

WHITLOCK FAMILY NEWSLETTER

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The emails have been a little quieter this quarter than recently but still a steady stream of them. The photographs section has the most additions this time and most of them are from the Find a Grave site. Google with Find a Grave and Family Search are the first three places I go to when looking for information. So many of the Find a Grave sites have great additional documentation included. I did contact the person posting information relating to the Grave of Sally (Whitlock) (Monroe) Thornton (1777?-1850) in Yerkes Cemetery, Northville, Wayne Co., Michigan (PH1824) to let them know who this person was, as this grave was being confused with a different Sally Whitlock. They were kind enough to post the additional information to make it clear which family was Sally's.

I was very pleased to receive a photo of the grave of Mary (Ponsonbay) Whitlock (1774-1843) who is buried in Mount Comfort Cemetery, Springfield, Missouri (PH1834). Unfortunately the inscription is too faint to be read. It is a shame I did not know this a few years ago as we visited Springfield, Missouri every summer for several years as Patrick's Aunt Alexandra Scoville lived there. We went last year after Alexandra died and visited with several of her friends we had met. If we manage to get back again I will make a point of checking out the Mount Comfort Cemetery.

One recent achievement has been the completion of the Oxfordshire census records. I now have a fairly complete record from 1841 to 1901. The additional records filled in quite a few missing sections of the Oxfordshire families and connected several of the families shown at the end of the WHITLOCK20 chart as "Also from Oxfordshire"

I was very pleased to reconnect with Judi Wilson and as a result of her research there is an article in this issue regarding Francis Whitlock & Judith Corley who have been shown as the possible parents of Tarlton Whitlock as far back as 2006. We now have documents from 1824 confirming this connection. The couple now head the WHITLOCK37 family and detail the descent from several of Tarlton Whitlock's siblings. The next step will be to determine how Francis Whitlock connects to the Whitlocks of Goochland Co. in the mid 1700's.

Ours thanks to Barb King for her research into the Whitlocks of Georgia. We added several Confederate Pension files to our collection and I did completed our Georgia Census collection from 1790 to 1900 as we tried to determine who the likely parents are of Armstead Whitlock (1804?-1877) of Hall Co., Georgia.

For several years Jan Witlox has been forwarding me copies of his monthly family newsletter *Digitale nieuwsbrief familie Witlox*. A great family newsletter in Dutch relating to the Witlox family of Holland and Belgium. (WHITLOCK90) In the January 2015 issue he detailed the family of the Antwerp, Belgium master bell maker Willem Witlockx (1669-1733). He was the youngest child of Bernaart Peter Witlockx & Maria Willem Walshots. I did some research on the Internet and put together a short article on Willem's bells for this issue.

One of my distant cousins, Luke Whitlock is a composer in England. I received an email from him announcing that he is launching his debut CD June 1, 2015. *Flowing Waters* is a collection of piano music all composed by Luke. On a personal note this issue of the Newsletter is a little late as my husband Patrick has been waiting for some months for a hip replacement operation and was called on May 21 to have the operation May 25. HANNAH WHITELOCK - FELON 1810

Proceedings of the Old Bailey

SAMUEL WHITELOCK, HANNAH WHITELOCK, Theft > grand larceny, 11th April 1810.

Reference Number: t18100411-109

Offence: Theft > grand larceny

Verdict: Not Guilty; Guilty

Punishment: Transportation

369. SAMUEL WHITELOCK and HANNAH WHITELOCK , alias HANNAH SMITH , were indicted for feloniously stealing, on the 3d of April , three lb. wt. of lead, value 1s. 3d. the property of Patrick Mulcahy .

PATRICK MULCAHY . I am a milkman , No. 30, East Smithfield . The prisoners lodged with me in the garret. On the 3d of April, both the prisoners came down stairs, and said they were floating with water. I went up stairs to their room, and saw the room was floating with water; I saw the lead was gone from the top of the house; I told them one or the other of them must have taken it; I saw the lead was fresh cut; I went to the Magistrate, got an officer who searched their room, and part of the lead was found in the bed before the Magistrate. The woman prisoner said she stole the lead; she told where she sold it at different times; she got 5 s. 9 d. at one time, and 1 s. 3 d. the other time. Nobody could go up to take it without their knowing it.

JOHN GILLMAN . On the 3d of this month, I searched the prisoners' room. In the bed clothes, this piece of gutter lead, I fitted it to the gutter, it tallied exactly; I took both the prisoners into custody before the Magistrate; the woman prisoner confessed that she and a soldier that lived in the next room cut the lead off, and that Samuel Whitelock knew nothing of it.

Samuel Whitelock was not put on his defence.

Hannah Whitelocke 's Defence. On the 21st of March the soldier that lived in the next room to me, he said he saw a bit of lead that was loose: he went and borrowed a chopper, and cut it off. I own to selling it, not to cutting it off. Samuel knew nothing of it; he was at work at the time.

HANNAH WHITELOCK - GUILTY , aged 30.

Transported for Seven Years .

It is not clear from this record if “Smith” was Hannah’s maiden name or a false name she gave to the Constable. It is assumed Hannah and Samuel were husband and wife but we cannot be sure of that either. I have a Samuel and Hannah Whitelock baptizing a son William December 22, 1802 at St.Botolph Without Aldgate, London.

This Hannah Whitelock shows in Peter Whitakers book of the Whitlocks of Australia and New Zealand as his family 001. She was born about 1772 and died at the Benevolent Assylum in Sydney in 1836 age 64. She was buried in the Devonshire Street Cemetery, Sydney.

Hannah arrived in Sydney aboard the ship “Friends” October 10, 1811. From 1811 to 1814+ she lived at the Female Factory in Parramatta and is shown living on Harrington St., Sydney 1822-28.

Hannah lived with William Hubbard (1766?-1843). He was born in Kingston, Surrey and convicted in Feb.1783 in Kingston. He arrived in Sydney Jan.26,1788 (First Fleet) on the ship “Scarborough”. William was a leaseholder of a 100 acres in the northern boundary of Windsor, Richmond and Castlereagh area 1790-1820. After the death of his first wife Mary Anne Goulding in 1820 William went to live on Harrington St., Sydney 1822-37+. William and Mary Anne Goulding had married in 1790.

Hannah had at least four children born in NSW. Mary 1814?, John 1816?, James 1818? & William 1820? All the children are listed under the surnames Hubbard and Whitelock although it is seems likely that William Hubbard was not their father as Hannah is not shown with William until 1822. None of Hannah’s children appear to have survived to their teens although no record of their deaths has been found.

WILL of GEORGE WHITELOCK of DOWNHOLME, YORKSHIRE 1718

In the Name of God Amen I George Whitelock of Downholme in ye County of Yorke yeo being in health of Body and of sound and perfect mind and memory, Praise be therefore given to Almighty God do make and ordaine this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following That is to say first and principally I commend my soul into ye hands of Almighty God hoping through ye merits Death and Passion of my saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit everlasting Life and my Body I commit to ye Earth to be decently buried at ye discretion of my Executor hereafter named, & as touching ye Disposition of all such temporal Effects as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I give and dispose thereof as followeth

I give unto my son in law Mathew Hagston ye sum of Ten Pounds
I give unto my son in law Edward Elerton ye like sum of Ten Pounds
I give unto my son in law Gyles Elerton ye like sum of Ten Pounds
I give unto my daughter in law Mary Whitelock ye sum of Five Pounds
I give unto ye Poor of Downholme ye sum of Five Pounds to be paid yearly by my Executor or to pay it in when he thincks convenient
I give ye Residue and Remainder of my Goods and Chattels and all Effects whatsoever unto my son Christopher Whitelock & make him sole Executor of this Last Will & Testament

As witness my Hand & Seall this fifth day of March 1716

Sealed signed & delivered in presence of George Whitelock his marke

Page 2 The stylized writing on this page is extremely difficult to read although the copy is good.

There is a paragraph in Latin which I cannot translate, dated 16 August 1718

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above...Christopher Whitelock do well and truly execute observe perform fullfill & this last Will & Testament of George Whitelock his late father in paying his debts & legacys so far as his goods will extend and Saw... all binds him if also he sointo the Consistory Court at Richmond a Inventory of all & singular the goods Chattels and of the deceased.....

George Whitelock was buried at Downholme on 7 Aug 1718

Our thanks to Jennifer for the transcription of this Will. George Whitelock heads the WHITLOCK21 family and we would estimate he was likely born in the 1630's and married his wife Elizabeth in the 1660's. We assume George was the first of this family to settle in Downholme and we have not yet been able to connect George with any of the other Whitelock families in Yorkshire and determine who his parents may have been.

The name George shows in the Thirsk, Rainham and Topcliffe Yorkshire families at this time and they are the most likely connections. George Whitelock bp Jan.25,1627 at Thirsk seems a likely candidate, particularly as the names Christopher and Francis are names used by both these families. Hopefully additional research will allow us to connect the Downholme Whitelocks with one of these families.

WILLEM WITLOCKX (1669-1733) BELL MAKER

Jan Witlok's January 2015 Witlox Newsletter includes family details and a photograph of a bronze bell cast by master bell maker Willem Witlockx of Antwerp, Belgium. Willam is recorded as casting bells in the early 1700's. In the same town was the older bell master Melchior DeHaze and it is assumed Willem learned some of his skill from the older master. He perfected bronze bell casting to a high degree and became a skilled bell turner using his other skill as an ivory turner. Willem was criticized for his gaudy self portraits that he cast into his larger bells but his status was confirmed in 1723 when he was appointed director of the Royal Cannon Foundry at Mechelen.

His work lives on to the present day and some of his bells were featured in a recent Christies Auction. Others did not survive as long. His Holy Blood bell at Bruges was destroyed in 1741 when the bell tower was hit by lightning and burned. The south tower at the Royal Convent at Mafra in Portugal has a set of clarion bells cast in 1730 by Willm Witockx. Each tower has 50 bells, 49 of which form part of the clarion. The bells weigh from 15 kg to 14,688 kg

Willem had set the standard for quality in the 1730's and in future years the goal was to try to cast bells that exceeded his standard. It is recorded he was a wealthy man at his death in 1733.

THOMAS WHITLOCK OF STOCKPORT NY 1839

The following documents are part of the Revolutionary War Pension files:

State of New York }

Columbia County } SS. I Margaret Dreimer ["Teller" crossed out], widow of the late Doctor Abraham Teller late of Hyde Park Dutchess County ~ deceased and who died in the year One thousand Eight hundred & Three being duly sworn say I am now ["in the" crossed out] Eighty two ~ years old ["of my age" crossed out], My maiden name was Margaret Way[man?] & I married Thomas Crummell for my first husband who at the time of his death which was in the year 1776 was a Soldier in the war of the Revolution & died of a wound he received in the Battle of White Plains in Westchester County, he died in about twenty two weeks after he was wounded. I had one child by my said first husband, the child died. Said Thomas ~ Crummell according to my best recollection & belief was an Enlisted Soldier & I think a corporal. I do not remember his officers ~ According to my present recollection my said second husband said Doctor Abraham Teller was in the service when my said first husband died. I was acquainted with him before my said first husband died & I married him said doctor Abraham Teller before he left the Service, He was I believe was in Van Cortlandts Regiment a Surgeon or Physician therein ~ We, said Dr. Teller and myself were married by Rev. Samuel Seabury My first child by my second husband was a son & was baptised by the name of Abraham Teller I think in Trinity Church New York ["by Said Seabury" crossed out]. My said first child is dead. My second child was a Daughter with whom I am now living She first married Doctor George W. Cook & after his death she married Thomas Whitlock.

My said husband Abraham Teller was taken prisoner by the English and taken to New York City ~ He was taken at or near Teller Point.

I cannot now say with precision what time I married my said first & second husbands. My family record was burned at Hyde Park when the house was burned up. I married my first husband before he left the Service and I married my second husband when he was a prisoner on Parole in New York and he was released by the English from his Parole after I married him & he went into practice in New York City and practiced in New York until he moved to Hyde Park & practiced in Hyde Park until he died ~ **Margarzt Teller**

Thomas Whitlock

Thomas Whitlock shows on the 1840 census of Stockport, Columbia Co., New York. He is aged 80 to 89. Also in the household are likely his mother-in-law Margaret (Wayman)(Teller) Dreimer aged 80 to 89 and his wife Margaret (Teller) (Cook) Whitlock aged 50 to 59 and a female aged 16 to 19. Their daughter Margaret Teller Whitlock was born June 6, 1819 in New York so was aged 21 in 1840. She was married December 21, 1837 to Augustus Cross and was no longer living with her parents.

Thomas Whitlock & Margaret (Teller) Cook were married about 1814. Thomas Whitlock was 55+ and Margaret was about 31 and had several children by her late husband George Whitfield Cook.

With Margaret Teller Whitlock born in 1819 in New York, Thomas should show on the 1820 census for New York. There is a Lewis Whitlock and a Thomas Whitlock living in Hudson, Columbia Co. in 1820. There appears to be a connection between Thomas Whitlock of Stockport and Lewis Whitlock (1786?-1859) of Stockport and they both have connections to the Cook family. Margaret Teller Whitlock's mother Margaret Teller was first married to George Whitefield Cook. Lewis's wife was Rebecca Cook.

Thomas Whitlock born about 1760 to 1770 married Margaret (Teller) Cook later in life and we would assume he was likely married before. The Thomas Whitlock who married Margaret Ritchie about 1800 and Abigail Sayres in 1814 has been connected to Columbia Co., in 1800 and 1810 but as both Thomas's married different wives in 1814 it would appear they are separate persons.

Further research into the Whitlocks of Stockport, New York will hopefully clarify this connection. Thomas died sometime after 1840 and hopefully we will find an obituary for him that will provide more information on his family.

FRANCIS WHITLOCK OF GOOCHLAND CO., VIRGINIA

In June 1999 I had an email from Jim Farrar detailing the find of the information in the Moody family Bible that shows Judith (Corley) Whitlock as the mother of several children including Frank, Patsey & Judith. Her daughter Judith married George W. Farra December 23, 1824 in Lexington, Rockbridge Co., Virginia. At the same time as the email from Jim Farrar, I heard from Judith Gore regarding the same information.

In March 2006 Laurie Whitlock wrote that Judith Corley's husband was likely Francis Whitlock and that another of Judith's children was Tarlton Whitlock of Rockbridge Co., Virginia who headed our WHITLOCK37 chart. Laurie's mother had done the research and she did not know the origin of the information on Francis Whitlock as the husband of Judith Corley.

Unfortunately there is no record mentioning a Francis Whitlock in Goochland Co., in the 1740's and I put this information aside until we could verify the connection in some way.

In September 2013 Mandane Ennis sent in a copy of the Goochland Co., Virginia Chancery documents relating to a disputed bee hive. This 1806 document showed that Judith was the mother of several children including Tarlton Whitlock.

This brings us to 2015 and the latest correspondence with Judith Frye Gore Wilson and the marriage announcement of the wedding of George W. Farra and Judith Whitlock Dec.23,1824 Lexington, Rockbridge Co., Virginia in which it states that Judith is the daughter of Francis Whitlock, decd.

This is the first record we have found that shows that Judith Corley's husband was Francis Whitlock.

The Corley family appears to have acquired land on Licking Hole Creek, Goochland Co., Virginia in the early 1700's and Francis Corley purchased more in 1754 and 1756. Several of Judith (Corley) Whitlock's children are shown as born at Licking Hole Creek in Goochland Co.

As early as 1731 Alexander Logan owned land on Licking Hole Creek and on July 23,1754 his daughter Ann married John Whitlock at St. James Northam, Goochland Co. so the Logan, Corley and Whitlock families appear to be living in the same locale.

There is no birth for a Francis Whitlock shown in the St. James Northam, Goochland Co., registers. Tarlton Whitlock appears to be the first child born to Judith in 1782 when she was about 30. Tarlton is also known as Tarlton J. Fulton Whitlock and that is not explained yet. Francis Whitlock would likely be born in the 1740's-1750's and died about 1803. He likely is connected to the Whitlocks of Goochland Co., Virginia but we are not sure how. We have not yet had any male Whitlock from the WHITLOCK37 family take the YDNA test. If it matches the rest of Whitlocks of Virginia it would confirm we are looking for the correct connection. If it does not match it will be interesting to determine which family it does match.
