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As you will see from the lack of additions in this issue, it has been a quiet summer, genealogically speaking. Patrick and I took several weeks off and did our annual trek to Springfield, Missouri to visit with his "aunt" Alexandra. We visited with a couple of Patrick's nieces in Fort Collins, Colorado and Omaha, Nebraska and on our way back stayed with friends in Denver, Colorado.

Our first stop on the way home was in Wichita, Kansas to visit with John Leslie Whitlock and it was great to finally meet. John's family is detailed on the WHITLOCK92 chart and can be traced back to Germany with origins likely in England but it is unknown how far back the English connection is. I have known about his ancestor, Frederick Whitlock (1790s-1846) of Farmington, Iowa for years and was very pleased to finally meet a descendant. I have wondered if the family is descended from the Whitlocks of Wokingham, a branch of which went to live in Prussia in the 1580's. The family kept the English spelling of their name well into the 1800's and it is likely that most descendants on the male line still spell the name Whitlock. John had some interesting family papers but nothing relating to Frederick's family in Germany prior to coming to America in 1837. Research into John's family will be one my priorities during my annual research week in Salt Lake City in October. Hopefully in the future we will get a DNA sample from a member of this family and see what that tells us. (See Main Line ML430 in this issue)

When we travel I normally take along some family history work to do during down time. On this trip I managed to finally catalogue all the female marriages from the St. Catherine's house records 1837-1870 that I had extracted while living in England in 1970/1 and the 1871 to 1903 female marriages extracted by Janis Kirby in 1986. I had only originally catalogued the male entries and had never gone back to add the female ones. These are now all included in our master index. I also finally tackled the St. Catherines house death records and catalogued up to 1872 of the 1837-1876 records extracted by Maisie Whitlock in 1988. This expanded the master database file of births, marriages, deaths and Wills to over 43,400 entries.

Over the past few months I have continued work on the British Wills 1858-1966 and have catalogued up to 1922 so far. I have extracted images of these Wills up to 1873 and plan to work on the rest during my week in Salt Lake City in October. Even the few details given in the index has allowed me to connect most of the Wills to their families and has enabled me to expand and link several additional families to our charts. I have used these Wills to put together a short Power Point presentation entitled *Using Wills to Link the Generations*. I will be talking on this at a conference in October. I have also arranged to give a talk at the Library in Salt Lake City on October 2 entitled *Unusual British Sources* based on the Whitlock Family Association, One-Name research files. This gives researchers an idea what kind of information some of the less used sources contain as well as giving an overview of the extent of a One-Name Study such as the Whitlock Family Association. Hopefully I will meet others with Whitlock ancestors at the Library.

Two of the articles for this issue are based on Wills and Benjamin Whitlock's connects with the ones included in the March and June issues. In doing research for the article on David Whitlock (1757?-1798) of Hanover Co., Virginia I found images on the Internet from a Whitlock-Wingfield Family Bible printed in 1767 that was unknown to me (R3430). The article details why this was such an amazing find.

I hope the article on Sir William Gore Ouseley is of interest. There is a tendency to get sidetracked from time to time and this article is the result of one of those side trips. I was working on the 1871 Cornwall census and noticed one of the charges of a Whitlock governess had the given name Ouseley and I was curious to know what the connection might be as I knew there were Whitlocke connections to the Ouseley family.

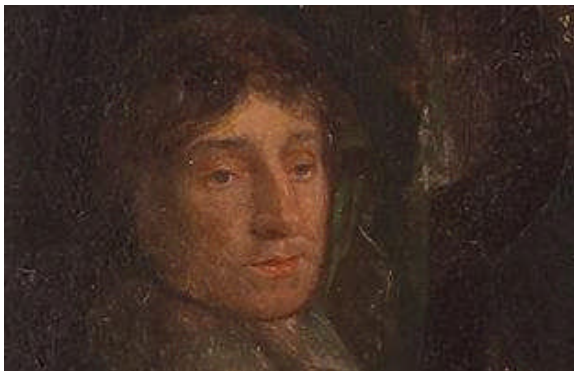
Jennifer Hart continues to uncover additional details on the WHITLOCK21 family, The Whitlocks of Downholme, Yorkshire (X7463-X7465). I was very pleased to receive the emails from Billy Bond (X7468) that added more descendants of Joseph & Mildred (Whitlock) Bond (M1821) shown on the WHITLOCK35 chart. Always appreciated.

I was very pleased to receive the email from Bjorn Witlox of Amsterdam regarding the website on the restoration of the *Trial of Strafford* painting that hangs in the British Parliament buildings (PH1521).

Interesting that they used the portrait of Sir Bulstrode Whitelocke (1605-1675), the painting contains, as an example of “before and after” the restoration process. I assume the portrait the artist used for Bulstrode’s likeness was one done about 1641 when the trial took place but I had not seen it before.

Interest in the website has continued and the amount of data downloaded continues to grow each month. I still have not tackled Lawrence Otis latest disc and will have to get to work on that. I have continued work on our Census collection and you can see in the Reference items what has been added.

As the summer winds down and we get into the fall routine researchers will get back to their hobbies and I look forward hearing progress reports and resulting questions from both new and long time genealogists.

WILL OF BENJAMIN WHITELOCK OF PUTNEY, UPPER RICHMOND, SURREY 1853

I Benj'n Whitlock of Putney in the County of Surrey being of sound & disposing mind do hereby publish & declare this as and for my last will & Testament Revoking & I do hereby revoke any Will or Wills Codicil or Codicils heretofore made by me I hereby nominate & appoint my sons The Rev'd Benj Whitlock & John Will'm Whitlock Exec'rs to this my Will I wish all my just debts & funeral expenses which I desire may not exceed those incurred at the time of the decease of my late dear wife to be fully paid & satisfied It is my desire to be buried in Putney burial ground in the same vault as was prepared for my said dear departed I give & bequeath to my son The Rev'd Benj Whitlock all my freehold Estate 14 Burroughs Bui'gs now 91 Great Surrey Street in the Parish of Christ Church & in the County of Surrey to him his heirs exec'rs admins & assigns forever I also give to my said son eighty Ship Charter shares in the London Assurance Four thousand pounds stock in the 3 p'nt Cons & Five thousand pounds Stock in the 3 + p'ct I then give & bequeath to my daughter Ann Salome Whitlock the beneficial lease of my house at Putney to her her exec'rs admins & assigns with all the furniture jewels plate & effects in and about the said premises I give further to my said daughter three thousand six hundred & fifty pounds stock in the 3 p'ct Cons & Fve thousand pounds stock in the 3 1/4 p'ct I then give & bequeath to my son John William Whitlock my Leasehold estate No 26 now 32 Great Charlotte Street in the Parish of Christ Church & in the County of Surrey with the fixtures therein to him his Ex'r adm's & assigns I further give to my said son John William Seventy shares in the Fire department of the London Assurance Three thousand six hundred & fifty pounds stock in the 3 p'ct Cons & further to him my said son Two thousand five hundred pounds stock in in 3+ p'ct I then direct **The Rest & Residue** of my property save & except such legacies I may be disposed to leave may be divided into three equal portions or shares to my son The Rev'd Benj Whitlock I give one portion or share & to my daughter Ann Salome Whitlock I also give one portion or share & to my son John William I give the remaining third portion or share Item give to Mrs. Mary Peyton of 12 Clapton Square the sum of one hundred pounds but if

any difficulty should arise as to the discharge for the same I then leave the said legacy of one hundred pounds to Will^m Henry Lane Esqr of Barnes Surrey I further give to Mr. James Peyton Susan Peyton & Samuel Peyton to each the sum of nineteen guineas I further give to William Henry Lane of Barnes Esq^r & Emily the wife of the said Willm Henry Lane to each the sum of ten pounds I give also to Thomas Lane of Antiqua Esq to Elizabeth his Wife & to Harriet their daughter to each three the sum of ten pounds I leave to Wilkins Wife of Henry Wilkens Esq of Waltham the sum of Ten pounds & like sum of Ten pounds to Mary the daughter of the said Henry Wilkins I leave further the sum of one hundred pounds to Caroline Armstrong of Chelsea & to Henry Arthur Spitter of Clapham Esq I leave the sum of ten pounds These 13 legacies to be paid within three months after my decease & clear of legacy duty I give to my old Servant Elizabeth Powell the sum of five pounds with a continuance of her weekly allowance To Ann Powell I give the sum of Five pounds To Sarah Clarke I give the sum of nineteen guineas To Mary Prothers George Parrott & Gunner to each I give five pounds if in my service at the time of my decease Mourning for such of my Servants as may in my service at the time of my decease Written in my own hand this 10th of August in the year 1848 **Benjⁿ Whitelock** Signed by the within named Testator as & for his last Will & Testament in the presence of us & in the presence of each other *Wm Aviss Putney Wm Aviss Jn*

I Benjamin Whitelock of Putney in the County of Surrey Do by this Codicil to my Will made on or about the tenth day of August 1848 hereby confirm & ratify the same except as hereinafter is expressed Whereas by my said Will I have bequeathed to my daughter Ann Salome Whitelock certain legacies which legacies I am hereby now revoke & in lieu and instead of the same I give & bequeath all and singular those legacies to my executors named in my Will viz my Sons the Rev^d Benjamin Whitelock of Groombridge in the county and John William Whitelock of Putney in the County of Surrey In trust that they my said exec^{rs} & trustees do receive and take all profits benefits & advantages that may arise from those legacies & pay the amount of the same as they become due & receivable to my daughter now Ann Salome Reeves whose receipt alone shall be a sufficient discharge for the same notwithstanding her coverture But in the event of my said daughter dying leaving a child or children then & in such case I direct my exec^{rs} & trustees to apply the same for the support maintenance & education of such child or children at their or his discretion during his her or their minority and as he she or they may attain the age of 21 years such share to which he she or they may be entitled to be paid him her or them also in share and share alike But if my said daughter should die without leaving issue then and in that case I give & bequeath those legacies so named in my Will between my two Sons The Rev^d Benjamin Whitelock & John William Whitelock or the survivor share & share alike absolutely August 23, 1849 **Benjⁿ Whitelock**

I **Benjⁿ Whitelock** of Point House, Putney & in the County of Surrey being of sound & disposing mind do hereby ratify & confirm a Will made by me on or about 10 August 1848 Also a Codicil thereto made on or about 23 August 1849 and this is to be considered as a further Codicil thereto whereas in my Will made on or about 10 August 1848 I had bequeathed to my son John William Whitelock Two thousand five hundred pounds in the 3 1/4 P^{ct} which I now partly revoke having given to my said son John William Whitelock One thousand five hundred pounds 3 1/4 P^{ct} stock to advance him in his profession I therefore by this my Codicil leave to my said Son John William Whitelock only one thousand pounds in the 3 1/4 P^{ct} Stock instead of Two thousand five hundred pounds as named in my Will of 10 Aug 1848 - Dated June 19th 1850 **Benjⁿ Whitelock** Signed & delivered by the within named Testator as a further Codicil to his last Will & Testament in the presence of us & in the presence of each other *Edm^d Reeves 6 Lyons Inn Strand - Wm Reeves Stock Exchange*

Appeared Personally Henry Author Spitta of Clapham Rise in the County of Surry Esquire one of the subscribed Witnesses to the third Codicil to the last Will and Testament of the said Benjamin Whitelock late of Putney in the County of Surry Esquire deceased the said third Codicil bearing date the seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two and made Oath that on the said seventh day of December the said Testator duly executed his said Codicil by signing his name at the foot or end thereof in the presence of this deponent and of Sarah Clarke Spinster the other subscribed Witness thereto who were both present at same time and this deponent and the said Sarah Clarke thereupon attested and subscribed the said Codicil in the presence of the said Testator and each other - *H.A. Spitta* - On the thirty first day of January 1853 the said Henry Author Spitta Esquire was only sworn to the truth of this Affidavit Before me *J.E.P. Robertson Sur Present John Nelson Not Pub*

Proved at London with three Codicils 4 th Feby 1853 before the Worshipful John Elliot Pasley Robertson Doctor of Laws and Surrogate by the Oaths of the Reverend Benjamin Whitelock Clerk and John William Whitelock Esquire the Sons the executors to whom Admon was granted having be first sworn duly to administer.

Benjamin Whitelock was born in the parish of All Hallows, Bread Street, London Sep.29,1763 the son of John Whitelock & Ann Lutkens. He married Elizabeth Lane (1786-1842) January 2, 1817 St.Olave, Old Jewry, London and they had the three children mentioned in the Will.

Boyle's Directory of London for 1800 lists Benjamin Whitelock, merchant of 46 Lime Street.

In Wimbledon Parish Church there is a memorial to Sarah Clarke who is a witness to the Will and the second Codicil:

"Sarah Clarke d.March 21,1859 aged 64 ... She was for nearly 40 years a faithful servant to the Late Benjamin Whitelock Esq. of Point house, Putney whose family in testimony of her worth have erected this Memorial."

SIR WILLIAM GORE OUSELEY (1797-1866)

In the 1871 census for St. Austell, Cornwall there is an entry for Kate Whitelock, age 33, Unmarried, Governess, born in Middlesex, London. Living the house are her four charges, Harriett 9, Isabella 7, Edith 5 and Ousley 3. There is also a nurse, a cook and a housemaid. The surname for the children is Fitzmaurice. I was curious about the Ouseley name and did a little research to determine who this family was.

The parents were Capt James Terence Fitzmaurice (1835-1917) & Frances Rhoda Ouseley (1827-1907). This couple had five children:

Harriet Marcia Jane Fitzmaurice (1863-1933)
Isabelle Annie Fitzmaurice (1865-1948)
Aimee Edith Emily Fitzmaurice (1866-1890)
James Campbell Gore Ouseley Fitzmaurice (1868- 1934)
Mabel Madeline Rhoda Fitzmaurice (1878-1934)

Frances Rhoda Ouseley was the daughter of Sir William Gore Ouseley (1797-1866) a British Diplomat & Marcia VanNess the 20 year daughter of the Governor of Vermont, Cornelius P. VanNess. Her father's uncle was the noted orientalist Sir Gore Ouseley who was married to Harriet Georgina Whitelocke, the daughter of General John Whitelocke.

Sir William Gore Ouseley had an interesting diplomatic career. He was attaché in Washington D.C. from 1825 to 1832. He was one of several Britons who helped the new country of Argentina (1826) by gaining an advantage for Britain and negotiating contracts for expertise in the building of railways. In 1832 he was sent to Rio de Janeiro as a consul and rose to the position of minister resulting in a posting in Buenos Aires which lasted until 1850. His book *Notes on the Slave Trade, with Remarks on the Measures Adopted for its Suppression* regarding the Atlantic slave trade, published in 1850, is still in print.

'In October 1858 he was sent on a special mission to San José in Costa Rica as a Special Envoy on the British warship *Valorous*. His mission was to resolve Britain's interests in Central America, particularly the Bay Islands off Honduras, the Mosquito Coast and Greytown (both now in Nicaragua). In 1859, he negotiated a treaty concerning the British interests with Nicaragua and with Costa Rica which involved the President of Nicaragua personally. In early November, Ouseley required a change for his health and he announced his return to Britain before the treaty was signed. Within two weeks he had to return as his only son, William Charles Ouseley, had died at the age of 27 due to an opium overdose.'

Ouseley was an accomplished artist and his research into the legend of Dick Whittington & his cat revealed an unknown tenth century Persian manuscript of the legend.

The governess to Sir William's Fitzmaurice grandchildren, Catherine Kay Whitlock was baptized May 4, 1831 St. Botolph without Aldersgate the daughter of William Whitlock and Peggy Hills Town who were married there Jun.27,1829. I have not yet determined if there was any connection between the two Whitlock families mentioned in this article. (See William Whitlock's Will in March 1996 issue of the WFA newsletter)

WILL OF DAVID WHITLOCK 1798

In the name of God amen. I, DAVID WHITLOCK of the County of Hanover and the Parish of St. Paul, being of sound mind and body and memory to make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following. to wit: It is my will and desire that all my just and lawful debts be paid and for that purpose I desire that my executors may sell a tract of land that I have in the state of Kentucky which I purchased of SAMUEL WHITLOCK and adopt such other methods for payment of the same as they think best. ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my sons CHARLES WHITLOCK, TURNER RICHARDSON WHITLOCK and DAVID PARISH WHITLOCK all the land that I, am entitled to in the County of Randolph (State of Virginia) to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever. ITEM: I lend unto my wife MARTHA WHITLOCK the tract of land on which I now live during her widowhood and at her death or marriage it is my will and desire that the said tract of land be equally divided between my two daughters REBEKAH DORAN WHITLOCK & LUCY ANN WHITLOCK, to them and their heirs forever, but in case either of my said daughters should die under age or unmarried it is my will that the surviving one have the hole of the said land. I likewise lend unto my wife MARTHA WHITLOCK during her natural life all the rest of my estate of every kind & quality whatsoever & at her death to be divid between my following children as she shall direct - CHARLES WHITLOCK, TURNER RICHARDSON WHITLOCK, DAVID PARISH WHITLOCK, REBEKAH DORAN WHITLOCK & LUCY ANN WHITLOCK to them and their heirs forever. And lastly I nominate and appoint my wife MARTHA WHITLOCK and John Allen Richardson executrix and executor to this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixt my seal this 28th day of March one thousand seven hundren & ninety eight

David Whitlock's will was probated September 19, 1798.

Hanover County Chancery Wills and Notes, page 169; Some Wills from the Burned Counties by Hopkins, 1987 has the following detail about David.

"During his lifetime he had purchased one of John Garland lands in Halifax County on Hycó River, which he subsequently sold to Dabney Miller. This land was later devised by Mrs. Martha Whitlock to her two surviving children. A law suit resulted, instituted in the Superior Court of Law and Chancery in Richmond in which the Court decreed that the tract of land be divided into four lots "first choice to be cast between Francis Timberlake, Sr. (now dec'd) and Martha Whitlock and John Allen Richardson, Executrix and Executor." David Whitlock also possessed land in Hanover, Randolph County (now West Virginia) and Kentucky. Survived by his five children and his widow, Martha, who died with will dated November 5, 1825, two Codicils dated April 22, 1833. Probated February 27, 1839. Their issue:

1. Charles Whitlock died without issue between 1798 and 1825.
2. Turner Richardson Whitlock, died without issue between 1798 and 1825.
3. David Parish Whitlock, died without issue between 1798 and 1825.
4. Rebecca Doran Whitlock, unmarried in 1843.
5. Lucy Ann Whitlock, married prior 1825 Ralph Wingfield. Both are deceased in 1841, leaving issue: Martha Rebecca Wingfield; Lucy Ann Barbara Wingfield, married after 1825 William Henry Curtis, and died intestate ca 1855; Sarah Lewis Wingfield; Julia Blair Wingfield, under 21 years of age in 1841, married ca 1855 Philip R. Norment; Henry Clay Wingfield, under 21 years of age in 1841; Virginia Wingfield, und 21 years of age in 1841"

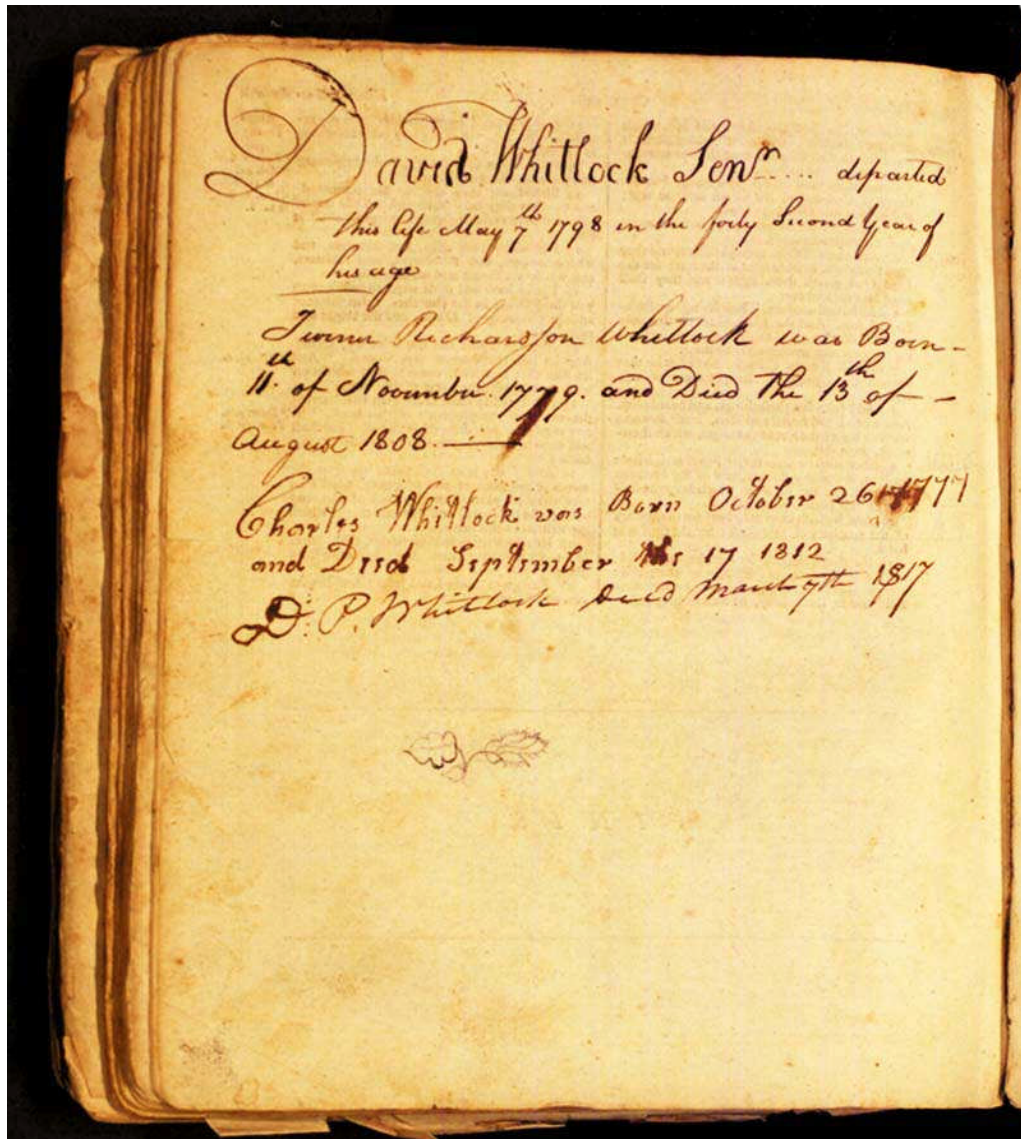
This family is detailed on our WHITLOCK25 chart. The only descendants of David & Martha Whitlock are through the Wingfield family as none of the other siblings are shown having any children. Lucy Ann Whitlock and Ralph Wingfield were married in Hanover Co., Virginia in 1815. Ralph was the son of Thomas Wingfield and Ann Davis.

David was thought to be born about 1724 but with the discovery of the Whitlock-Wingfield Bible (1767) we now know he was born about 1757. The entry for his death May 7, 1798 says he was in his forty second year when he died. He and Martha are not having children until the 1770s and we had speculated that either David married quite late or we were missing a generation. The latter turned out to be true. The family Bible also confirmed that Martha was Martha Richardson born Oct.22,1752 the daughter of Turner Richardson & Elizabeth Smart which we had deduced as one of her children has the name Turner Richardson Whitlock and John Allen Richardson is made executor of David's Will. The Whitlock and Richardson families appear together in Hanover Co. many times and David Whitlock Sr. and Turner Richardson are both listed as early as 1752 in as St.Paul's Parish, Hanover Co., Virginia document.

The Whitlock-Wingfield Bible makes it obvious we are talking about two different David Whitlocks. The tax records for St.Pauls, Hanover Co., indicate they were likely father and son and that David Whitlock Sr likely died about 1793. Up to 1793 there are two David Whitlock shown and in 1794 there is only one and he now owns all the land formerly owned by the two separate David Whitlocks.

The Hanover Co. processioning records from 1770s to 1790s, where owners of land where required to prove their property lines, indicated David Whitlock Sr's neighbours were the Bailey, Richardson, Tyree, Lemay, Oliver and Jones families. In 1784 there are two D. Whitlocks who sign the processioning record.

David Whitlock Jr. is referred to a "Captain" David Whitlock which would indicate he served in the Revolution War as a Captain. There is a reference to a Captain David Whitlock in *Virginia Revolutionary Publick Claims*. In Faquiere County "David Whitlock Capt. of guard of prisoners to Winchester 150# flour, 4 bu oats and 69# bacon". I have not been able to find any reference to him in the Revolution War pension records.

David Whitlock Sr. is mentioned in the March 21, 1733 Will of his father James.:

“Item: I bequeath to my son, David Whitlock, all the land and plantation I now live on with the 100 acres I lately purchased adjoining thereto, to him and his heirs in fee.” Also

“Item: I give to my son, David Whitlock, one negro boy named, Dob.” Also

“My will and desire is that if either of my two sons, David or Mathew, shall die before they come of age of 21 years.....” This confirms he was under 21 in 1733 and fits with him being born in 1724.

While David Whitlock Sr. is shown of St.Pauls Parish, Hanover Co, he also purchased several properties registered in Henrico Co. between 1747 and 1755.

Considering his land holdings, it is surprising that there does not appear to be a Will for David Whitlock Sr.

Now we know the sources relating to David Whitlock are split between a father and son, hopefully we can determine more about David Whitlock Sr. We do not have a wife shown for him but know he was likely having children in the 1750's. There is also the Samuel Whitlock of Kentucky that David Whitlock Jr purchased land from - could he be another son of David Whitlock Sr? The only other reference we have to this Samuel is the 1798 Kentucky Gazette item that mentions that his lost watch has been found.

In 1789 David & Martha Whitlock are parties to a deed with Ann Whitlock to Benjamin Oliver. Ann Whitlock died about 1790 and in 1800 her 193 acres in Hanover Co. were conveyed to Benjamin Oliver. We don't know yet if Ann was a widow or a spinster or how she connects to David Whitlock.

It is amazing after more than forty five years of research to come across an unknown 18th Century Family Bible record that fills in details of this part of the Whitlock family. It certainly gives us hope that other long time mysteries will be solved. I do find it unusual that major landowners in Hanover Co. died in the 1790's and there is no record of their wills. David Whitlock Sr. died about 1793 and Ann Whitlock died about 1790. There is also James Whitlock who died about 1783. His 433 acres in Hanover Co. are eventually conveyed to Nathaniel Whitlock in 1800. This James Whitlock is likely the one from Henrico Co. who was married first to Sarah ?? and secondly to Mary Smith who died in 1786. He heads the WHITLOCK23 chart.

The Whitlock-Wingfield Family Bible fills in some of the blanks for the Hanover County family but there are still more questions to be worked on.
