall have all that my man' cawld beches planer & also all that lands cawld.... & all that lands ... in the Counties of Berks & Wilts to him & to his heirs all my lands .. To son John ... her naturall life & if so be that my wife Jane do marrie that then the ...by the ...will Item I will that my son Willm shall have a ...in my said for him self & ...during his life Item I bequeath ... my brother a Item the residue off my goods...not bequeathed to ... &my last will & testament... my brother John Grove to be overseers thereof & I will that a.....

MARYLAND INDENTURE - 1838

This Indenture, made this first day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between JOHN LOFTIS and his wife, MARGARET LOFTIS of the village of Cecilton, Cecil County, Maryland, and JOHN WHITLOCK and his wife RACHAEL A. WHITLOCK of the village of Middletown, NewCastle County, Delaware, of the one part and JAMES FORD of the village of Cecilton, Cecil County, Maryland of the other part, Whereas SAMUEL WHITLOCK late of the village aforesaid, died seized of certain lots or parcels of land, situate in the vicinity of said village of Cecilton, leaving six children viz: LOUISA now the wife of WILLIAM NORRIS the aforesaid JOHN WHITLOCK, JAMES WHITLOCK, SAMUEL WHITLOCK ARIANA WHITLOCK and HENNY GREENBACK WHITLOCK, the last three being minors, and Whereas ELIZABETH WHITLOCK wife of the aforesaid SAMUEL WHITLOCK also died seized of a certain message tenement and lot of ground situate in the vicinity of the aforesaid village of Cecilton leaving ten children viz: ELIZABETH LOFTIS, REBECCA, wife of CHARLES AABB?, the aforementioned JOHN LOFTIS, LAVINIA LOFTIS, HYLAND B. LOFTIS, ROSETTA LOFTIS, HARRIET LOFTIS, FRANCIS LOFTIS and the aforementioned ARIANNA WHITLOCK, HENNI GREENBANK WHITLOCK and SAMUEL WHITLOCK minors as aforesaid and Whereas the aforesaid JAMES WHITLOCK and LOUISA NORRIS wife of WILLIAM NORRIS aforesaid hath by their deed duly executed and recorded conveyed to the aforesaid JOHN LOFTIS all their undivided, share part or interest of so much of their fathers real property as lies at the east end of the village of Cecilton, And upon the South side of the public road, passing East & West through said village, And Whereas it is the wish and intention of the aforesaid JOHN LOFTIS and his wife MARGARET and the aforesaid JOHN WHITLOCK and his wife RACHEL by these presents to convey to the said JAMES FORD the aforesaid lots or parcels of land as hereinafter described, therefore Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said JOHN LOFTIS and MARGARET his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said JAMES FORD at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof we the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife and the said JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL, his wife doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit exonerate, and discharge the said JAMES FORD, his heirs, executors and administrators, they the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife, and JOHN WHITLOCK & RACHAEL his wife hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents, doth grant, bargain sell, alien, enfeoff, release, convey and confirm, unto the said JAMES FORD his heirs and assigns, all their and each of their undivided, shares parts, or interests of into, and out of three several pieces lots or parcels of land, adjoining each other, one containing one eight of an acre more or less, being the former residence of the aforesaid SAMUEL WHITLOCK decd one containing one fourth of an acre more or less being the late residence of the said SAMUEL WHITLOCK and ELIZABETH his wife and on other containing four acres of land more or less the whole located at the east end of the village of Cecilton, and bounded on the north by the public road aforesaid on the east by the land of the aforesaid JAMES FORD, and on the South by the land of CHRISTOPHER JONES, and on the West by the lots of JAMES FORD aforesaid and the heirs of FREDUS MECHIN deceased, together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, woods, ways, waters, water courses, rights, liberties, priveleges, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate right, title and interest whatsoever of them the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife and the said JOHN WHITLOCK & RACHAEL his wife both at law and in equity of, in, and to and out of the said lots or parcels of land and premises hereby bargained and sold or meant mentioned or intended hereby so to be, and every or any part and parcel thereof, To Have and To Hold all the aforesaid JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife, and the said JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL his wife's undivided shares parts or interests in and to the said lots or parcels of land, so as aforesaid described together with the buildings and appurtenances, and all and singular other the premises, hereby bargained and sold, or ... mentioned or intended hereby so to be, and every part and parcel thereof with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said JAMES FORD, his heirs and assigns forever; and to and for no other use intended and purpose whatsoever, and the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife, and the said JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators, doth covenant grant promise and agree to and with the said JAMES FORD his heirs and assigns that they the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife and the said JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL his wife, and their heirs the said undivided shares or interest in the said lots or parcels of land and premises hereby bargained and sold and every or any part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances thereunto belonging to him the said JOHN FORD his heirs and assigns against them the said JOHN LOFTIS & MARGARET his wife and the said JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL his wife, and their heirs and against all and every person or persons title or interest in the same, will warrant and forever defend by these presents, In witness whereof the said JOHN LOFTIS and MARGARET LOFTIS his wife and JOHN WHITLOCK and RACHAEL A.

This deed was part of a collection of documents relating to the Whit(e)lock families of Maryland and Delaware sent in by Duane Whitlock. It is of particular interest for the amount of genealogical detail it gives. Not only does it list all of Samuel Whitlock's six children, it shows he was married twice, the second time to Mrs. Elizabeth Loftis who already had seven Loftis children (also named) and she and Samuel had three more. This family is detailed at the end of the WHITLOCK57 chart as "Also from Maryland". Receiving this information from Duane enabled me to place one of the other families shown as "Also from Maryland". This was the family of John Whitlock and his wife Rachel A. They show on the 1850 census of NewCastle Co., Delaware but John Whitlock was born in Maryland. This is obviously the couple mentioned in the 1838 deed. This places John as one of Samuel's children with his birth about 1810. On the 1810 census Samuel and his wife are likely the two persons shown age 16 to 25 and they have one daughter, likely Louisa who is under 10. John is not shown so was likely born later in 1810. There is also an older woman living them age 26 to 44, possibly a mother in law.

By 1820 the family has grown. There is Louisa and John shown age 10 to 16 and joined by a son under 10 which would be James H. Whitlock who was born about 1813. It is likely that Samuel's wife had died by 1820 as she does not appear on this census and on Apr.13,1825 Samuel Whitlock marries the widow Elizabeth Loftis.

Our thanks to Duane Whitlock for this detail and to adding to our knowledge base for this part of the Whitlock family. Hopefully as our research progresses we will connect Samuel to the main section of the WHITLOCK57 chart.

SHIP LIST - 1820 QUEBEC TO MONTREAL

Rita Somers sent in an interesting example of what information you can obtain from early Ship Lists. In this case it was from the ship *Malsham* on her fifth voyage up the St.Lawrence River from Quebec to Montreal arriving May 28,1820. The entry gave the following details:

It is evident from our records that this is the family of John & Susanna (Williamson) Whitlock who were married at Ternascobe, Co. Armagh, Ireland December 14,1796. Their Location Ticket for Settlement at Richmond on the River Rideau is dated at Quebec May 27,1820 and recommends John Whitlock and his son William Whitlock age 21 be accepted for settlement. This John Whitlock currently heads the WHITLOCK28 chart, the Whitlocks of Co. Armagh, Ireland. We show John born 1776 in Loughalin, Altaturk, Co. Armagh but we have not yet been able to determine who his parents were. Our thanks to Rita Somers for this item.

WHITLOCK'S PICKLES OF NEW ZEALAND

Lawrence Otis recently came across some examples of the labels used by F. Whitlock & Sons Ltd., pickle and sauces makers of Wanganui, New Zealand. While the company ceased operations in 1990, they were in business for over 100 years. Records show the pickle business was launched in 1877 with manufacture of Delhi Chutney Sauce. Frederick Whitlock knew the power of advertising and as early as 1878 ads were appearing in the Wanganui Chronicle "Ask for *WHITLOCK'S DELHI CHUTNEY SAUCE, the purest and most economical preparation in the market, and a genuine local industry. ANALYTICAL REPORT 'I witnessed the manufacture of Whitlock's Delhi Chutney Sauce; it is free of Copper, and composed entirely of wholesome ingredients. (Signed) J. DECIMUS TRIPE Reg. Med. & Sur. Pract.'*"

By 1895 the family were also selling Worcester Sauce and Tomato sauce as well as the Delhi Chutney. From 1887 to 1902 production was done from the back of the Whitlock's residence using large white



enameled pots (note the “free of Copper” claim in their ad). By 1905 they were operating in their new factory built on the opposite side of their property in Wanganui. Products now included items such as Chow Chow, Piccalilli, Vinegar, Cordials and Liqueur flavourings.

In 1908 the founder, Frederick Whitlock died from complications of a broken arm following a horse and cart accident and in 1912 the Limited Liability company was established to refinance their growing operations and fund the necessary purchase of equipment to continue their expansion. They could now make their own packing crates and could purchase bulk spices and grind and mix their own ingredients to control consistency and quality.

A milestone was reached in 1924 when the debts to expand the business were paid they were able to purchase a new model “T” Ford one ton truck to replace the old horse and cart system that had been in place since they first opened in 1877. The Company was stable enough to weather the depression but suffered some hard times during World War II with both Howard Whitlock and his cousin Maurice Whitlock away for nearly three years. Howard’s father Percival carried on as best he could during this time. Following WWII the plant was overhauled again and updated and by 1960’s when the fourth generation of the family entered the business it was a stable, modern and prosperous one. The new generation adapted the product line reflecting the changing market needs and the rise of “supermarket” system that was to dominate food sales for the next generation.



Things ran smoothly until 1983 when factory manager, Fred Whitlock suddenly died of cancer at the young age of 43. The family decision following Fred’ death was that it was time to consider selling the business as a going concern. The 1980’s were a time of corporate take-overs, mergers and consolidation of businesses. Following fairly extensive negotiations the company was sold to the Australian company of R.M. Gow Ltd. Within a short time the company changed hands several times and finally in 1990 the plant and fittings were removed to Auckland and the Wanganui land and buildings sold. This brought to an end over 100 years of pickle manufacture by the Whitlock family in Wanganui.



One of our Whitlock Collection items is tall green glass pickle bottle from F. Whitlock & Sons, “Phoenix Brand Pickles” made about 1895. Frederick Whitlock’s family is detailed on our WHITLOCK43 chart, the Whitlocks of Ealing, London. This chart is headed by Mark Whitlock who married Elizabeth Living Oct.26,1772 at St.Mary’s, Harefield, Middlesex.

I had a chance to meet Howard Percival Whitlock (1913-1998) and his wife Marion during a stop in Vancouver on their way to England in the 1980’s. Howard was a long time subscriber to the Whitlock Family Newsletter. Much of the material for the above article is from the book *The Whitlocks of Middlesex* by Alison Honeyfield, 1997 (R1817) received from Howard.
