

WHITLOCK FAMILY NEWSLETTER

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This issue will mainly be made up of articles left over from the March issue. This is likely a good thing as I dislocated my shoulder the other day as well as broke three bones in my left foot. Trying to hop over a fence is not likely a good idea at 62!! Anyway typing is a little difficult but we will see how things go.

The past few months have involved working on Lawrence Otis' disc from last June which I still have not finished the huge collection of certificates from Dorset. This collection is filling in many blanks in the Dorset families and has also corrected some Wiltshire information. There were two Whitlocks who both married ladies named Emily Targett and both had connections to Winterslow, Wiltshire. The Dorset documents made the separation of these two families clear.

I have almost finished the blitz I was doing on the Yorkshire families. I just have a bit more of the 1871 census to complete and we will have 1841-1881 complete for Yorkshire. This work has allowed me to determine how a lot of the Yorkshire families fit together and I have updated the Yorkshire charts considerably.

I am also ready to do a major update on the Website which involves replacing all the databases with new and updated ones. While the actual source documents get uploaded to the website regularly the databases listing those items are only updated about once a year. This should happen once I am able to drive again.

I was interested to see that some of Bulstrode Whitlocke (1605-1675)'s books are now available on the Internet at www.archive.org. One I downloaded was his *Journal of The Swedish Embassy*, Vol II. This relates to the period 1653-1654 when Bulstrode was Cromwell's Ambassador to Queen Christina of Sweden. Fairly dry material but computer searchable for items of interest. I noted Bulstrode took two of his sons, including his eldest James with him to Sweden plus his cousin Colonel Potley and his son Andrew. This book includes an interesting account of their ship running aground on a sand bar during a storm and the night of peril they spent concerned the ship would break apart and they would drown. The storm eventually turned and the ship was freed and they anchored safely away from the bars for the rest of the night.

This account includes verbatim conversations Bulstrode and the Captain had regarding the seriousness of their situation and what course of action was open to them to free the ship. This talent Bulstrode had of being able to set down word for word conversations made him a valued negotiator. His recording of the conversations between Charles I and Oliver Cromwell attempting to negotiate an end to the English Civil War have survived and are in the British Museum Library.

More and more information is becoming available on-line. The latest items that caught my eye were from "Find My Past" who have released Irish Prison Registers 1790-1924 (X7191) and Index to Merchant Seamen (X7192). As with most on-line items they are indexes only and there is a cost to view the actual entry. The latter was quite extensive with five pages of Whitlocks and Whitelocks listed with dates and places.

I was interested to receive information from Anne Hawkins on the family of Charles Whitlock (1859-1929) writer and actor of Wolverhampton (X7196). His eldest son was Palmsun Day Whitlock (1904-1977) of Australia. Charles Whitlock wrote the play *The God of War* first performed June 1, 1903 at the Royal Theatre, Exeter. This family is part of the WHITLOCK18 chart, the Whitlocks of Somerset. Anne Hawkins also provided details on the ancestry of Charles Whitlock's wife, actor Georgina Vittery France. (X7198) This traces the France and Vittery families back to the 1600's.

My thanks to Jennifer Hart for the great detailed on the Crosley and Triquet descendants of Peter Whitlock (1702-1782) of Downholme, Yorkshire and St. Leonard's Shoreditch, London (X7213 - X7223) plus the continued postings of Jennifer Hart and Vicky House of Whitlock details on the Whitlock facebook page.

I recently received an enquiry and donation from someone researching the Pew family and their connection to the WHITLOCK16 family. He was asking if we had determined which Pew family the John Pew who married Susanna Whitlock in the 1690s was descended from. I researched this query by searching my files on Susanna Whitlock's father Thomas Whitlock (1623-1703). I then went into the website using the

“Sources” tab and the Search Box, typing in the word “Pew”. This brought up three pages of references where the word “pew” appears in the body of documents in our collection. This added another six source documents to the collection I had already searched. Of course the word “pew” is also a piece of furniture but those references were easy to ignore. I urge anyone who has not used the “Search” feature on the website to check it out. Punch a semi-unique word that relates to your family in and see what documents in our files contain that word. It is like having one 1,000,000+ page document that you can search easily.

Patrick’s catering business has kept us pretty busy and we just finished a 100+ wedding May 20. Was spectacular - food was great and the old linen and silver theme we used blew everyone’s mind. The Bride and Groom were particular happy which was the most important thing. Needless to say this has kept us at home more and traveling less. Subscriptions have dropped fairly dramatically this year from over 100 to just 72. The economy has been tough and I know a lot of people have just cut back on some of the extras. My thanks to all those who did renew for 2012 and to the many who added a little something extra to help fund the Whitlock Family Association. All very much appreciated.

I have not spent much time converting the last of my 3 x 5 cards to the database as I spent that time getting the main database ready for updating the website. I hope to work on this as time permits over the next year. I have been concentrating on getting the Deaths and Burials included in the hopes of eventually having everything pre-1900 included. One day.... I understand there more are Y-DNA results pending and I will be pleased to see them.

This year marks the 60th anniversary of the reign of Queen Elizabeth II. As the Queen is also a Whitlock descendant we are doing our bit to recognize this occasion. I am participating in celebrations in June at the local genealogy society where they are holding an “encounters with the Queen” evening. Several members are talking including one who’s father was an executive with CBC and was instrumental in arranging to broadcast the Coronation in 1953. I will be talking about the Ford Hill portrait collection of 300+ official portraits of the Queen that Professor Hill has now donated to the *American Friends of the National Portrait Gallery (London) Foundation* who has loaned the collection to the Gallery for five years. Ford Hill kindly donated one of the portraits the gallery already had to me and that is the one I will be displaying at the June meeting. I will also be talking about my cousin Pat Wright who, in 1959, escorted the Queen and Prince Philip on a private hunting and fishing holiday in the interior of British Columbia.

WILL OF ANNA ELIZA WHITELOCK, 1870

This is the last Will and Testament of me Anna Eliza Whitelock of Chatham in the County of Kent Spinster Direct that my funeral may be as private as decency will permit and after my debts funeral and testamentary expenses I give and bequeath to the Reverend John Edward White of St. Pauls Vicarage Chatham in the County of Kent all my moneys now in the hands or under the custody of the Reverend Richard Whitelock of Saddleworth, Yorkshire amounting to the sum of £813.0.0 Eight hundred and thirteen pounds thereabouts and also my gold watch and all my other effects excepting jewelry As to my jewelry I bequeath my turquoise broach and my emerald ring to Charlotte Julia Turner wife of the Reverend John Bowman Turner rector of Barford in the County of Norfolk and all the remainder I bequeath to Frances Ann Hughes wife of Hugh Hughes Esquire of Mount Place Brightling in the County of Sussex And I do hereby appoint the Reverend John Edward White aforesaid to be Sole Executor of this my Will In witness whereof I have in this my last Will set my hand this twenty sixth day of October Eighteen hundred and sixty seven - Anna Eliza Whitelock - Signed and acknowledged by the said Anna Eliza Whitelock as her Will in the presence of us present at the same time and who in her presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses - Anne Katherine Whitelock., C.R. Whitelock Col.H clls Indian Arm (Retd) of Belle Hatch Park, Harpedon, Oxon.

Proved at London 5th Oct. 1870 by the Oath of the Reverence John Edward White Clerk the sole Executor to whom Admin was granted.

This Anna Eliza Whitelock was the daughter of Rev. Richard Hutchins Whitelocke and his wife Frances Storer who were married in 1800 at Purley, Berkshire. The two witnesses to the will were her brother Col. Charles Robert Whitelock and his wife Anna Katherine (Storer) Whitelock. This family is detailed on the WHITLOCK21 chart.

WILL OF JOHN EDWARD WHITE 1880

This is The Last Will and Testament of me John Edward White, of Saint Pauls Vicarage, Chatham in the County of Kent Clerk in Holy Orders First I desire to testify that I die in the faith of Christ crucified and as a sinner saved by grace alone, humbly trusting for, my salvation in the merits of the blood and,of my Lord, Jesus Christ and desiring to give glory for this to the Jehovah the Father the Son and the Holy Ghost.

I direct that my funeral may be private and as little costly as decency will permit.

After payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I give and bequeath to my executors the sum of twenty five pounds to erect a suitable monument over the grave of Anna Eliza Whitelock, in Chatham Cemetery the said monument to be approved by her brother Colonel Charles Whitelock of Bell Hatch Park Oxon and Mrs Charlotte Julia Turner of Barford Rectory near Hymondham Norfolk unless during my lifetime the executor of the Will of the said Anna Eliza Whitelock do erect or cause to be erected the said monument then and in that case this bequest to be void.

I give and bequeath to the Church Missionary Society for Africa and the East the sum of three hundred pounds.

I give and bequeath the sum of ten pounds each to my sisters Isabella and Elizabeth.

I give and bequeath my gold watch and seal, which did belong to Anna Eliza Whitelock to Mrs. Hugh Anthony Whitelock to be presented to one of her daughters by the late Hugh Anthony Whitelock of Westmoreland Jamaica the daughter to be selected by the said Mrs. H. A. Whitelock and the receipt of Colonel Whitelock of Bell Hatch Park near Harpsden Oxfordshire or of Surgeon Major Thomas Whitelock of 18 Chalcott Terrace Primrose Hill to be sufficient release for my executors for the same.

I give the few silver forks and spoons and sugar tongs which I inherit under the will of the late Anna Eliza Whitelock to Mrs. Charlotte Julia Turner wife of the Revd. John Bowman Turner of Barford Rectory near Wymondham Norfolk, the said spoons forks are marked with the Whitelock ores or the Whitelock initials.

I give the Bible and Prayer Book which did belong to Anna Eliza Whitelock, the gift of her Godfather to Surgeon Thomas Whitelock, mentioned above.

I grant and bequest to my wife, Mary Arabella White the sum of ten pounds and I freely forgive her as I hope to be forgiven.

I give and bequeath to my son John Thomas (called John Warren)? White, of Winchester, my silver teapot presented to me by the Parishioners of Maralin my small, silver cream ewer, my silver pepper box my silver watch and all my nickel, silver forks and spoons also my plated sugar bowl and tongs.

I give and bequeath to my son, Algernon Warren White of Braybrook, Victoria, Australia all my silver coffee service presented to me by the Parishioners of Gertingthorpe in Essex.

I give and bequeath all my clothes and the Family Bible to my son William Henry Forbes White.

I give and bequeath to my executors the sum of twenty five pounds each for their trouble in performing the duties of the office And I give and bequeath the whole balance or residual of my monies or estate, whatever the values may be to be divided share and share alike between my three sons aforesaid, John Thomas, Algernon Warren and William Henry Forbes.

I direct that my furniture of all kinds not mentioned above and my books except those mentioned above may be sold and the proceeds to be applied to the purposes of this will.

And I hereby appoint my son John Thomas White and my Cousin John Edward Lewis, Lieut. Colonel, retired, late of Her Majesty's 68th Light Infantry or the survivor of them to be Executors of this my will As witness my hands this eleventh day of November in the year 1871 ----John Edward White----- Signed and Acknowledged by the said John Edward White as his last will and testament (the words "or residue" being first inserted between the 7th and 8th lines of this the last page)? in the presence of us being present at the same time who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our name as witnesses _____ William Henry Bennett Grocer 2/01 High Street Chatham _____ Maria Jane Walker 6 Whittaker Place New Road Chatham.

Proved at London, 24th March 1880 by the Oath of John Thomas White the Son the surviving Executor to whom Admin was granted.

The Anna Eliza Whitelock mentioned in this Will was the daughter of Rev. Richard Hutchins Whitelocke and his wife Frances Storer who were married at Purley, Berkshire in 1800. (See her will in this issue as well). Charlotte Julia Turner was Anna Eliza Whitelock's sister.

The Thomas Whitelock who was Anna Eliza Whitelock's Godfather was her older brother and the Thomas William Whitelock, Surgeon in the India Medical Service who was the subject of an article in the March 2011 issue. At the time the article was written we did not know who his parents were but thanks to research by Vicky House and Jennifer Hart we have been able to place these Whitelocks on the WHITLOCK21 chart, The Whitelocks of Yorkshire and Jamaica.

It was interesting to note that Rev White returned so many items left to him in the Will of Anna Eliza Whitelock to members of her family.

“As a side note my wife and I had an interesting drive recently as I wanted to investigate a couple of Islands off the West Australian coast, each called Whitlock Island.

There is one off Jurien Bay named after Frederick Bulstrode Lawson Whitlock obviously in your whitlock02 chart from Wokingham. He was a famous ornithologist which is behind the name. Geographical coordinates are -30.319049835 and 114.994003295 and its feature is Island

The second island off Carnarvon is from my Oxfordshire chart, named after Frank Abbott Whitlock who became mayor of Carnarvon in the early 1900s having been pivotal in local commerce as manager for Dalgety Farmers Ltd.

I hope you find this of interest and thanks for all your work. “

Frederick Bulstrode Lawson Whitlock was born Jun.3,1860 Nottingham, England the son of Thomas Oliver and Mary Anne (Taylor) Whitlock. He was married to Clara Ellen Neale Apr.28,1887 Nottingham and died June 15, 1953 Bunbury, Western Australia. Frederick was employed by Smith & Co., Bankers but the family, including two daughters left England in 1898 for Australia. A noted ornithologist, Frederick published several books on birds from 1908-1939.

Frank Abbott Whitlock was born in 1860 in Lambeth, London the son of Frank & Rebecca (Abbott) Whitlock. He died in Albany, Western Australia Sep.23,1930. Frank married Eve Frances Corrie Nov.21,1893 St.James the less, Plymouth, Devon. Eve was born in Australia in 1869. They had three children, including a daughter who died as an infant. This family is detailed on our WHITLOCK20 chart the Whitlocks of Oxfordshire.

THE LANDLADY AND THE SWEEP

The following newspaper article was sent to Dianne Sutton by a friend who knew her interest in Whitlocks. It is from the Bucks Herald, Newport Pagnell of Oct.25,1856

Petty Sessions Oct 22 nd (Before Mathew Knapp Esq, Rev A Chester and Rev Dr Langley) The Landlady and The Sweep - Frederick Whitlock, chimney sweeper of Wavendon, was charged with assaulting Mary Lee, who keeps the Fir Tree public-house, in the same parish, on the 3rd of October. The case having been adjourned from the last Petty Sessions in consequence of the complainant being too ill to attend. Complainant now stated that the defendant drove up to her door about ten o'clock on the night of the 3rd inst., just as she was in the act of closing the door. He called for a quart of beer; she saw he was intoxicated and refused to admit him or draw any beer. He forced himself into the house, and, with very abusive language, said he would not go until he had some beer. The old lady, who is sixty five years of age, said that she thought she would show a little spirit, so she took the poker and ordered him out; he instantly snatched it from her and knocked her down with it. Francis Lee, her son, stated that he was in bed, but hearing the disturbance, he came down. His mother was lying on the floor, bleeding very much, and the defendant had the poker in his hand, and threatened to serve witness in the same way, but witness succeeded in getting the poker from him and turning him out. A neighbour was sent for, who came and put Mrs Lee to bed. She had a severe wound on the head, the ear being cut through; she has been under surgical treatment ever since. Mr Jones appeared for the defence, and called the defendants lad, who was sitting in the cart at the door, and who stated that Mrs Lee struck defendant with the poker first. Mr Jones stated in mitigation, that the defendant had offered to make any compensation to Mrs Lee that she might require, immediately after the assault. The defendant was convicted in a penalty and costs of £4, or one months imprisonment.

Dianne also sent in this item showing Frederick was in trouble again 12 years later:

Northampton Mercury - Saturday 13 June 1868

"Fredk. Whitlock, of Woburn Sands, chimney sweeper, was charged [by] Charles Bowler of Hurstbourne Crawley, with stealing three dozen cabbages from his garden, on 23rd May.—The case occupied some time, and defendant was ultimately convicted, and fined 10s. and costs, which was paid for him by friend. — Mr. Stimson of Bedford, appeared for Whitlock."

Frederick Whitlock was baptized Nov.25,1821 at Wavendon, Buckinghamshire and buried at St.Michael's, Woburn Sands, Buckinghamshire Aug.10,1897. He was the son of Mary Ann Whitlock the daughter of Thomas & Sarah (Lester) Whitlock. Frederick's father was possibly Thomas Collins as Thomas & Mary Ann had banns of marriage read in July 1821 in Aylesbury but the marriage never took place. (Although it is equally as likely that the reason the wedding did not take place was because Thomas discovered Mary Ann was already pregnant by another man.)

Frederick married Jane Hudson at Woburn, Bedfordshire Oct.30,1842 and they had three children born 1843 to 1848. The Keech family of Toronto, Ontario, Canada descends from their daughter Mary Anne Whitlock (1845?-1884)

JAMES WHITLOCK, REVOLUTIONARY WAR SOLDIER

In the pension file for Christopher Doughty there is the following affidavit:

“Some short time after my secont inlistment there was an other Company came down from uper freehold monmoth County New Jersey & was stationed about 3 miles farther down towards Sandy hook & we were shifted one half the Company or Nearly so - from one station to the other as relief the Duty were so plenty on Sandy hook - frequently Doing mischeif in them parts as to the Time I inlisted for I Cannot Determin that is gone from me it was of Little Consiquence to me at that period. as I was resolved to remain in the service - as long as the war Lasted - and wether it was for 3 months or 6 months I Dare not say - but I know our service was severe Day & Night wet and cold untill the second of January 1777 we were betrayed by our Ensign Cornelious M Claye with the asistance of 3 of his Confidents the on he placed as sentinels = at the Dawn of Day we were Captured with the loss of one man shot through the body his name was **James Whitlock** a fine yong man and a good soldier - both Companied Drove on to Sandy hook Like Sheep for the Slatter - Except 3 or four that made there Escape - but in what way our Captain Stilwill made his Escape, I never heard - when we arrived Near to the Light house - some sent to the ships & some put on board of a large scoonner and storied in the hole among the watter Casks - it was the 26 rigment of british troops that took .. with the asistance of the refugees and those that were under there Care fared well for food - wile on bord at the ship - but those on bord of the scoonner fared badly with a tory Captain in about 3 days we were sent to New York, some to the North Church and some to the sugar house and some to the Hospital, on Cowfoot Hill green street - Now Perl Street = it was the quakers meeting house - about the Last of January I was taken to Nurs the sick in the hospital, and Doctor Wiggins from middle town on the Suykahanah, who was also a prisoner on Parole - and the head Doctor was from boston - he apeared to be much at a gentleman, I do not remember his name - I served as Nurs for the month of February & march 1777 worn down for the want of rest was glad to go to the shugar house again and was Let to go = a Lesson to gard me from thence on the tenth of July - 1778 I made my Escape taking with me 3 yong men that was also prisoners - and landed safe on the shore of middle town township monmoth County New Jersey the 11 - 1778, on the morning of the Eleventh of July our handkerchiefs worn out with muffling the oars to keep from being heard by the Enemy”

This information about the death January 2, 1777 of James Whitlock is new to me and I am not sure how he fits into the family. I would assume he is likely part of the WHITLOCK16 clan but I do not have an unaccounted for James Whitlock for that family who would fit the time period.
