

# WHITLOCK FAMILY NEWSLETTER

The purpose of this research is assist Whitlock descendants in putting together the most accurate picture of their ancestors and to gain the greatest understanding of their heritage. In most cases proof of the ancestral line is reasonably verifiable back to the mid 1800's. Prior to that period you have to do more sleuthing and make educated estimates of the likely line of ascent based on the documents available. There are therefore going to be errors and trick is to recognize when there has been an error and to correct it as soon as possible.

Over the years our researchers have documented many errors, mostly minor but a few have been major and have resulting in wholesale changes to the line of ancestry. One such error was mentioned in the March 2013 issue of the Newsletter and I have done an article for this issue that details why we believe an error has occurred. The affects the WHITLOCK25 chart and specifically the descendants of Thomas Whitlock of Rowan Co., North Carolina who married firstly Catherine Steelman in 1794 and secondly Mary Ponsonbay in 1799. I have reviewed the research by Bobby Minish and have to concur with his findings. My thanks to Bobby Minish for his work on this part of the family and to Mandane Ennis for bringing this to our attention. I will be interested in comments.

As with most research, as you solve one mystery, you tend to uncover the next one. The research into the Whitlocks of North Carolina made me realize there are two viable candidates for which James Whitlock was the son of James Whitlock & Agness Christmas of Virginia. This James was born about 1740 and the possible candidates head the WHITLOCK23 and WHITLOCK87 charts respectively. Both fit for time period and location. I have speculated that YDNA will likely show they both descend from the same family and if we are lucky, one day we will uncover the answers we are looking for.

One of the articles in this issue also relates to other items in the March issue of the Newsletter as I did not have space to include everything. This includes the Will of Salome Whitelock of Wimbledon. I will include the Will of her brother Benjamin Whitelock in the next issue.

The past few months have seen some interesting developments. In addition to the Will mentioned, this issue includes the 1845 Will of Henry William Whitlock of Powhatan Co., Virginia. The collection of 651 pages of documents relating to Henry's estate, recently found on-line by Tina Adams, is a great addition to our collection. The business ledgers for the H.W. Whitlock & Son company provide amazing detail into life in the 1840's in rural Virginia.

Other items of interest include the rest of the North Carolina & Kentucky records relating to the Whitlock and Jones families received from Mandane Ennis (R3381-R3403).

There are the latest additions to our Census collection. I am currently working on Hampshire. With its connections to the Wiltshire families it is one of larger Whitlock British counties.

My thanks to Mandane Ennis for the 1799 Will of Ornan Whatley of Oglethorpe Co., Georgia (X7414). An interesting Will as three of his children married Whitlocks from the same family. Ornan Bradley Whatley married Elizabeth Willingham Whitlock, his brother Burwell Whatley married Elizabeth's sister Polly Jerrald Whitlock and their sister Tabitha Whatley was married to Elizabeth & Polly's father John Whitlock. This made their sister Tabitha their step-mother-in-law. Lots of interesting material received this quarter. Thanks to everyone who sent in their finds.

There has been quite a bit of activity on the Website and subscriptions and donations continue to come in, both through the "donate" button on the Website and through the mail. I have a good collection of Main Lines from new contacts and I will be printing them in the next few issues. Many thanks to all.

I am in the process of planning my next trip to Salt Lake City - likely during the last two weeks of September. While I want to concentrate on finishing the British Wills 1858-1966, I am gathering together a list of other items for attention while there. ## WILL OF SALOME WHITELOCK 1836

**This is the last Will** and Testament of me Salome Whitelock of Wimbledon in the County of Surrey Spinster I nominate constitute and appoint William Meyrick of Red Lion Square in the County of Middlesex Esquire and William Henry Meyrick of Berkely Square in the same County a Lieutenant in His Majesty's Service **Executors** hereof I request to be buried in the late Mr. & Mrs. Meyricks Vault at Wimbledon according to her permission as mentioned in her Will I direct that my funeral and testamentary expenses and my just Debts be in the first place fully paid and satisfied I give and bequeath to my Brother Benjamin Whitelock all that my leasehold house and premises situate at Wimbledon aforesaid To hold unto the said Benjamin Whitelock his executors admors and assigns for all residue to my Estate term and interest therein Together with all my fixtures furniture cooking glasses culinary articles household china (except the ornamental china hereinafter disposed) & glass linen plate wines pictures prints books work and other ornamental Boxes (except Lady Nightingalls two Worl India boxes one of which I give and bequeath to her niece Clara Telf Sharp and the other to her niece Amelia Sharp and all the articles in them appertaining thereto respectively) I give and bequeath to Lady Laura Meyrick the wife of the said Lieutenant Colonel Meyrick two dresden china Vases a dresden china Basket a pair of Dresden china groups of figures and one india china Beaker all of which are labelled with Lady Laura's name All the rest of the ornamental china I give and bequeath to my said brother all green lions plants lights garden utensils china flower pots vases and flower baskets and all my watches (except the late Mr. Meyrick's two repeaters which I give and bequeath to the said William Henry Meyrick) I likewise give and bequeath to my said Brother Benjamin Whitelock the sum of two thousand pounds and to his Wife Elizabeth Whitelock Two hundred pounds and the India cups and Saucers given to me by her I give and bequeath to my Executors the said William Meyrick and William Henry Meyrick the sum of one hundred pounds each for their trouble in executing the Trusts of this my Will I give to Lieutenant General George Meyrick one hundred pounds I give to the said Lady Laura Meyrick Two hundred pounds and to her daughter Elizabeth Laura Meyrick one hundred pounds I give and bequeath to Miss Maria Tierney Two hundred pounds and to her sister Madeline Tierney one hundred pounds I give to Miss Ann Lee daughter of James Lee of West Retford in the County of Nottingham Esquire one hundred pounds I give to Fanny Bridges the wife of Sir Henry Bridges of Beddington on hundred pounds I give to the said William Meyrick of Red Lion Square the further sum of one hundred pounds I give to Captain Charles Mayra one hundred pounds I give to Sir Andrew Halliday M.D. Fifty pounds free of legacy duty I give to the said William Henry Meyrick the further sum of Two hundred pounds I also give and bequeath to him the following family portraits namely one of the said late James Meyrick Esquire one of my late sister Mrs. Meyrick and one of myself all of which are in the drawing room of my house at Wimbledon aforesaid I also give and bequeath to the said William Henry Meyrick my alabaster Vases complete also me India Cabinet with the contents in it and the stand it is upon also my Birds Glass case and stand it is upon I return give and bequeath to the said Elizabeth Laura Meyrick the Broach with her Hair her Derbyshire Ornament and Bracelet of her Mama's hair the Broach with her Grand papa's hair his portrait and her papa's portrait I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Robbins one hundred pounds if living with me at the time of my death or to any other female filling her situation I also give and bequeath to the said Elizabeth Robbins or in case of her death to the Successor in her place all my wearing apparel of every description unless I shall give any articles to Friends by any Codicil to this my Will I give to Ann Watts Twenty pounds if living with me at the

time of my decease I give to Rachael Last Twenty pounds if living with me at the time of my decease I give to Joseph Escott Twenty pounds if living with me at the time of my decease I also give to Mr. Malcolm Twenty pounds if living with me at the time of my decease I also give and bequeath to each of the five abovenamed legatees the sum of six pounds for mourning the said five last mentioned legacies to be free and clear of duty and lastly I give and bequeath unto the said William Meyrick and William Henry Meyrick their executors admons and assigns all the **Rest Residue and Remainder** of my estate and effects of what nature or kind soever To hold the same unto the said William Meyrick and William Henry Meyrick their executors and admons of such survivor do and shall continue or lay out and invest the same in the public Stock or funds and upon Government and other securities and do and shall pay the interest dividends and annual produce thereof unto the said Benjamin Whitelock for his use or benefit or permit the same to be received by him during his life and after the decease of my said Brother Benjamin Whitelock do and shall pay transfer or assign the Capital unto and divide the same equally between or amongst the children of my said Brother if more than one who shall attain the age of twenty one years and the issue of any such children ho shall die under that age such issue to take the same share as the Parent would have been entitled to receive at the age of twenty one and to take vested interests at that age and if there shall be only one child of my said Brother who shall live at attain the age of twenty one and there shall be no issue of any deceased child then Upon Trust to pay transfer or assign the same unto such one child so attaining the age of twenty one years and so do and shall after the decease of my said Brother and in the incontinue until the shares hereby provided for his children or Grandchildren shall become vested and payable pay and apply all or any part of the dividends interest and annual produce of the expectant share or shares of any such children or grandchildren for or towards his her or their maintenance and education and if my said brother shall leave no child or Grandchildren who shall attain the age of twenty one years then I give and bequeath the whole of such residue and the funds and securities in which the same may be invested to the said William Henry Meyrick his executors admons and assigns absolutely and I do hereby expressly declare and direct that my said Trustee shall not be answerable to accountable the one for the other of them for any more money than they respectively shall actually receive notwithstanding their joining in any receipts or conformity and that they shall not be answerable for any involuntary loss misfortune nor for the deficiency of any security and that they shall be allowed to retain and reimburse themselves all Costs charges damages and expenses which may be occasioned in or about the trusts hereby reposed in them or in anywise relating thereto In Witness where I the said Salome Whitelock the testatrix have to this my last Will and Testament contained in three sheets of paper my hand and seal that is to say my hand to the first two sheets thereof and my hand and seal to this third and last sheet thereof the thirtieth day of July one thousand eight hundred and thirty three — *Salome Whitelock* Signed sealed published and declared by the said Salome Whitelock in the presence of us ---- *Wm Maders Wimbledon Surrey Gent — Joseph Lockhart Wimbledon Surry Gent*

**Codicils** to Salome Whitelock's Will My dear William Henry Meyrick I feel sure whatever I address to you & Mr. Meyrick as my executors will be attended to I request you will have my funeral as respectable as Mr. Meyrick & you consider would be satisfactory do not accept of Carriages to attend me do not allow me to be fastened down till I am changed I desire not to be opened as it is of no consequence what an old person dies of I beg you to give as a compliment from me ten pounds to Mr. Lindsay or Mr. Edelman if either perform the funeral Service as Mr. Shrubsole of Kingston was employed as undertaker for Mr. Wright of Wimbledon I gave satisfaction it will be more convenient to have him than any person from Town the first day of October one thousand eight hundred and thirty four — *Salome Whitelock of Wimbledon*

and during such time he hath frequently seen her write and subscribe her name and thereby came well to know and be acquainted with her manner and character of handwriting and subscription and the said Lewis Edward Engelbach for himself saith that he well knew the said Salome Whitelock spinster deceased and that during the time he this Deponent hath been with the said Mess'rs Coutts & Company who were the deceased's Bankers he hath frequently seen and paid Cheques upon them which he well knew were written and addressed by the said deceased to the said Firm and signed by her That be reason thereof he hath come well to know and be acquainted with her manner and character of handwriting and subscription of the said deceased and these Deponents having now carefully looked upon and inspected the paper writings now hereto annexed purporting to be and contain two codicils to the last Will and Testament of the said deceased the first of the said Codicils beginning thus "Codicils to Salome Whitelock's Will my dear William Henry Meyrick" ending thus "it will be more convenient to have him than any person from Town the first day of Oct'r one thousand eight hundred and thirty four and thus subscribed Salome Whitelock Wimbledon" the second of the said Codicils beginning thus "I return to Lady Nightingall the long spriged India Shawl given to me by her Ladyship" ending thus "These Codicils are written & signed by myself the first day of Oct'r one thousand eight hundred & thirty four" and thus subscribed "Salome Whitelock Wimbledon" they say that they do verify and in their consciences believe the whole body series and contents of the said two Codicils beginning and ending as aforesaid and the names "Salome Whitelock" respectively of her the said Salome Whitelock deceased ---- *Joseph Escott* ---- On the seventeenth day of Aug't one thousand eight hundred and thirty six the said Joseph Escott was duly sworn to the truth of this affidavit before me *John Daubeny Surr of Pres't F. C. Austin Not Pub L E. Engelbach* On the seventeenth day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty six the within named Lewis Edward Engelbach was duly sworn to the truth of this affidavit before me *John Daubeny Surr of Pres't F. 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Salome Whitelock was born Jan.23,1765 in the Parish of All Hallows, Bread Street, London. She was the daughter of John Whitlock and Ann Lutkens. Among her brothers and sisters were Benjamin Whitelock (1763-1853) merchant of 46, Lime Street who lived in Putney and Ann Whitelock who married James Meyrick May 25,1779. Women's wills tend to be much more detailed than men's and Salome's Will is a great example of this. Salome makes her Will and Codicils from 1833 to 1834 when she is in her late 60's. Salome Whitelock died August 3, 1836 at Wimbledon.

James & Ann (Whitelock) Meyrick do not appear to have had any children. The Meyrick's mentioned in Salome's will are James Meyrick's half-brothers William M. Meyrick, General George Meyrick and his nephew Lieutenant - Colonel William Henry Meyrick, the son of James' half brother Thomas Meyrick. Thomas' wife was Elizabeth the illegitimate daughter of Admiral Keppel. Their son was Lieutenant Colonel William Henry Meyrick, who with his uncle William were the executors of Salome's Will. William Henry Meyrick (1790-1865) was married Feb.24,1823 to Lady Laura Vane, the daughter of William Henry Vane, the 1<sup>st</sup> Duke of Cleveland.

## WILL OF HENRY WILLIAM WHITLOCK 1845

I Henry W. Whitlock do hereby make my last will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, First I give and bequeath to the Wife, Frances E. Whitlock, a certain tract of land, commencing at the Jefferson Mills, and thence to follow the fence, as it now runs in a straight line to the lands of Elizabeth Aston, including eighteen acres bought of Eugene Swann & to follow the road by Mrs. Clarke's house to the Main road leading from Jefferson to Michaux's Ferry and to cross the road, so as to include the lower half of the Woodlands beyond the Jefferson road adjoining the lands of Dan'l. P. Steger. And should any portion of the above named lands be sold under a deed or deeds of Trust for the benefit of my creditors, I wish my Wife to have such portion of my other lands as she may select, provided it does not exceed in value the part so sold, & should all my lands be sold, I wish her to have negroes if sufficient, if not other property to the value of the lands from which she shall be so excluded. I also give to my Wife Frances E. all my household and kitchen furniture of every kind also the house and land adjoining the Jefferson Mills free of toll. I also give my Wife Frances E. Six cows, twelve head of sheep, sixteen killing hogs, one yoke of oxen, one ox cart, four mules, two wagons, all of my crop of corn and oats, and as much seed wheat as she may want to sow, all of which I give her during he life and at her death to be equally divided between my children Mary Elizabeth, Ann Enora Watkins, Emily Catherine, Frances Adelaide and Alice Victoria. The above named stock to be selected by my wife.

2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my sons Armistead A. And William W. Whitlock, their riding horses. Armistead A. Is to have a sorel colt, if he desires it, and Wm W a sorel mare.

3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my three sons Armistead A., Wm. W. And Chastain B. Whitlock, the Jefferson Mills, ferry and store house, lumber house, dwelling house & lot attached thereto together with the lot between the mill and the river.

4<sup>th</sup> I give to my son James M. Whitlock, the sum of two hundred dollars, and I give to my son Patrick H. Whitlock the sum of three hundred dollars to be left in the hands of my son James M. Whitlock as Trustee, for the use and benefit of my said son P.H. Whitlock to be used and disposed of by the said James M. Whitlock as Trustee for the benefit of my said son P.H. Whitlock at the discretion of the said James M. Whitlock & not to the discretion of the said P.H. Whitlock but it is in no way to be appropriated in whole or in part to the payment of the debts of the said P.H. Whitlock.

5<sup>th</sup> I give to my daughter Caroline M. Whitlock one bed and furniture, one bureau, one negro girl or boy or such a one as she may select out of the negroes coming from Moseley's estate in Hanover.

6<sup>th</sup> It is my wish and desire that my Executor make sale of all the balance of my estate both real and personal and after the payment of all my debts, if any money remain, I wish it equally divided between my children, James M., Patrick H. and Caroline M. Whitlock, and portions coming to my son P.H. Whitlock I desire to go into the hands of my son James M. as Trustee herein before mentioned.

7<sup>th</sup> I leave to my executors the collecting of all claims due to me by bond, account, or any other way whatsoever.

8<sup>th</sup> It is my wish and desire that Richard F. Graves act as my Executor to administer this my last Will & Testament.

At a Court of Quarterly Sesson begun and held for Powhatan County at the Courthouse thereof on Monday the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1845. The foregoing last Will and Testament of Henry W. Whitlock dec'd was presented in Court & Proved by the oaths of John C. Stratton and William A. Scruggs, two of the subscribing witnesses to the same, and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Richard F. Graves, the Executor named in the said Will, who made oath thereto according to the law & together with Richard Bass, Bennett M. Bagby and Wilson Winfree, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, a certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form.

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Henry William Whitlock was born in Powhatan Co., Virginia likely in the 1780s as he was age 50 to 60 on the 1840 census. We have not yet determined who his parents were. He married Lucretia Legg Oct.18,1815 in Powhatan Co. and they had three children, James Madison Whitlock, Carolina M. Whitlock & Patrick H. Whitlock. Henry W. married as his second wife, Frances E. (Allen) Seayers Oct.10,1826 in Henrico Co., Virginia. The youngest seven children are from this marriage.

Henry ran several businesses in Franklin, Powhatan Co. including a Ferry service, a tavern and a store. In 1841 he entered into a partnership with his eldest son, James Madison Whitlock. There was a partnership agreement drawn up but Henry, who could neither read nor write, did not think it was required and would not sign it. Following Henry's death in October 1845 there was a long legal suit resulting from the partnership and over how much of Henry's estate belonged to James Madison Whitlock. A huge collection of 651 pages of documentation has survived and is in the Virginia Archives (our reference R3425). This includes two Day books and the Ledger of the business James Madison Whitlock and Henry William Whitlock operated in Franklin 1841-1842. The collection also includes the Wills of Henry William Whitlock and his father-in-law Christian Allen. Frances E. Allen was married first to a Seayers and had at least one child when she married Henry Whitlock. Charles Allen acted at Surety for Frances' marriage to Henry in 1826.

I have added this family to the end of the WHITLOCK23 chart as likely connect to the Henrico Co., Whitlocks. Our thanks to Tina Adams who found these documents on-line at the Virginia Archives. I am also in contact with Bob Wright who descends from Henry's son Armistead A. Whitlock.

## THOMAS WHITLOCK OF ROWAN CO., NORTH CAROLINA

I raised the issue of a major correction to the WHITLOCK25 chart in the last issue and I will try to explain the reason for the change here.

In the research provided by Mandane Ennis and Bobby Minish, into the Whitlocks of North Carolina, it is proposed that Thomas Whitlock who married Catherine the daughter of William Steelman (1794) & Mary Ponsonbay (1799) was actually the son of James Whitlock & Sylvia Jones who head the WHITLOCK87 chart. Currently we show him on the WHITLOCK25 chart as one of the sons of Charles & Esther Whitlock. He is first married to Catherine Steelman April 2, 1794 in Rowan Co., North Carolina. They have one daughter born in 1796 and Catherine dies, possibly in childbirth. Thomas marries as his second wife Mary Ponsonbay May 17, 1799 in Surry Co., North Carolina. Thomas & Mary have seven more children including a daughter Sylvia born in 1817.

It appears Charles & Esther Whitlock and James & Sylvia (Jones) Whitlock both had sons John, James & Thomas. Both lived in North Carolina. The deciding factor that separates these two families is that we know James Whitlock the son of Charles moved to Grainger Co., Tennessee as early as 1797. Bobby Minish therefore proposes the John, James and Thomas Whitlock that show together in Rowan Co., North Carolina must be the sons of James & Sylvia (Jones) Whitlock. The fact that Thomas names a daughter Sylvia adds even more weight to Bobby's proposal.

The following are Bobby Minish's notes that appear in our NCLAND file:

'The correct Thomas Whitlock makes his first appearance in the Surry County records on November 9, 1795 when he purchases 128 acres on the North Fork of Dutchman's Creek from William Steelman. The land is described as "adjoining the Rowan County line, Thomas Cook, and Jesse Reavis." Later land and tax records would seem to indicate that the amount of land was actually 130 acres.

The following year a deed is written up in Surry County on May 7, 1796 showing Thomas Whitlock selling 80 acres of land on Dutchman's Creek to a George Moore of Rowan County which was witnessed by John Reavis and William Steelman. I don't believe the 80 acres he sold in 1796 was part of his 128 acre purchase from William Steelman because when Thomas makes his first appearance in the Surry County tax lists in 1796 for Captain Hudspeth's District, and the following year, he is shown still owning 130 acres of land and listed adjacent his brother James Whitlock. By 1798, county tax lists show him having acquired an additional 95 acres on Hunting Creek which was finalized in a deed from Matthew Brooks of Stokes County on September 16, 1799. This land was later sold to Reuben McDaniel on November 11, 1815. Reuben McDaniel was the brother of Isaac Jones' son Wiley's wife Nancy. The tax list for 1799 once again shows Thomas owning 225 acres in Surry County, but more importantly, it shows him listed adjacent Bennet Wood.

The deed that really pulls James, John, and Thomas Whitlock together can be found in Surry County and was written up on New Years Day in the year 1803. On this day Thomas Whitlock can be found selling his 1795 130 acre purchase on the North Fork of Dutchman's Creek to a man named Joahua Brown with John and James Whitlock acting as witnesses.'

I think Bobby's research is methodical and logical and reaches the correct conclusion. The fact the brothers, John, James & Thomas of Rowan Co. remain tied together through the Dutchman's Creek land transactions as late as 1803 is significant. The final deciding factor is that the name of Thomas' mother, Sylvia Jones is honored by being carried on for several generations. Thomas names a daughter Sylvia in 1817 and his son William Holeman Whitlock names a daughter Sylvia Caroline in 1857.

The conclusion is therefore that I am recommending we correct this error on the charts and move Thomas Whitlock and his descendants from the WHITLOCK25 chart to the WHITLOCK87 chart.

While we do not know yet who the parents are for James Whitlock who married Sylvia Jones, I suspect that YDNA testing of descendants will likely show they are part of the same family. We know Charles who married Esther had a brother James but whether this James is the one who heads the WHITLOCK23 chart or the WHITLOCK87 chart is not yet determined. Interestingly James Whitlock & Sylvia Jones named a daughter Agness. If James is the brother of Charles Whitlock, his mother would be Agness (Christmas) Whitlock.

## CYRIL DOUGLAS WHITLOCK (1918-2013)

By D.A.Keith Whitlock ( East Grinstead)

Peter, this is the point to tell you that sadly Cyril Whitlock, my father's last brother, passed away in his ninety fifth year on 17th of January. He found the family history fascinating and we spent many happy hours talking about it. In fact he made a sort of pilgrimage to Langtree. Just before he died he saw his father's signature for the first time in his life, sent to me by John Whitlock ( Essex), which had appeared on a couple of ships' manifests in 1904/1906.

Cyril, like my father Albert Whitlock, was born (on 1st June 1918) at 3 Alexandra Terrace, Teignmouth, Devon. He attended the local Grammar School and entered local government mainly in London. As a young man he was an excellent swimmer and soccer player who turned down the chance of a professional trial. He served in the war in the Eighth Army and was away for six and a half years. At first he was the youngest Quarter Master Sergeant in the British Army initially in the City of London Artillery providing air defence against German bombing. Then the artillery moved to Egypt as part of the Eighth Army fighting the Italians and Germans. Under Montgomery they trapped Rommel and drove the Axis back till they surrendered in Tunisia. He was awarded the British Empire Medal (Military) for leading a train of lorries out of danger and back to headquarters in preparation for the counter attack at El Alamein. His unit then crossed to Sicily and the Italian mainland where the decision was taken to convert them into infantry, so he completed his military service in the Royal West Kents This new now allied army, drove the Germans up the spine of Italy till they surrendered in the Po valley. He witnessed the surrender of many units. He remarked in words that are relish to an Englishman: we were a citizen army and we beat the professionals. He retired early with heart trouble from the London borough of Merton in 1972. On his first wife's death in 1989 he determined to have a heart by-pass, which was so successful that he lived a wonderfully long life, marrying a second time ( both his wives were called Joan) and surviving what he called very happy marriages. He died in dignity in his own home having determined that he did not wish to be an invalid in a nursing home. We are very proud of him.

I shall miss him. I hope to take his ashes to Teignmouth in Devon for interment in his mother's grave.

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Cyril was the son of William Thomas James & Elizabeth (Lamble) (Hook) Whitlock. He married as his first wife Helinor Joan Mary Barton (1916-1989) January 11, 1941. He second wife was Joan Berry Violet (Staddon) Brown whom he married Sep.30,1999 in Weybridge, Surrey. Cyril and his first wife had one son Douglas Alexander Whitlock born just after the War in 1946. Cyril was a long time subscriber and supporter of the Whitlock Family Association and his family is detailed on the WHITLOCK01 chart.
