Another fairly quiet quarter with some interesting additions being received.

I have been concentrating on making notes and preparing for my annual visit to Salt Lake City and a week of research in the LDS Library there. I was not able to go last year so am looking forward to this year's trip September 13-20. The past couple of visits have concentrated on the British Wills and resulted in us making several amazing breakthroughs in our research. I am hoping to continue this and include the Wills from the Prerogative Court of York. I also have a list of other items to check while there.

I have continued my work on the British Census records and have extracted all of the Somerset census records 1841-1881. I still have 1871 to catalogue and that County will also be complete to 1881. I did have a problem that there are a lot of Whitlocks in Somerset and I know a lot of these families are confused with the Whitlock ones.

We received the latest YDNA test results, for John Leslie Whitlock of Wichita, Kansas. His family traces back to Bad Pymont, Waldeck, Hanover, Germany and while his YDNA did not match any of the results in the files, I am hoping as more Whitlocks with origins in Germany, Poland and Sweden are tested we will find they have common origins.

I was very pleased to receive emails and documents from Jennifer Thackwray showing that Jonas Whitlock and Jane Bristow who married November 3, 1796 at St. Mary, Newington, Surrey were the parents of William Whitlock who headed the WHITLOCK61 family. Jonas Whitlock was buried at St. Mark, Kennington August 15, 1831 age 75 making him born about 1756. William Whitlock was baptized June 29, 1806 at St. Mary's, Lambeth as the son of Jonas & Jane. There is a William Whitlock of Camberwell whose death is recorded in 1870 age 74 (1796). On the 1851 census William shows he is 52 (1799). While we seem to have several possible birth dates for the William who married Rachel Hind June 5, 1821 St. Mary, Newington, Surrey, it does make sense that we have the correct William. He names a daughter Jane after his mother Jane Bristow and more importantly he names a son William Jonas Whitlock after his father. Jennifer also connected the Canadian descendants of Gilbert Charles Hawes Whitlock to this family showing that Gilbert was an son of Mary Ann Sophia Whitlock, a granddaughter of William and Rachel. Our thanks to Jennifer for sharing this research and adding another generation to the WHITLOCK61 family. Unfortunately there is no Jonas Whitlock born about 1756 in our records so the search starts again.

Following on the information from the last issue relating to Francis Whitlock & Judith Corley who now head the WHITLOCK37 family, I was pleased to receive details of Francis Corley's Will dated January 27, 1818 and proved November 20, 1820. He mentions his three Whitlock grandchildren, the children of his daughter Judith (Corley) Whitlock. Plus his son in law Frank Whitlock was his executor. This provides further proof the connection was correct. This makes two families this year we have been able to get back at least one more generation after many years of research.

On a sad note we lost our oldest long time subscriber to the Newsletter when my distant cousin Cyril Henry Whitlock died at 102 July 10, 2015 in Hornchurch, Essex. Cyril was born August 28, 1912 in Ivybridge, Devon and he and his wife Maisie have been involved with the Whitlock Family Association since the 1970's. Cyril was the son of George Henry & Minnie Susan (Soper) Whitlock and we shared common ancestors in the WHITLOCK01 family.

Bit by bit we are piecing together a clearer picture of the families that use the various Whitlock names. We have confirmed with YDNA what we had expected to find, that there are multiple origins. Each branch of the family has a story to tell and more and more of these stories are becoming better known and extending further and further back. Many are linking together with others. Through the collective research of the Whitlock Family Association members we are uncovering and sharing these family histories and preserving them for the coming generations. I get a lot of thanks from people thrilled to uncover and learn their family story and I know the thanks are really due to all of you who have done the work and shared it. Great job everyone. 2018 will be fifty years since the Whitlock Family Association was formed - we will have think of a way to celebrate that milestone. (I apologize for the volume of Certificates in this issue - I am trying to catch up with them.)

BANDA AND KIRWEE BOOTY

While legally all goods captured during a war belong to the state, it was traditional that the spoils of war were shared among the soldiers responsible for their capture. In 1858, during the wars in India one booty taken was so huge that the division of it resulted in a nine year case before the British Admiralty Court.

During the Indian Mutiny the Central India Campaign a huge booty was captured by the Saugor and Nerbudda field force. Under Major-General George Cornish Whitlock these field forces were sent to Bundelkund to achieve the relief of various towns in the region. A force of 7000 outside Banda were defeated and they entered the town and were able to take a large amount of loot from the palace. General Whitlock then marched on nearby Kirwee and the town surrendered as well. There was a large amount of money and jewels from the palace there as well.

The other Generals serving the same campaign recommended that due to the huge difference in the value of their separate booty captured that they be combined and shared equally among the officers and men who had claimed to have a role to play in related actions. The problem was the disparity in the amounts. General Rose's booty was £49,000 and General Robert's was £18,200 while General Whitlock's was estimated to be £700,000. Needless to say the men serving under General Whitlock were not in favour of combining and the matter was referred to the Admiralty Court.

By the time the Judgement was released in March 1867 the case had cost £60,000. Most of the claims of the other officers were disallowed. The payments made were:

Lord Clyde £60,000
General Whitlock £12,000
a Captain £600
a Lieutenant £325/£375 (dep on service length)

a Sergeant £100
a Private £50

There were subsequent payments made to the Privates that raised their portion to about £75

To put this in perspective in today's money values, the original estimate of £700,000 is over £30,000,000 and General Whitlock's £12,000 portion would be over £500,000

In the British Archives is the 1862 document by Major-General Whitlock KCB giving his account of the events at Banda and Kirwee and making clear his claim on the prize money.

Major-General Sir George Cornish Whitlock is part of the WHITLOCK22 family. He was born December 3 1798 at Ottery St. Mary, Devon. He died January 30, 1868 in Exmouth, Devon only a few months after the Admiralty case was settled and payments were made of the Banda & Kirwee prize money.

His descendant Penny Mills is in the process of photographing and downloading copies of the Journal of the General's son George Frederick Tod Whitlock (1827-1900) that details the career of his father and his family.

EDWIN DONERSON MOTEN MD (1875-1955)



Following the Civil War the Quakers helped many black families during the Reconstruction period. In Denton, Texas in the mid-1870's they founded a community which became known as Quakertown. In 1878 a school was built there and many families relocated from Freeman Town to this area of Denton. In 1907 Dr. Moten married Susie Annetta Whitlock and came to live in Quakertown as the only African American Doctor. The Moten family stayed until 1919 when the family moved to Indianapolis.

Dr. Moten was born December 18, 1875 in Bastrop Co., Texas and was a graduate of Hampton University and Shaw University Leonard Medical School in North Carolina in 1907. He served as secretary to the Lone Star State Medical Association and was a second lieutenant in the Officers' Reserve Corps of the U.S. Army during World War I. The family stayed in Indianapolis and Edwin died there in 1955.

Susie Annetta Whitlock was eldest the daughter of Rev. Emanuel Whitlock and Carolyne Booker who were married Sep. 18, 1878 in Buckingham Co., Virginia.. Susie had a brother Rev. Bernard Godfrey Whitlock (1896-1949). Emanuel Whitlock was born in Campbell Co., Virginia about 1857, and was likely the son of Elias & Dolly Whitlock.

The Bayless-Selby House Museum in Denton, Texas has a collection of Dr. Moten's letters and photographs.

Edwin and Susie had three children, Annetta (1908-1986), Myrtle B. (1910-1970) & Edwin D. (1915-2001).

After Susie's death in 1938 Edwin married Josephine Bramlette (1892-1991)

My thanks to Joy Miller-Davis for contacting us and providing links to this information. I look forward to working with Joy as she traces back her Whitlock ancestry. Hopefully our files will provide additional information about their origins in Virginia.

FIEF CHOISY PURCHASED 1825 BY JOHN WHITLOCK

In 1825 the Loyalist, Capt. John Whitlock made an agreement to purchase the Fief Choisy near Montreal. The actual transaction took several years to complete. Part of the agreement involved the sale of the 120 acres of land in Lenox, Massachusetts left to him by his father in 1808. The following document is three of the thirty-one pages of documentation relating to this land transaction:

On the Tenth day of the month of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty six, in the after noon Before the Undersigned Public Notaries, duly admitted and command for the Province Lower Canada, residing at the city of Montreal, in the said Province; Personally Came and appeared George Sage Henshaw, of the city of Montreal, advocate, attorney duly appointed, by Samuel M. McKay Esquire of Pittsfield, in the State of Massachusetts one of the united States of America of the one part. And Charles Whitlock of the Parish of Vaudreuil, in the District of Montreal, Gentleman Attorney duly appointed by John Whitlock, of the same place, his father, of the other part. Which said George Sage Henshaw authorised as aforesaid has bound and obliged the said Samuel McKay to sell, dispose, and convey to the said John Whitlock the said Charles Whitlock for him present and accepting, that is to say, the Fief manor known and distinguished by Fief Choisy situate lying and being in the seigneurie of Vaudreuil in the district of Montreal, containing ten arpents in front, by all the depth of the said Seigneurie of Vaudreuil, bounded in front by Rieneri du Ontaruas?, to the Northwest one quarter west by Gabriel Constant's representatives and the Southeast by the concession of Jaques Bertrand with all its dependencies rights, emoluments, honorifices lucrative as bequeathed to the said Samuel M. McKay by Marie Louise Chartier De Lotbiniere, the sale is to be made for and in Consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Fifty pounds Halifax Currency payed as follows, that is to say, part of the said sum by the Assignment and Transfer of a certain farm situated at Lennox in the county of Berkshire in the commonwealth of Massachusetts containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less being bounded in part by a Lot occupied by the Court House in rear by a public road, joining on one side by Colonel Northrup, and on the other side by a Maured Laven, which land the said John Whitlock heretofore conveyed to one Peter Vanderburgh and being the same land wick John Whitlock late of said Lennox deceased died, seised and possessed of, and which by his last will and testament he devised to the said John Whitlock; will be valued at and after the rate of twenty three dollars per acre, for which farm or lot of Land a good clear and guaranted deed of sale & conveyance according to the forms by law required at the place where the Land is situated shall be given, The remainder will be paid as soon as the said Samuel McKay will have obtained a clear sheriffs deed of sale, by decret force or forced process which he binds and obliges himself by his said Attorney, to obtain as soon as possible and to pay the expence of such decret; The parties by their Attornies bind themselves to give such conveyances and apurances in the law, which shall be reasonably devised or advised and required, freed and discharged, of and from all incumbrances, whatsoever, and the Choisy Property clear and discharged of the Quint or other Domesical rights, which may be due to his Majesty. To have hold and take possess and enjoy the said respective properties and Estates from and after the fifteenth day of October now next ensuing, but the said John Whitlock will and is hereby forbidden, cut down or take away any part of the Timber on the said Land or fief, until such time as the said title by decret shall have been obtained, a similar conditions will be executed for the Lenox property until this transaction shall have been closed. For securing the conditions of this bond the parties have mortgaged all their constituents properties estates and premises to grant such other writings as shall deemed necessary and continue or to create such mortgage to fulfil [the] above agreement. Thus Done and passed at the city of Montreal the day and year first above written and the appearers have signed with as the said notaries these presents having been first duly read in their (Signed) Geo. S. Henshaw Charles Whitlock, P. Luken n.p. N.B. Doucet n.p. as appears on the original remaining in the subscribing notaries office. N.B. Doucet np

Captain John Whitlock was born about 1749 in Connecticut the son of John Whitlock. His mother's name is unknown as at her death in 1781 she was recorded as "Mrs. Whitlock" John was a member of the Queen's Rangers and a Loyalist. His properties were confiscated following the American Revolution and he and his family moved to Nova Scotia in 1783. They were not pleased with the quality of the land allocated in Nova Scotia (later New Brunswick) and after some years, resettled in Vaudreuil near Montreal. John married Eleanor Coley April 6, 1771 in Weston, Connecticut. Their first three children were born in Lenox, Massachusetts and the last three in Nova Scotia. His daughter Anna Whitlock born in Lenox December 12 1775 eventually returned to Massachusetts and about 1802 married Peter Vanderburgh whose family was from Dutchess Co., New York. In 1866 her brother William Coley Whitlock (1787?-1875) married her granddaughter Ann Eliza Amelia Mathison (1832?-1916) and their property in Hudson, Quebec became the Whitlock Golf and Country Club. This family is detailed on our WHITLOCK09 chart.

DR. JOHN C. WHITLOCK (1818-1886)

JOHN C. WHITLOCK, M. D., whose portrait appears in this volume, is one of the old and prominent citizens of Christian County, and is a son of John and Sarah (Ashlin) Whitlock, natives of the Old Dominion. The Whitlock family settled in Louisa County, Va., prior to the Revolutionary war, where Dr. Whitlock, his father, John Whitlock, and his grandfather, Thomas Whitlock, were all born. Sarah (Ashlin) Whitlock was a native of Patrick County, Va. The parents of Dr. Whitlock removed to Kentucky in 1830, and resided mostly in Trigg County, where Mrs. Whitlock died in 1845; Mr. Whitlock died in Christian County in 1865. Dr. Whitlock was born March 18, 1818, and came with his parents to Kentucky in 1830, when twelve years old. His education was received in the schools of Christian County, mostly at Garrettsburg; his father being but a plain farmer in moderate circumstances, was unable to give his son a collegiate education. Upon leaving school young Whitlock commenced the study of medicine with Dr. John A. Steele, a prominent physician of the time, and well known throughout the county. He attended two sessions of the medical college at Louisville, from which he graduated in 1852, and since that time has practiced his profession in this county. While Dr. Whitlock takes a lively interest in political affairs, State and National, he has never been an active politician nor an office-seeker, his public service having been confined to a term in the lower House of the State Legislature, to which position he was elected in 1846, and the duties of which he faithfully discharged. Dr. Whitlock was married, January 13, 1848, to Miss Maria F. Withrow, a daughter of James and Leittia Withrow

(nee Edgar), and who was a native of Greenbrier County, Va. They have had six children, of whom three only are living: two of these are married. Dr. Whitlock and wife are members of the Presbyterian Church; he is also an Elder in the same. Devoted to his profession, Dr. Whitlock has given to its practice and progress his best energies during a long and successful career, and is deservedly respected by his brethren of the healing art for his knowledge of the sciences, as well as by the whole community, for those fine personal traits which make him a valuable and worthy citizen. For more than fifty years his face has been familiar to the people of the county, and all may point to him, and say with truthfulness, "there is an honest man."
