

WILL OF GEORGE WHITLOCK OF PITTON, 1720

In the name of God Amen this Fourth Day of June in the Sixth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Britaine France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith & - Anno Dom 1720 I George Whitlock of Pitton in the County of Wilts Husbandman being of Sound and perfect mind and Disposeing memory thanks be given to Almighty God for the Same revoking and making null and void all other and Former Wills Whatsoever by me heretofore made and Calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and the Certainty of Death Doe make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following (that is say) First I Commend my Soule into the hands of allmighty God hoping that throw the merritts Death and Passion of my blessed Saviour and redeemer Jesus Christ to have a full and free pardon and forgiveness for all my Sinns and to inherit Everlasting Life my Body I Commit to the Earth to be Decently buryed at the Discretion of my Executrix herein after named And to the Disposition of Such Temporall Estate as itt hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I Give bequeath and Dispose of the Same as in and by this my said last will and Testament is mentioned and expressed in manner and forme following Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Whitlock all that Living that was my Fathers with thappurtences During the terme of years that be then to come after my Decease And all the rest and residue of my Goods and Chattles and Lease hold Estate I Give to my Loving Wife Anne Whitlock Dureing her naturall life And my Will and meaneing is that after the Decease of my said Wife that my Son Joseph Whitlock shall have all the Goods and Chattles and Lease hold Estate after the Decease of my said Wife, that shall be then remaining And alls bills ready money and Plate Whatsoever I Give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Anne Whitlock whome I doe make and Ordaine my whole and Sole Executrix of this my Last will and Testament In Wittnesse whereunto I sett my hand and Seale the Day and Yeare First above Written.
