

WHITLOCK FAMILY NEWSLETTER

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It has been a hectic few months with lots happening in all facets of our lives. The number one distraction had to be the Winter Olympics happening in Vancouver. They were an amazing experience to both watch and have going on all around you. We only spent three days actually in Vancouver but they affected every aspect of our lives for weeks. Everything stopped from time to time to listen to the final minutes of a special event - particularly hockey!!

As well I continue to work on setting up the new website and that is taking a good deal of time to organize and make decisions. This is proceeding well and I think we will be happy with the result. In this vein, I finally managed to complete the huge scanning job that I have been working on for the past four years. Most everything in our collection is now digitized and protected against loss. There is still a lot of work to do on the Xmiscellaneous files as I still have several years worth to extract from the "mail" folders and place in their individual files so they can be downloaded. There are also some bound items that I left until the end to scan as they have to be done page by page. I had microfilmed our collection in 1977 and 1987 but digitizing everything is a much more permanent and user friendly way to hold our data. As well as an offsite copy I have contracted with Amazon to hold our files and be the location researchers download files from. This will mean another copy of all our data will be held in a different location.

Another project completed was the September 2009 disc of material from Lawrence Otis. This material added great information including hundreds of new certificates to our collection, so many I will have to split them over a couple of issues of the Newsletter. We now have 2430 copies of certificates for Whitlocks or their descendants available for researchers!! A great research tool. The latest additions are mainly American, the states represented are Ohio, North Carolina, Michigan and South Carolina. Eventually these certificates will be available to be downloaded from the website but for now feel free to request copies directly from me. I have already received several requests from the last Newsletter. While most of the recent entries are for deaths in the 1900's, the persons involved were born throughout the 19th century and some of the parents shown on certificates lived in the late 18th century or early 19th. This has been a great resource and I have added information to many of the charts.

I have another disc from Lawrence received in December and will now start work on cataloguing that one!!

Needless to say the Birth Register project is still stalled at 1890 but will I try to complete the next ten years as the huge combined database of Births, Deaths and Marriages, the new website will make available, will be searchable for everything prior to 1901 or 23600 of 35,000 entries!! It is expected the Death Register will also be made available separately for all years.

One of the items from Lawrence's last disc relates to Solomon Lipinsky who founded the Bon Marche chain of stores in the US. There is great information available and combined with the information on Solomon's wife Eva (Whitlock) Lipinsky's death certificate new clues regarding the Whitlocks of Poland are hinted at. See the article on Eva (Whitlock) Lipinsky in this issue.

Other items of note include: William Ogden Whitlock sent in several Colonial Dames applications that detailed his family's descent from some of the original Dutch settlers. (R2870-2) Very useful genealogical documents for anyone researching the part of the WHITLOCK16 chart that descends from Bache McEvers Whitlock (1819-1884).

I appreciated all the census information Lawrence Otis send on the Pugsley family of Michigan. (R2873-79). There are two different Pugsley families connected to the WHITLOCK01 chart. The one family descends from Joseph Pugsley born in Cleves, Cornwall in 1809 and died in Geauga Co., Ohio in 1882. Joseph Pugsley married Mary Whitlock (1812-1857) of Langtree, Devon and Geauga Co., Ohio. The other family descends from William Pugsley born about 1819 in Fremington, Devon and married to Sally Ayre the daughter of William Ayre and Ann Whitlock of Langtree, Devon. At this time we do not know if the two Pugsley families are related.

R2892 is an ad on the inside the cover of a City Directory for Asheville, North Carolina for 1883. It advertises Whitlock's Dry Goods and Millinery. This is the business of Solomon Whitlock, the brother of Eva Whitlock who married Solomon Lipinsky, founder of the Bon Marche stores.

CERT2426-30 are British Columbia certificates for local Whitlock families sent in by Pat Kelly of Victoria.

X6819 is a 1935 City Directory of New Westminster sent in by Pat Kelly it shows my own father with his first wife, the mother of my sister Necia.

PH1135A&B are a couple of interesting photographs taken at the photographic studio of Mrs. Vreeland Whitlock of McPherson, Kansas in the 1880's. I could not find this person on the 1880 census and am interested to know if anyone has further details about this lady photographer.

Fred Whitlock sent a very interesting email about his experiences with family history research and DNA testing. I have used the body of his email in a article for this issue. Very useful to hear some personal results from this project and hopefully it spurs other to join in and add their DNA results.

One change you will see in the Newsletter is the Birth Register at the end of each issue. I finally came to the end of the pages from the old Microsoft Access program and the new ones are from the current Excel database. Hopefully the format is close enough to the previous one to be understood.

Subscriptions continue to come in but there are more than 30 who have not renewed for 2010 yet. I hope most of you will consider supporting us for another year. I will send email reminders to those who receive the Newsletter in that way and renewal forms will be included in the mailed ones. Subscriptions remain the main source of revenue to fund this project and I appreciate the support all of you have given over the years.

EVA (WHITLOCK) LIPINSKY & THE BON MARCHE

After 42 years of research I am amazed when items come to light that have evaded our net of data collection for so long. Perfect example is the Whitlock connection to the American department store chain, The Bon Marche!!

Included in the disc Lawrence Otis sent in September 2009 is a great collection of papers from the University of North Carolina in Asheville detailing the history of the Lipinsky family and the origins of the Bon Marche stores.

The biography of Solomon Lipinsky states:

“Solomon Lipinsky appears in the Asheville census, in 1880. He was born in Richmond, Virginia on February 23, 1856 and at the age of 21 he moved to Tarboro, North Carolina and remained there for four years. He came to Asheville when he was 25 years old with his wife, Eva Whitlock Lipinsky and his brother-in-law, Solomon Whitlock. Sol and his brother-in-law opened a dry goods store at various locations on S. Main Street (now Biltmore Avenue) during the 1880s and 1890s. One of his first stores was Lipinsky and Ellick, a partnership with his half-sister, Eva Ellick. Sometime around 1911 or 1912, he had moved his store, by then called Bon Marche', to the northwest corner of Lexington and Patton Avenues (19-23 Patton

Avenue). In 1928, Bon Marche' moved again to the northwest corner of Haywood Street and Battery Park Avenue and in 1933, the store moved across the street to 33-35 Haywood Street. His three sons followed in their father's footsteps and Morris and Whitlock ("Whit") worked in the local Asheville store, while Louis was placed in charge of the store in Charlotte, North Carolina, founded by Solomon in 1920. Another Bon Marche store had been opened in Wilmington, North Carolina in 1916 but closed in 1921 and a Columbia, South Carolina Store was operated between 1920 and 1923.

Solomon was active in many civic organizations. As Director of the National Bank of Commerce, he played a major role in the economic construction of Asheville. He was an active member of the Knights of Pythias, the Masons, and the Odd Fellows. He played a central role in the administration of the Congregation Beth Ha Tephila as its President. His work as president of the local Institutional Service Committee, was well known and his attempts at social reform in Buncombe are well-documented. His obituary notes that his "many activities show that he did not concern himself solely with business. His love for his fellow man was demonstrated by many acts of kindness. Asheville has had few citizens who have been held in greater affection than Mr. Lipinsky. His kindness and courtesy, his unflinching consideration for others, made him one of the most beloved of Asheville citizens."

Eva (Whitlock) Lipinsky & Solomon Lipinsky

Solomon's home at the time of death was at 156 Cumberland Avenue in the Montford section of Asheville. Previous to that he and his family lived at 36 Montford Avenue.

Solomon Lipinsky's name appears in the Vol.2 Sherrills Inn ledgers which are found in the D.H. Ramsey Library Special Collections. D.H. Ramsey, who annotated the ledgers, notes that "... S. Lipinsky who founded Bon Marche was a frequent visitor to Sherrill's Inn. He has just moved to Asheville and gone into the Mercantile business here when his name first began to appear on the register. His wife was a Whitlock. S. [Solomon] Lipinsky was the father of Clara, Morris, Whitlock, and Louis Lipinsky."

The Lipinsky family shows on the 1880 census of Asheville, Buncombe Co., North Carolina. Eva and her brother Solomon Whitlock both show age 25 born in Poland with both parents born in Poland. Eva (Whitlock) Lipinsky died November 7, 1926 in Asheville. Her death certificate shows her date of birth as March 18, 1852 and place of birth as Brest Litovsk, Poland (now Brest, Belarus) Her father's name is very hard to read but may be Simeon Whitlock. No mother's name is given on the death certificate.

There is also the family of Philip Whitlock (1838-1919) who came to the USA in 1853. He was born in Kovel, Poland (now Ukraine). Kovel and Brest are neighbouring cities on opposite sides of the current border between Ukraine and Belarus. (See article on Philip Whitlock "Richmond Grays" in the December 2005 issue of the WFA Newsletter). Due to the close proximity of their birthplaces it is likely that Eva Whitlock's and Philip Whitlock's families are connected. Finding these two Whitlocks origins in Poland also likely rules out the possibility that the name Whitlock was adopted upon their arrival in America. Philip Whitlock founded the *Old Virginia Cheroot* company and was a financial supporter of many Jewish organizations in Richmond, Va.



I have made contact with a descendant of Solomon & Eva (Whitlock) Lipinsky to determine if anyone has more on the origins of Eva Whitlock. Hopefully as more research is done we will determine if Eva & Philip's families are connected.

The Whitlock name is English and I am hoping some of the descendants of the Polish Whitlocks will have information regarding their origins. I have a Richard Whitlock (1565-1624) of London who went to live in Elbing in 1580. He and his wife Katherine Dambits had 16 children and the family stayed on the continent. I suspect many of the German, Swedish and Polish Whitlocks likely descend from this part of the family. The recent advent of DNA testing has proven very useful to indicate the likely origins of many of these families and I am hoping to come across male Whitlock descendants of this part of family willing to be tested. THE WILL OF WILLIAM SMALE - 1834

The following will is dated Nov.15,1834 and was proved Jan.19,1839. William Smale died Dec.11,1838. This will is a perfect example of a document from a collateral line that provides a huge amount of information. William Smale's niece Mary Smale married Richard Whitlock of Langtree May 10,1770. It appears William Smale was related to most of the major North Devon families!!! Certainly to the main Langtree ones.

This is the last Will and Testament of me William Smale of Frithelstock in the County of Devon, Yeoman.

I give and bequeath to the poor of the parish of Frithelstock aforesaid the Sum of Five pounds to be dispensed? within three months after my decease in such manner as my Executor and Executrix hereinafter named shall think proper.

I give and bequeath to the several persons hereinafter mentioned the following legacies that is to say to my Brother John Smale the sum of nineteen pounds. To my Nephew John Smale the younger son of my said Brother John Smale the sum of One hundred pounds. To my niece Rebecca Fursman Wife of John Fursman of Buckland Brewer in the said County Butcher the Sum of Sixty pounds. To each of the children of my said niece Rebecca Fursman (that is to say) John, Joseph, Susanna, Catharine, Rebecca, Harriet and Emily Fursman the sum of Five pounds. To my Niece Sarah Copp wife of Thomas Copp of Horwood in the said County Yeoman the Sum of Fifty pounds. To George Hackwill, son of my late niece Catherine Hackwill Wife of George Hackwill of Langtree in the Said County Yeoman the Sum of Five pounds. To Susanna Copp Daughter of the said Thomas Copp the Sum of Nineteen pounds. To Richard Smale otherwise Nankievil the Sum of Nineteen pounds. To my Nephew Richard Whitlock son of Richard Whitlock late of Langtree aforesaid Yeoman deceased and Mary his Wife the Sum of Five pounds and I hereby forgive him the Debt he now owes me. To my Nephew John Whitlock another son of said Richard Whitlock and Mary his wife the sum of Fifty pounds. To Mary Daughter of the said John Whitlock the Sum of ten pounds. To my Nephew Philip Whitlock another son of the said Richard Whitlock and his Wife Mary Sum of Five pounds and I hereby forgive him the Debt he now owes me. To my Nephew Henry Whitlock another son of the said Richard Whitlock and Mary his wife the Sum of Nineteen pounds to be paid at the expiration of Six calendar months next after my decease. To my niece Mary Riddecleave Wife of William Riddecleave of Langtree aforesaid Husbandman the Sum of Three pounds. To John Whitlock son of my nephew Richard Whitlock the younger herein named the Sum of Nineteen pounds. To my niece Mary ... Wife of John ... of Petrockstow in the said County Yeoman the Sum of Ten? pounds. To my niece Rebecca Smale Wife of my nephew John Smale the Sum of Nineteen pounds. To my niece Susannah Copp Wife of Henry Copp of Langtree in the said County Yeoman the Sum of nineteen pounds. To my nephew John Beare the son of George Beare of Frithelstock aforesaid yeoman and Rebecca his wife the Sum of nineteen pounds. To my Nephew William Beare another son of the said George Beare and Rebecca his wife the Sum of nineteen pounds. To may Niece Catherine Galsworthy

who died on the *eleventh* Day of *December* 1838 and made Oath, that they have made diligent search and due enquiry after, and in respect of the Personal Estate and Effects of the said Deceased, in order to ascertain the full Amount and Value thereof: and that to the best of their Knowledge, Information, and Belief, the whole of the Goods, Chattels, and Credits, of which the said Deceased died, possessed within the *Diocese* of Exeter, (exclusive of what the Deceased may have been possessed of, or intitled to as a Trustee for any other Person or Persons, and not beneficially, but including the Leasehold Estates for Years of the Deceased, whether absolute or terminable on Lives, and without deducting any thing on Account of the Debts due and owing from the Deceased,) are under the Value of *Twelve thousand pounds* to the best of their Deponent Knowledge, Information, and Belief.
~~the Deponent do hereby declare that the said Deceased did not possess any real or personal Estate or Credits or Debts or other Intestments or Liabilities at the last of his Decease~~

FAMILY HISTORY & DNA

I was very interested in a recent email from Fred Whitlock and thought I would just print it as see what comments we receive on this subject:

“Like most people who have entered the murky waters of Family History Research, I did so to find out where my roots were, who I belonged to and who belonged to me. After 15years of research I justifiably felt pleased to get back to the mid 1600's and perhaps maybe one day I might be able to push further back. But probably like most, one gets those little niggling thoughts, like 'what if I have taken a wrong turning', so I thought that DNA might confirm or prove a point, which I think it has.

When I was a young lad I often heard the expression 'It is a clever man who knows his own son, and an even cleverer son who knows his own Father'. Never gave the matter any thought, but after receiving my DNA report it ocured to me, "I do" and what's more I know there is an unbroken continuity back some 500 years when those in the WHITLOCK 16 Group in the USA and my family line shared the same Ancestor. Michael Parson who lives in Highcliff, Dorset, Eng. and may be known to you, is a well known Writer and Historian on matters about Pitton & Farley. He expressed the view that he thought the WHITLOCK who traded as a Wool Merchant at the end of the 14th.Cent. in Salisbury, Wilts. was possibly the Ancestor of all the Whitlocks in that area. Only DNA will confirm or deny that, and it would be nice to know the truth of the matter, but a rather tall order.! However a few more samples from WHITLOCK's who claim ancestry from this Group would give a clearer picture. My DNA Haplogroup is R1a (or possibly R1a1) so I was informed by the DNA Lab. Report, this is only 4.5% of the total English DNA content, the rest being filled by R1b some 67% and the balance with I1 or I2. Any DNA results that show a difference would indicate the possibility of there being more than one source of WHITLOCK's in the area, or perhaps an indecession by some Whitlock Woman! You takes your choice!

I don't pretend to have more than a passing knowledge of these matters but I do feel that DNA will be a useful tool, it may well be that my line may have come into the Salisbury area from elsewhere, if so it would be a big step forward if we can show a connection with another Group, which I am sure was the reason for you instigating the DNA Programme. I am of the view that we need to encourage as many as possible to enter into the programme and will support you any way I can. Personally I would be happy to make a small donation say £10 or more Annually to a Fund (Similar to the Whitlock Tomb) and if we can generate enough interest from others, build a fund to perhaps award say a couple of Tests to others each year. No merit need to be found amongst those chosen other than the need to make connections. I think the choice of those recipiants should remain with you (you're the Guvenor!) as you have an overall view. It maybe that this is just "Pie in the Sky", I hope not. The stated view of the WHITLOCK Family Association is to expand our knowledge of the Whitlock Name and Family we all want this, I hope. I don't know if this makes sense or whether it will be worth a shot, give me your views.”

I agree with Fred that even with the small number of DNA test results the Whitlock DNA Project has received it has yielded great results. The confirmation of some of our long held assumptions has been gratifying to say the least. The connection of so many of our charts to the WHITLOCK02H chart has been very interesting. Even the WHITLOCK90 chart that traces back in Holland to 1300, while not a 37 marker test, still only has one variance from one of the families that likely connects to the WHITLOCK02H chart. While the DNA tests normally say there is likely a common ancestor within 500 years this is already 700 years.

One of the things I have learned lately is that the families showing the same mutation are likely connected

closer so having one or two mutations is desirable as that constitutes a subgroup of from the main line. Theoretically you should be able to determine where your mutation breaks off from the main line. The confusion is determining which is the mutation and which the main line!!

This said, I would encourage more male Whitlocks to take the plunge and have your DNA test. Family Tree DNA still seems to be the most common choice for this and has the largest database so far. They can be found easily by searching for that name. The 37 marker test is most common test done and gives the best comparison. The tests are still somewhat pricey at about \$150. Fred's proposal is interesting and I would like to hear comments about setting up a fund to subsidize some of these tests where we deem the test of particular interest to our Whitlock research.

While the Virginia families are fairly well represented - more tests will allow us to look at the mutation data and see if it yields any interesting conclusions. There is still only one test from the WHITLOCK01 line (me) and I am very curious to see if others in my own family share the same DNA as I do. The Pitton, Wiltshire Whitlocks appear to share a different DNA from the WHITLOCK02H line and more tests from descendants of that line would help confirm that as well.

Thanks Fred for your thoughts on this subject - hopefully this results in more tests being added to the project with more confirmation that our research is on the right track!!

All test results are confidential and only the WHITLOCK line number and the area where you live shows in the summary of the test results.
