

WILL OF SARAH (WALL) WHITELOCK OF SHEEPSCAR, LEEDS, YORKSHIRE 1761

In the Name of God Amen. The twentieth Day of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and Thirty Nine I Sarah Whitelock of Leeds in the County of York Widow being of Sound Disposing mind and memory praised be God for the same Do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. First I Give unto my son William Whitelock his heirs and Assigns for Ever All my Messuages Dwelling houses Mills, Land Tenements and hereditaments with their Appurtenances situate lying and being in Leeds aforesaid or within the parish of Leeds in whose possession so Ever the same are or be Chargeable with the payment of all my Debts and funerall Expenses as also paying thereout to my Daughter Mary Whitelock Four hundred pounds and to my Daughter Sarah and Deborah Whitelock three hundred pound Each which said legacyes to my said Daughters I do hereby order and appoint to be paid by my Son William Whitelock within one month next after my Decease But in Case of Faillure of payment of the said Legacyes or any of them then my will and mind is that my said Daughters or such of them whose Legacyes shall not be paid as above Directed shall and may have power to Enter upon all or any part of my Real Estate above given to my said son and the Rents and profitts thereof to Receive and take to her to their own use or uses untill payment be made of their Respective Legacyes with all Interest and costs they or any of them shall or may be put to On Occation of my said son William not paying them as above appointed All my goods and Chattles whatsoever I Give and Devise unto my said three Daughters Mary, Sarah and Deborah and Do hereby appoint them Joint Executrixes of this my last Will and Testament Revokeing and makeing void all former and Other Will or wills by me heretofore made and Executed In Testimony whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal the Day and year first above written **Sarah Whitelock** Signed Sealed published and Declared to be the Testatrix last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in presence of the Testatrix have Subscribd our names as Witnesses. Houinson. **This is a Codicil** to the last Will and Testament of me Sarah Whitelock of Leeds in the County of york Widow bearing Date the Twentieth Day of February One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty nine **Whereas** in my said Last Will I have Devised all my Messuages Dwelling houses Mills and other Real Estate in the parish of Leeds to my son William Whitelock and his heirs Chargeable with the payment of my Debts and Funeral Expenses and of certain pecuniary Legacyes to my Daughters Mary, Sarah and Deborah Now I Do hereby Revoke annul and make void so much of said Will as Relates to the Messuages or Dwellinghouse wherein I now Inhabit with the Rights Priviledges and appurtenances thereof And I Do hereby Give and Devise the same Message or Dwellinghouse with the Rights Priviledges and Appurtenances thereunto belonging unto my said Three Daughters Mary, Sarah and Deborah for their Lives and the Lives of the Survivors and Survivor of them And I Do hereby Charge and make Chargeable All the Residue and Remainder of my said Real Estate with the payment of my Debts Funeral Expenses and the Legacyes or sums of money Given by my said Will or thereby Directed to be paid to my said Daughters Respectively I Do hereby Ratify and Confirm all the Every Gifts Devises and Bequests by my said Will made or Given not hereby altered or revoked And I Do hereby order that this Codicil be annexed to and accepted and taken as part of my Last Will and Testament as fully and Effectually as if the same had been actually inserted therein **In Witness** whereof I the said Sarah Whitelock have hereunto set my hand Seal this Twenty seventh Day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and Sixty. **Sarah Whitelock her mark.** This Writing was Signed and Sealed by the First above named Sarah Whitelock and by her published and Declared as a Codicil to be annexed to her last Will and Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto Subscribed our names as Witnesses thereto in her presence.
