

THOMAS DANIEL WHITLOCK (1923-1964)

Thomas Daniel Whitlock was born in Saline Co., Illinois March 22, 1923 (some records say 1924). He grew up in Illinois and graduated from Harrisburg High School in 1940. He served as a combat engineer in World War II and served in Korea. He rejoined the army after the war in CID (forerunner of CIA) and rose the rank of Lt. Colonel. It is not clear when he was posted to Vietnam but he was a Infantry Unit Commander when he was killed by an artillery shell November 1,1964. He was buried in Arlington National Cemetery in Washington, DC.

Thomas was married to Zella Faye Davis and they had four children, Sharon Lee 1945, Thomas Daniel 1954, Jonathan Robert 1956 and Devi Dewain 1961.

He was the son of William Lee Whitlock and his wife Lola Banes and is part of the WHITLOCK33 family.
