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Another very interesting quarter with hopefully another break through in our research to announce!! This issue contains an article using a clue from Grizel (Coleman) Whitlock (1705-1759)'s Will that gives us a pretty good hint who her elusive husband was. Many researchers have been trying to uncover this detail and I will be interested to hear the response to the theory I propose.

I managed to have my third annual trip to Salt Lake City September 29 to October 6 and it was a fantastic time as always. I managed to download the British Wills to 1899 which finished the that collection as far as I wanted. The indexes go to 1966 but the Library only holds copies to 1925. There were some interesting finds regarding the Whitlocks of Iowa and Kansas who originate in Waldeck, Hanover, Germany. We found the information on the ship they arrived on but still have not been able to pin down the town in Germany they were from. I have been working with John Leslie Whitlock on this part of the family and I am hoping we will be able to trace this line back in Germany where the family used the spelling Wittlake. I am very curious to see a DNA sample from a member of this family.

While in Salt Lake City I was also able to collect a series of images of Whitlock deeds from King William County, Virginia. Unfortunately these documents were fragments from documents that had been burnt. Many were missing sections but were still fairly readable. (R3520-34). I also added images of several other British Wills from 1559 to 1651 that were the latest additions to the collection on The Genealogist website. After discussions with John Cook I downloaded a copy of Nathaniel Herne's 1677 Will in which he mentions the daughter of his late brother John Herne _____ wife of _____ Whitlock of Virginia. Unfortunately the Will was the same as the typed copy - just blanks to fill in the given name of his niece and her husband. Hopefully one day we will confirm this was Dorothy Herne who married James Whitlock (1650-1716).

Some of the researchers belonging to the WHITLOCK25 family are starting to work on the WHITLOCK02H families including the De la Beche family as they now know of the connection between the two families. I have done three articles for this issue relating to this family. The first involves three 1549 Bill of Complaint documents that John Cook found at the National Archives in Kew, England. It involves a long standing dispute between William Whitlock and his younger brother Richard Whitlock regarding ownership of Beches Manor, near Wokingham, Berkshire. These documents both correct a mistake in our records as well as tell us there is a 1510 Will for their father William Whitlock of Wokingham, Berkshire that is still to be found. The second item is the Will of Richard Whitlock (1533-1570) who was a son of the above Richard Whitlock and the father of Sir James Whitlock (1570-1632). The third item takes a Latin document referring to the Whitlock Coat of Arms that has been in the files for years without the ability to translate it. Using Google translate we get a clear enough picture of what the document says and it confirms what we had thought, that the person requesting the confirmation of Arms is indeed Richard Whitlock (1564-1624) of Elbing, Prussia. Who was "on this journey to foreign countries".

Having catalogued all the material I brought back from Salt Lake City, I finally tackled Lawrence Otis' latest disc and you will notice the great additions added to our collection that he has found. A lot more census extracts from England, Canada and Ohio mostly relating to descendants of the WHITLOCK01 family. I am currently working on his US Birth Marriage and Deaths extracts and am about one third done.

I was very pleased to learn from Gord Bulger that there were probate documents available on line from the Province of Saskatchewan for two Bulger descendants of the Whitlock family that were connected with the Whitlock golf course in Hudson Quebec. This family is part of the WHITLOCK09 line. I downloaded both of them (R3551& R3552) and then typed in "Whitlock" to see what might be there for other parts of the family. I was very surprised to see my great-grandfather, Fredrick Whitlock's name!! Fredrick died in Pitt Meadows, BC but apparently still owned land in Saskatchewan. The probate document included a copy of his Will and it was great to get this kind of detail. There are several others listed for other Whitlock families and I will have to go back to the site and pick them up.

Mandane Ennis continues to uncover interesting material and this issue includes a collection of photographs of graves from the Find a Grave site for various families (PH1545-PH1555) and (PH1562-PH1566). One of these was the grave of Sarah (Gillihorn) Whitlock (1787-1857) one the original Virginia pioneers to head

west. Thanks also to Louise Brumbaugh for the photos for her Ohio family (PH1557-PH1560).

Bjorn Witlox of Amsterdam continues to uncover records from the 1200's & 1300's that further establish the presence of the Witloc family in Europe. His latest find relates to Ramée Abbey in Belgium in 1352 with the bonus of a photograph of the seal of Henri Witloc. (PH1568). You can quite clearly see the letters WIT-OC with the L being somewhat damaged but clear enough to know it is more likely an L than a T. The Ramée Abbey had connections with Margaret Plantagenet. Margaret the daughter of King Edward I, was born Sep.11,1275 and died in 1318. She married July 9,1290 John II Duke of Brabant. John of Brabant lived in England for some time and was involved in the resettling of the residents of Winchelsea in 1283 when the entire town was moved to higher ground due to the old town sinking into the sea. Bjorn also found a plot map dated 1290 showing the land in New Winchelsea allocated to Richard Witloc. (R3443). The speculation is that John of Brabant brought some members of the Witloc family with him to England.

I was recently looking at some references to the family listed in a document compiled in 1936 by William Percival Whitlock and Francis Metherall Whitlock (R1942). On page 6 they comment on the possible origins of the Whitlock name and one given is that the origin is from the Dutch personal name WITLOK meaning "Courageous Swordsman". I had forgotten this and it is interesting to note the possible Dutch origin was considered nearly 80 years ago! Bjorn shares the same DNA with the WHITLOCK02H & WHITLOCK25 families. It seems too much of a co-incidence to have the same name origin and the same DNA and for there not to be some connection.

I have included the statement for 2013 and the renewal notices for 2014 with this issue. Both subscribers and researchers were very generous this year enabling me to reduce our debt from setting up the website - very much appreciated. We really seem to be getting somewhere in tying families together and I hope you will be able to support this research for another year by renewing your subscription. I will advise those of you who have already prepaid for 2014 & 2015 by email.

Unfortunately Google has changed their Site Search feature and I have had to drop it from the website as the re-write of our site to enable us to use the new system would be about US\$1,500 and that is out of our price range. It was a great feature as it enabled everyone of the more than one million pages of research contained in our collection to be searched for key words. This even included the handwritten pages which would show up with a rough estimate of what they said. I can still do some basic searching but nothing as elaborate as Google. I have noted on the home page that you can enhance the Google search feature by typing the word you wish to search for followed by a space and: "site:whitlockfamilyassociation.com". This allows Google search concentrate on our site more directly. This works for any site you are searching and I find it a very useful tool.

GRIZEL (COLEMAN) WHITLOCK (1705-1759)'s HUSBAND

After more that 30 years trying to determine which Mr. Whitlock was the husband of Grizel Coleman I have a theory that I think makes sense. As with most solutions to long standing problems, the clues have been there in front of us for years.

My theory is that the John Whitlock who shows in the Registers of St.Peter's, New Kent Co., Virginia (our R0849) is most likely the husband of Grizel Coleman and I will lay out why I think this is likely.

Firstly we need to understand how this area of Virginia evolved. New Kent County was created 1654 from York and part James City Cos. It was a parent county for Hanover Co. (created 1720, King and Queen Co. created 1691). New Kent County is adjacent to King William County, created 1700 from King and Queen Co. It was a parent county for Caroline Co. (created 1727 from Essex, King William and King and Queen Counties) St.Peter's Parish also evolved becoming the parent of St.Pauls Parish in 1704. After 1720 St.Paul's Parish was in Hanover Co. Thus while many of these different county names and parish names show in our records it is important to realize many refer to the same places or places that are contiguous to each other in a very small area of Virginia. (See Fry-Jefferson Map 1751- R3434)

It is not known when St.Peter's Parish was formed but the registers commence in 1680. The Whitlock entries start in 1706 with the baptisms of several negroes belonging to John Whitlock. Robin 1706, Dick 1708, Betty 1710, Frank 1712, Molly 1715 (died 1715). In 1716 the death of the emigrant James Whitlock born in London, England about 1650 is recorded for March 29, 1716. The next reference is for Harry a negro belonging to Joe (sic) Whitlock 1727 then David 1729. In 1736 John Whitlock's daughter Fanny died. Also in 1736 is the baptism of Watlington a negro belonging to John Whitlock. In 1737 a negro girl Jack and in 1738 a negro boy Matthew.

This shows us that John was an adult owning slaves at least from 1706 until 1716. He was therefore likely born in the 1680's and as the emigrant James' death is recorded in the same parish it makes sense that he was likely a son of the emigrant James. John likely married in the 1720's and there is a unconfirmed record that he died in King William Co. in 1746. (The Will of Nathaniel Herne tells us that James was likely in Virginia prior to 1677.)

The significant clue here is the record for the negro Harry born June 20, 1727. In Grizel's will 1759 she leaves a negro named Harry to her two daughters. Grizel's inventory totals £68 of which most of that value is negro Harry at £55.

There are just too many co-incidences here for the connection not to be likely. Grizel was born in 1705 in King & Queen Co. so likely married in the 1720's. Her eldest son was named John and John's eldest daughter was named Frances. She was a widow by 1750 and was shown as "of King William Co." in 1751 when she purchased land in Goochland Co. The biggest clue is the negro Harry as we know there was a negro Harry that belonged to John Whitlock. Harry would have been 32 when Grizel died and he is the only negro listed in her inventory and Harry was important enough to be left to her daughters.

The John Whitlock shown in the New Kent Parish registers has been known for some years but which family descends from him has been unclear. This connection through the negro Harry is the first time a possible link to this John has had any merit. The fact the death of the emigrant ancestor James Whitlock (1650?-1716) is shown in the same Parish Register as John is too much of a co-incidence not to conclude that he is James' son. I also think it is significant that the records of births of negroes belonging to John Whitlock stops after 1716 when James died and does not recommence until 1727 when Harry's birth is recorded.

One other explanation for this could be that the second set of negroes born 1727 to 1738 belonged to another John Whitlock, possibly a son of the first one. I think this is unlikely as there are only negroes belonging to John Whitlock registered during this time period and no mention of a wife or other children. It also seems unusual that there would be no differentiation between them if there were two John Whitlocks.

The other John Whitlock living in the same area at this time is the one who had been granted land by the Pamunkey Indians as early as 1699. There is record of him in April 1702 being granted 233 acres in Pamunkey Neck for transporting five persons including a John Whitlock. While you could include yourself

as one of persons being transported and entitling you to land, it is known John Whitlock was already there in 1699 so there may have been two John Whitlocks involved here. This John Whitlock heads the WHITLOCK35 chart and seems an unlikely candidate to have been a son of the emigrant James Whitlock (1650?-1716) as he was arriving in 1702 and James' children would have been born in Virginia. The only scenario that would work would be for John Whitlock to be transporting another John Whitlock in 1702. Unfortunately no descendant of the WHITLOCK35 family has yet taken the DNA test to determine if the families share the same DNA. All these Whitlocks lived in a very small area of Virginia at the same time.

If this theory makes sense it likely only provides a husband for Grizel but does not make it clear which John Whitlock he was. Again DNA testing may shed more light on this and confirm if the John Whitlock who may have been Grizel's husband was related to the emigrant James Whitlock as I suspect.

I will be interested in comments.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I Richard Whitlock m'chante of the City off London sicke of bodye but whole of mynd do make this my last will and testament w'h is my bodie to be buried in christian burial Also I do make Joane my wyffe and my children full executrix and my goods to be demysed accordinge to the worshipfull order of the Cytie of London (my debts being paid) Also I doe give and bequeath oufe of my possion unto ye children of Jerome Whitlocke to saye Willyam & Mychell my godchildren to either of them the some of thre pounds sixe shillings eighte pence good and lawfull money of England to be paied unto them within one yere, Also I do give unto the children of John Whitlocke to either of them xxs lawfull money of England to be paied to them at the daye of their mariage/ Also I do give unto my servante George Spencer the some of vis viijd good and lawfull money of England to be paied unto him at his cominge furthe of his yeres/ Also I do bequeath unto Coops hall the some of iij£ vis viiid currante money of England to be bestowed at the discecon of the worshpfull companye/ Also I do ordeine John Heath the yonger, and John Lendall my overseers to oversee my books and accounts debts and b paymente, And I do bequeath unto either of them for their paynes fortie shillings/ And I doe make and ordaine my frend John Lendall my deputie to receive all suche money as is due to me here in this towne of Burdee And also all suche clothe as is to come for me in the Ane Frances of London and to sell it to my use And also the sayed John Lendall to have the government of all suche money as I have in this towne/ And also I will that the saied John Lendall shall paye for all such wynes and wares as hath been alreddie boughte for my use And for all such money as shall be left I will him to lode it in wynes and to deliver a... accompte unto my wiffe Jone Whitlocke, And he the said John Lendall to have For his paynes tenne french Crownes, And For the rest of my parte (my funerale and gifts aforesaied being payed I doe Give and bequeath it unto my wiffe Jone Whitlocke and my children to saye, my wyffe thone halfe and my children thother, halfe wrytten the xxxth of October in anno 1570/ in the presens of George Lucas and William Lucas marchannts of London and for the true wytnes hereof they have setto their hands the daye and yeare above sayed per me Richard Whitlock, Delivered as his dede in the presence of me Willyan Lucas mercer, by George Lucas In the presens of me John Lendall & me Willm May mar't

PROBATUM FUIT HMOI TELTA' coram Duo Cante Archiscopo ni hmoi testamento norat & Cni comissa fuit administraro & de bene & Jurat

(Rough translation - Probate of HMOI TELTA 'Two Cambridge before Archbishop hmoi will not be issued and was committed to the well known and Cni or rights)

Richard Whitlock is shown on the WHITLOCK02h chart, born in 1533, son of Richard Whitlock & Jane Grove of Wokingham, Berkshire. He was the father of Sir James Whitlock (1570-1632) who gives a short account of his life in *Liber Familicus*. "p.4 My father, Richard Whitelock, was the fourth and youngest sun. He was put to London to be brought up in the trade of merchandise, and then became free of the best companies, as of the marchant adventurers, Spayne, Muskovie, and did trafique in all these countryes, and heer in England withe the Italian marchants, but used most trafique in Fraunce. He used to go in parson into foreyne countryes, and, having a purpose to leave that dangerous course of life, was taken away by deathe in that voyage he made accoumpt shold have been his last. He went from London toward Burdeux in Fraunce, the emporium for Gascoyne wines, 22 September, 1570, and thear fell into a plurisy, 21 October next following, of whiche he dyed 7 November following, and was buryed withe great difficulty; for, by reason that he refused extream unction and sutche popishe ceremonies in his sickness, he was excommunicate as an heretik, and so deprived of christian buriall. But the Englishe marchants that wear then at Burdeux, to the number of a 100 or more, armed withe shot, did carye the corps into the vineyards, and thear did honorably interr it. He made his last will and testament in his siknesse, dated 30 October, 1570, and in it made my mother his executrix, who did prove it and execute it most faythefully and lovingly toward her children. The inventorye was £1221.11s.7d. He was 37 yeares of age when he died, as appeerethe by his picture, whiche was made 1563 and then he was 30 years olde, and he died in anno 1570. I have noted his gravitye by his picture, for, being then but 30 year olde, he ware a cap, a verry small ruffe and edged withe black work, a side coat of fine black clothe, a black satten dubblet, and a Spanishe cape of fine black clothe, furred and edged withe pinked satten, and long stokkins. This apparell now would be thoughte over grave in an elder by ten yeares."

Unfortunately the portrait that Sir James describes has likely not survived. Their house in Fleet Street was burned in the Great Fire of London in 1666.

Richard married Joan (Colte) Brockhurst February 7, 1563. She was a widow, her husband and only child, a daughter, having died of plague in 1563. Sir James' account of his mother from *Liber Familicus* p.6 "and leaving his widow of comptent estate, she maryed afterward my father, he being yonger than she, and of no great meanes, but civill, and likely to thrive. My mother being a widow maryed Thomas Price, a marchant of London, that had by her only on sun named George, now living... This Thomas Price proved a notable unthrift, and a veye unkinde and insolent husband, so as my mother, being destitute of frendes, had these burdens lay upon her, the care to avoyd dayly wrongs to herself from her husband, to preserve those portions that wear left to her children, and to finde the meanes to bring them up in lerning and civility."

Sir James' portrays his mother as very financially astute. She managed to keep her children's inheritance away from her husband and invested it successfully enough that each was well educated had a fairly substantial estate when they reached adulthood. Two sons, Edmund and James attended Merchant Taylors School and learned the classics, Hebrew, Greek and Latin. Edmund went on to Cambridge and James to Oxford and then to the Middle Temple to train as a lawyer.

p.16 On the 21st of February, 1606, 4Jacobi, dyed my kinde, godly and loving mother, having lived a goodly time; the certeyn number of yeares she could not tell, but herself and her kindred reconed her neer fourskore...she was buryed in Aldermarve churche in the chauncell thear, 25 February. She dyed in that parishe, and thear preached at her funerall doctor John Done, the parson, that had been my acquayntance when he was of Christ churche in Oxford.

Richard's wife Joan was pregnant at his death and on November 28, 1570 she gave birth to twins, William and James. Sir James mentions his twin brother in *Liber Familicus*. p.11 William, that was the elder born of us two, was brought up withe the rest in lerning, but had no minde to it, and therfore was bound apprentice to a marchant in London, but when the Portugall voyage was undertaken, he left maister and thrift and all, and put himself into the action, and so fell from that civill course to a martial life. He was brought up from shipbord, at his return, in a sheet, he was so extream weak, and did hardly recover again by my mother's great tendernesse of him, and, when he was well againe, followed the warrs altogeather. He served sir Frauncis Drake in his chamber, and followed him to the Groin, and his other voyages, and behaved himself veye valiantly, to the good liking of his master, and so continued in his service untill sir Frauncis dyed at sea... He followed that course of life, untill at the last, going forthe in a ship of war from London to the Indian seas, he lost his life in a conflict withe the Spanyards. He was a veye tall young man, strong of body flaxen hear, fair of complexion, exceeding wastfull in expence, and carelesse of all worldly matters that tended to thrift. He was about the age of 27 yeares olde when he dyed. *Liber Familicus* p.11 "Richard, my second brother, was sent over sea, being about the age of sixteen yeares, unto Christopher Colte, my mother's brother, to Dansk, and lived withe him in travail in those estern countries untill he came to man's estate; and afterward maryed a gentlewoman of that country, on Katharin Dambits, by whome he hathe many children. He hathe tasted of many varieties of fortune, sumtime good and sumtime bad, and hathe trayeled over many countries, and the the uncerteynty of trafique hathe susteyned great losses in his estate. By reason that his wife had a good patrimony of land by enheritance from her father, he abidethe at Elbing and those partes, whear she was born and her land lyethe."

We know of at least five of Richard's supposed 16 children and were able to trace descendants of his son John for 200 years in Sweden. A daughter was married to Colonel Christopher Potley (See article WFA March 2012). It is suspected that some Wittlokes and Wittlakes of Germany and Poland may descend from Richard Whitlock (1565-1624).

BILL OF COMPLAINT 1549 RE: MANOR OF BECHES

In the Berkshire Volume of the Victoria County Histories there is a reference to William Whitlock son of William Whitlock suing his younger brother Richard Whitlock in 1549. John Cook recently discovered the National Archives at Kew hold the documents relating to this lawsuit and he was able to purchase a copy of them for us. There are three separate documents written on parchment mostly in English with some Latin. I did a rough transcript of the documents and hopefully between John and I we will eventually be able to produce a fairly comprehensive version of these documents.

Even with just the rough transcript I have done it is fairly clear what the issues were.

The dispute centers around the Will of William Whitlock (1510) the father of the two sons, William and Richard. This family is detailed on our WHITLOCK02H chart, The Whitlocks of Wokingham, Berkshire and as the son William did not show on the charts I had this dispute attributed to the next generation where there was also two sons William and Richard. These documents make it clear that the William whose Will was dated December 20, 1510 was the son of John Whitlock & Agnes De la Beche and is shown married to a Crowdrey. Unfortunately we have not found a copy of the Will from 1510 which is referred in the 1549 Bill of Complaint.

It appears from the documents that this dispute had gone on for some years and there is reference to an award made in 1541 to settle the issue.

William Whitlock in his Will of 1510 apparently made allowance for his eldest son. The son William and his wife Thomazine and their son William were to have possession of land and an orchard and a croft named Harpies "in Okyngham aforesaid by the kyngs high waie" [Okyngham = Wokingham] for their lifetime. After their decease, this portion of the estate was to return to his brother Richard's heirs who were to inherit the whole of the Beches Manor.

The allowance to William & Thomazine Whitlock included revenue from manor lands and "six loads of wood yerelie to him delyvered, at the dwelling hous of the same playntif [William] in Okyngham aforesaid and that the said Thomasyn shall receive yerelie after the deathe of said playntif her husband one annuitie of vjs viijd paid & two loads of wood out of the said manor & other the p' myssets to the said Richard before awarded duryng his naturall lif w't a chanse of distres for no payment of the said (pevall?) annuylie and loads of wood"

The son Richard was ordered to pay his brother William any amounts required by their father's will that remained outstanding and William's claim was dismissed.

It is not clear why William and Thomazine Whitlock were omitted from the family trees and are not mentioned in *Liber Familicus*. His younger brother Richard married Jane (Johanna) Grove and their children were born at Beches. James Whitlock begins *Liber Familicus* written in 1609 with "My father

Richard Whitlock was the fourth sun of Richard Whitlock, and was born in the ancient seat of the Whitelocks, called Beeches, situate neer Okingham, a market towne in the countye of Barkes, whiche hath continued in our blud sithence the year of our Lord 1231"

We do not know what happened to the elder son William & his wife Thomazine or their son William. I have a Will of a Thomazin Whitlock from 1562 but there is nothing in it to indicate a connection to William, plus William and Thomazine would have to have been married before 1510 to be mentioned in William Whitlock's will so this Thomazine would be over 70 in 1562.

We know Richard Whitlock died in 1556 and have a copy of his Will (R2755). (See June 2008 issue of WFA Newsletter.)

Our thanks to John Cook for uncovering these documents and sharing them with us. Hopefully in our further searches we will be able to track down a copy of William Whitlock's Will of 1510.

From you was, therefore each and every one of you, we, the aforesaid Garter principal King of Arms, in English, and of all the other noble sir, All the nobility, honor, and virtue, the virtues, officiciarius most obedient earnestly we ask and entreat in this manner, all were with you, as aforesaid Master of the rights of Praehementijs Richard Whitlock, privelegijs, was free from, of the war exercicijis in peace, and ornaments, which either can or ought to gentlemen of distinction for the laws of their arms are usually attributed, without any hindrance on your part, free to use, and in all places permit: Given in the City of London, England: the twentieth day of the month of April, xxxiiijth year of the reign of Elizabeth the grace of God, of England, of France and Ireland Queen, defender of the Faith, & c, year of Christ the Saviour, 1592*

Whitlock

The Richard Whitlock referred to above is shown on the WHITLOCK02H chart. The Whitlocks of Wokingham, Berkshire. He is Richard Whitlock (1565-1624) the second son of Richard Whitlock (1533-1570). Richard was the elder brother of James Whitlock (1570-1632) who tells a bit about him in his *Liber Famelicus* (P.11) (See Pg 8 of this issue)

Richard worked for the Eastland Co. which was established in Prussia to rival the British East India Co. They traded with the far east and there is reference to Richard in Jakarta in 1616 and James Whitlock mentions his brother had travelled to many countries.

I had assumed years ago that this Richard Whitlock had to be the one requesting the confirmation of arms in 1592 as he was the only Richard son of Richard alive in 1592. The translation of the Latin document confirms it with the expression "*on this journey to foreign countries*"

To date we only know the names of four of Richard's sixteen children plus we know a daughter married Col. Christopher Potley. We have been able to trace Richard's line through his son John Whitlock for 200 years to the late 1700's. His son James Whitlock b.1601 was sent to England in September 1620 to live with his uncle James Whitlock (1570-1632). James sent him to Magdalen Hall, Oxford where he was tutored by Mr. Ramsden. Richard's daughter Catherine married Anthony Smyth of Lancashire.

As mentioned elsewhere in this Newsletter, I suspect many of the Wittlock and Wittlake families of Sweden, Poland and Germany may descend from this part of the Whitlock family.
