This issue is a little later than usual but hopefully it will be worth the wait. The first piece of news is that the new website is now up and running!! www.whitlockfamilyassociation.com is our new domain name. The old website operated by Dick Whitlock is still there for the time being and can be accessed if required. (No updates have been done since 2008). The new website will continue to be a work in progress for sometime as I get more and more of our files uploaded. The vast majority of them are now available and can be accessed by clicking on the highlighted file names. I have only completed the Xmiscellaneous items up to X3200 so many of the email and genforum items between X3200 and X6000 still have to have files made for them and be uploaded. Note the charts are zipped for confidentiality as there is a lot of information on living persons included. (I just means they cannot be searched by search engines such as Google.)

This now makes the majority of our collection available to anyone wishing to research. The only downside is there was a cost to get this up and running and an annual cost to maintain it. I have therefore added a "donate" button to the website and my hope is that researchers will be happy enough getting access to all this material that they will be willing to donate to keep it available. Check the website out and comments and suggestions are always appreciated.

In other news, I have finally finished cataloguing the masses of data on Lawrence Otis's December 2009 disk. The additions pages for this issue are full of this new information. The 1942 draft registration cards for the US (R2940, R2942, R2960-R2968) cover all males born between April 28, 1877 and February 16, 1897. These cards give the full date of birth and place of birth. There is also other personal information plus next of kin. I have received this information for several states and found it adds great detail to many of the charts.

The Brooklyn Eagle newspaper clips (NP1190-NP1313) provided loads of interesting information about the Brooklyn Whitlock families. I will be using some of these for articles in this and future issues.

Vicky House has given us copies of her research into the Whitlocke families (R2916-R2933, X6845,6, X6852, X6854-7, X6859-63). In cataloguing her research it became evident that the origins of the WHITLOCK21 chart were in Downholme, Yorkshire. This family has always claimed descent from the WHITLOCK02H line which my research has not indicated any connection. A review of the will of Peter Whitlock (1702-1781) provided the clues we needed to make the connection to Downholme, Yorkshire and show that Peter was the son of Christopher & Elizabeth (Harland) Whitlock who were married at Downholme May 28, 1700.

I was very pleased to be contacted by Frank Dickson whose family descends from the Whitlocks of Hartlepool, Durham. I have added his information to the "Also from Yorkshire" section of the WHITLOCK12 chart and put him in contact with his cousin Desiree Whitlock of Chilliwack.

The Massachusetts and Michigan additions to our certificate collection from Lawrence Otis are great and added new details to many of the families from those states. I have started adding both family and chart codes to the additions lists where I know them. (There were so many certificates and newspaper clips that some needed to be held over to the December 2010 issue.)

It was great to reconnect with Sherry Callahan and receive the updates on her family. The newspaper clipping regarding the elopement of her grandparents is the subject of an article in this issue. Also included is an article from the Brooklyn Eagle regarding a less happy love affair.

Lots of great new material and my continued thanks to all of you who contributed your finds for this issue.

I am sure the new website will continue to take a lot of my time as I update it and improve it but hopefully I will get back to some of our other projects as time allows.

WILL OF PETER WHITELOCK OF ST.LEONARD'S, SHOREDITCH, LONDON 1781

In the Name of God amen I Peter Whitelock of the parish of Saint Leonard, Shoreditch in the County of Middlesex Permit Examiner in the General Excise Office London being of Sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in the manner following that is to say after all my just Debts and Funeral Expenses are fully paid and satisfied I give and Devise and bequeath unto my Kinsman Giles Ellerton of West Smithfield in the parish of Saint Sepulchre London and Richard Reddish warehousekeeper at the General Excise Office London six hundred pounds of my three per cent Bank Annuities of the Year One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six Upon the Trust and to and for the ends interests and purposes hereinafter mentioned (that is to say) Upon Trust that they and the Survivor of them and the Executors Administrators and Assigns of such Survivor do and shall hand remain and be possessed of and Interested in the said Six hundred pounds Bank Annuities and of the Interest or Dividends thereof In Trust forever and pay the whole of such Interest or Dividends thereof or Authorize permit and Suffer my Daughter Mary Hills Wife of Robert Hills to receive such Interest as the same shall from time to time arise and become due and payable for and during the term of her natural Life to and for her sole and separate use and benefit and her receipt or Receipts for the same whether she be sole or consort And notwithstanding her shall from time to time be a Sufficient discharge of my said Trustees for the same and the some shall not be Subject or liable to the controul? Debts or Engagements of her present or any future husband she may have or take but be absolutely freed and discharged therefrom as if She was Sole and unmarried and from and immediately after the Decease of my said Daughter Mary Hills then upon Trust that my said Trustees and the survivor of them and the Executors administrators and assigns of such Survivor do and shall assign and Transfer the said Six Hundred pounds Bank Annuities unto my Son Peter Whitelock and my two Daughters Elizabeth Crosley and Hannah Smith and their children in such proportions manner and form as my said Daughter Mary shall by any Deed or writing or by her last Will and Testament or any other writing purposing to be her last Will and Testament (whether She be sole consort and notwithstanding her coverture) under her hand and seal testified in the presence of two or more credible witnesses ... or appoint And for want of such direction or appointment In Trust to assign and Transfer the same unto my said Son Peter Whitelock and my two Daughters Elizabeth Crosley and Hannah Smith equally to be divided between them share and share alike and in case of any of their deaths in the life time of the said Mary Hills then their respective Share of him her or them so dying to go to and be assigned and Transferred to his her or their child or children and in default of such child or children then to the Survivor or survivors of them the said Peter Whitelock, Elizabeth Crosley and Hannah Smith in equal proportions share and share alike Also I give devise and bequeath unto my Son in Law Robert Hills the said Giles Ellerton and Richard Reddish Six hundred pounds of my three

percent ... Bank Annuities Upon the Trusts and to and for the ends intents and purposes hereinafter mentioned (that is to say) Upon Trust that they and the survivors and Survivor of them and the Executors Administrators and Assigns of such Survivor to and shall hand remain and be possessed of and interested in the said Six Hundred pounds ... Bank Annuities and of the Interest or Dis... thereof in (continues for three more pages)

In Witness whereof I the said Peter Whitelock (the Testator) have to this my last Will and Testament contained in four sheets of paper set my hand to the first three sheets and my hand and Seal to this last sheet thereof this twenty second Day of Juni in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty one Pet'r Whitelock (LS) Signed Sealed published and declared by the said Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as Witnesses thereof in his presence and his request and in the presence of each other G. Black - Jno Mullins - both of the Excise Office.

This Will was proved at London the twenty first day of August in the year of Our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty one before the Worshipful Andrew Colter Duc... Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right Worshipful Peter Calvert Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or commissary of the prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the Oath of Robert Hills the sole Executor named in the said Will to whom Administration was granted of all andthe Goods Chattels and credits of the deceased he having been first sworn Duly to Administer.

This Peter Whitelock was baptized December 28,1702 in Downholme, Yorkshire and married Hanah ?? prior to 1728. His four children are named in the will, Hannah, Mary, Elizabeth and Peter. There is also mention of a kinsman Giles Ellerton. The mention of Giles Ellerton provided us the clue we needed to confirm who this family was. Giles Ellerton was from Downholme, Yorkshire and this confirmed that this Peter was the one born in Downholme.

Peter's daughter Hannah Whitelock married Captain Jeremiah Smith Nov.7,1765 St.Botolph, Bishopsgate, London and they had a son Jeremiah Smith.

Mary Whitelock married Robert Hills Sep.29,1765 St. Leonard's Shoreditch.

Elizabeth Whitelock married Samuel Crosley

This Peter Whitelock shows on the WHITLOCK21 chart. The chart includes the Whitlockes of Jamaica who claim descent from Bulstrode Whitelocke (1605-1675) but no connection has yet been uncovered. The grandchildren and greatgrandchildren of Bulstrode Whitelocke are fairly well documented and there is no Peter Whitelock born about 1702 among them. Peter held a fairly prestigious job as Permit Examiner in the General Excise Office, London and his will is both lengthy and detailed.

Peter is also able to send his son to Merchant Taylor's School (1744-49) where many of Bulstrode's family were educated.

The family was obviously of some influence but so far our records have not uncovered the source of this power.

Thanks to Vicky House for giving me the incentive to look at this family again and determine that Peter's parents were Christopher Whitelock and Elizabeth Harland who were married May 28,1700 at Downholme.

ELOPEMENT OF CHARLES & PEARL WHITLOCK 1895

A collection of newspaper clippings was sent in by Sherry Callahan regarding the elopement of Charles William Whitlock and Pearl Eunice Mumford. The event was obviously exciting news in 1895 in Elkton, Maryland as articles appeared in the Cecil Whig, Cecil Democrat and Cecil Star papers of December 14, 1895. All the articles are fairly similar and the one from the Cecil Whig is shown below:

“LOVE’S ROUGH PATH

A Chesapeake City Elopement and an Exciting Honeymoon

The love of George W., alias Charles H. Whitlock and Pearl Mumford, of near Chesapeake City, laughed at more than locksmiths, and the experience of the ardent lovers this week has certainly afforded them a novel, if unpleasant honeymoon. Charles George’s marriage was an elopement, and the fact that his bride was but 14 years of age, still holds her under parental control, and her mother has appeared upon the scene, indignant and bent after revenge on the crafty Whitlock.

On Tuesday of last week a young man stepped up to the desk at the Clerk’s office and secured from Deputy Clerk John G. Williams a marriage license. The applicant after taking the necessary oaths, signed his name as William S. Snyder, and gave the name of the groom as George W. Whitlock, aged 22, and that of the bride as Pearl Mumford, age 19, both of Chesapeake City. The couple later in the day presented themselves at the Trinity Church Rectory, on Bridge street, this town, and were married by the Rev. Wm. Schouler, a matronly lady named Kelly accompanying Miss Mumford, the marriage certificate being regular to all appearances.

When the mother of the bride, Mrs. Mary Mumford, learned of the wedding, she was very much distressed at the conduct of her daughter, who was but fourteen years of age in October last. She stated that the girl had been met by Whitlock, that day while on her way to school, and had been persuaded by him to put on a long dress and accompany him to Elkton, to be married.

Whitlock’s name is Charles, not George, and it therefore appears that the mysterious Snider perjured himself in securing the license, both as to the name George and the age of the girl.

States Attorney A.L. Crothers was notified and a warrant was issued for Snider, on the charge of perjury. The only Snider that could be found was Robert A. Snider, of Chesapeake City, who knowing nothing of the case whatever, was surprised at his presence being so peremptorily demanded at Elkton.

On Wednesday afternoon a hearing was held in the case before Squire Cleaver in Elkton. The witnesses failed to appear, and an attachment was issued for the arrest of Whitlock, his young bride, and others. They were brought to Elkton, and failing to give bond for their appearance at a hearing set for Thursday afternoon, were compelled to pass Wednesday night in the custody of Sheriff Mackey, who showed them every courtesy possible, allowing them to occupy a comfortable room in the residence portion of the jail. The hearing took place in the Sheriff’s office before Squire P.H. Cleaver, on Thursday afternoon. Whitlock

testified that he had engaged the man who gave the name of Snider, to secure the license for him, which he afterwards found in a "box," but he positively refused to reveal the man's identity. When told unless he gave this information he might be returned to jail, Whitlock replied that he would prefer to do so rather than divulge the fact. Mrs. Mary Mumford, the mother, and the bride herself, here fell fainting to the floor, being no longer able to withstand the nervous strain to which they had been subjected. Deputy Clerk of the Court Williams did not know the person securing the license.

Magistrate Cleaver, at this point, dismissed the case, the costs being paid by Mr. Whitlock, father of the groom."

This family is shown at the end of the WHITLOCK57 chart as "also from Maryland". The family descends from Samuel who married Louisa Pearce about 1800 and died in 1833. Sherry Callahan's Main Line is ML349, an updated version is included in this issue of the Newsletter.

THE EMMA MOORE TRAGEDY

The Brooklyn Eagle of March 26, 1855 includes this item:

The Rochester papers do not inform us whether Mr. Whitlock is still retained in custody: but we take it for granted that he is. The explanation of the facts most current seems to be that there was an understanding between Emma and her beau that he was immediately to redeem his pledges, and that she purchased the gloves on the evening of November 14th, for the purpose of standing with him at the altar. She put them on, and arrayed herself in her bridal apparel, and met her lover, when some repulse or misunderstanding occurred, which suddenly determined her to live no longer. She was found with these bridal robes on, and wearing the gloves which she purchased on the night of her disappearance. Of course all this is mere conjecture, and Mr. Whitlock may be entirely innocent of her seduction, and of the subsequent wrong of which he is now suspected. The Rochester Democrat says that there is one circumstance which remains to complicate and throw further doubt upon the question. A woman, it is averred by two witnesses, was seen with the deceased on that dark night of her doom. Who she was remains an unsolved question, which defies all enquiry.

There are several Whitlocks shown in Rochester in 1855 and 1860 but it is not clear which "Mr. Whitlock" is referred to in the above. Obviously this situation did not end well. The details of how Emma died are not given.
