Another interesting quarter in which we continue to add new information to our collection. This issue concentrates on Charles Edward Whitlock (1745?-1822) an actor and theater manager (and part time dental surgeon to George & Martha Washington). Charles married into the Kemble family that dominated the theater scene in England in the late 1700's and early 1800's. Charles' father in law, Roger Kemble was instrumental in helping make the theater a legitimate occupation for women.

I want to start first with the great news I have about our new Whitlock Family Association website, that while not totally complete, is up and running. Some years after launching the second Whitlock Family Association website to replace the one in South Africa the web designer sold his business in Bellingham, Washington and the new owner was in Providence, Rhode Island. It became obvious the remoteness of the new owner and the fact we were very small compared to the rest of his clients meant we were going to have to find a new home.

As a long time member of the Guild of One Name Studies in England I was interested in their free members website program where they host member's websites. I approached them a couple of years ago but their analysis of our site showed it was larger and more elaborate than all the member sites put together. They asked that we hold off a bit while they got more experience in hosting sites. Last Fall I approached them again and they took on the task of recreating our site on their system. A few months ago I got a look at the beginnings of the site and was very pleased with the progress. The site is now up and running but there are still a couple of major things to complete. The number one task is to update the sources sections with all the items that have been received since the previous site was last updated in 2012.

The site is amazing simple consisting of a series of html pages that can be easily downloaded into my computer, updated using something like "open with Notepad" that has no formatting for the updating vehicle. The changes are made, the file is saved and then downloaded back to the website. Updates are that simple.

Lawrence Otis in Ontario and I have devised a way he can cut and paste updates into a Notepad template, email it back to me and I just cut and paste from there into the html file and download it back to the website. Lawrence has taken on the X miscellaneous sources and is already one third done. Rob Whitlock agreed to do the reference sources and I am hoping for a couple more volunteers to take on a section. This will bring the new site up to date and I can keep it updated from there.

Still to be added to the site is the ability to use Google Search that I was very sorry to lose from the previous site. This will enable us to once again search every one of the more than 1,000,000 research pages, copies of which are on file at Amazon. Even the handwritten pages provide enough information to be included in most searches. I also asked if we can change the source page numbers to the first number of the items on each page. This will make finding the item you are looking for a lot easier. There needs to be some changes made to allow this but I understand it can and will be done.

My plan is to keep both sites for awhile as mirror images of each other. Eventually the new site will be the main one.

Some of our members have actually joined the Guild of One-Name studies to keep up to date with this interesting organization and support them. Members get some interesting benefits including reduced DNA test rates and free website hosting etc.

Updating other issues, I continue work on getting census images for all the census records up to 1880/81. The British Counties are complete and I just completed Connecticut for the United States section but still need to do the transcription for 1870.

The America passport records have been very interesting and useful documents. The January 1849 record (R4233) for George W. Whitlock leaving from New York gave enough detail to enable me to connect him to the George Washington Whitlock who subsequently arrived at the gold rush in California and eventually settled in Sacramento. His birth place of Brooklyn enabled me to determine he was part of the WHITLOCK16 family and his parents were Sidney Berry Whitlock (1794-1849) and Mary Phyfe. The guarantor for George's application was Edward Phyfe.

My thanks to Martha Endres for the item (X7930) from the Museum of Dentistry in Baltimore, Maryland that held the clue that Charles Edward Whitlock the actor was also the Dr. Whitlock who was the dentist to George Washington and his family in the 1790's. See several articles in this issue connected to Charles.

I have also done an article updating our YDNA project results. A recent test result from Doug Whitlock of California that shows just how detailed YDNA variance results can be in confirming cousin relationships.

Welcome to our new subscribers and many thanks to everyone who renewed for 2017. Thanks also for the donations that many of you included - all much appreciated. We have sixty-five subscribers so far this year.

Check out the new website over the next few months as it evolves into an even better research tool than the last two.

## WILL OF CHARLES EDWARD WHITLOCK (1745?-1822) ACTOR & DENTIST

**This is the last Will** and Testament of me *Charles Edward Whitlock* Gentleman formerly of Charleston in the State of South Carolina in America but now of residing at Addlestone in the parish of Chertsey in the County of Surry I direct that all of the just debts which I shall owe at my death and also my funeral and testamentary expenses be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently may be I desire to be buried at the discretion of my beloved wife Elizabeth Whitlock and as to all my worldly estate whatsoever and wheresoever both real and personal I give devise and bequeath the same to my dear Wife Elizabeth her heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever to and for her and their own use and benefit and I nominate and appoint my said Wife Elizabeth the sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Charles Edward Whitlock have hereunto set my hand and seal the twenty ninth day of May one thousand eight hundred and twenty one *Chas Edward Whitlock (LS)* Signed sealed published and declared by the said Charles Edward Whitlock as and for this last Will and Testament in the presence of *James Wilson Addlestone H. S. Benford Addlestone John Rampley Junr Addlestone*

**Proved** at London 18<sup>th</sup> July 1822 before the Worshipful John Daubeny Doctor of Laws and Surrogate by the Oath of Elizabeth Whitlock Widow the Relict the sole Executrix to whom Admon was granted having been first sworn duly to adm'r

We have quite a bit of information about Charles Edward Whitlock but have not yet been able to determine who his parents were. His Will seems to indicate that he was from Charleston, South Carolina but The Will of his cousin Isabella Whitlock of St. Luke's Chelsea may indicate he was born in England. His burial record for January 28, 1822 in Chertsey, Surrey gives his age as 76 or born about 1745.

Charles appears to have trained as a dentist and surgeon but the Theatre was his passion.

Little is known of Charles' early life. In the 1770's he met Elizabeth Kemble, the youngest daughter of the famous London Theatre family. Elizabeth was a young girl and acting in Bath. Miss Kemble had inherited both the Kemble beauty and Kemble skill as an actor and at twenty-four she married Charles at Lancaster, Lancashire June 21, 1785. Charles was at the time manager of the Newcastle-upon-Tyne circuit and the Theatre Royal, Chester. He was about forty.

Charles and Elizabeth had at least three children, none of which survived to adulthood. In 1793 the Whitlocks were performing in Edinburgh when they were recruited by Thomas Wignell to play the Chestnut Street Theatre in Philadelphia. In February 1794 Elizabeth made her first appearance in one of her sister, Sarah Siddons favourite characters Isabella in *Isabella; or The Fatal Marriage*. At this time Charles was also practicing as a dentist when his acting commitments allowed and one of his patients in America was Martha Washington about 1793. In 1793 the word "Dentist" was new and just starting to appear in America. William Dunlap records that Mr. & Mrs. Whitlock were with Wignell in New York in Sep. 1796. There are letters from 1798 where Charles now living in Boston, was requested to make a new set of dentures for Martha Washington and had to decline due to his acting commitments and the work was given to Dr. John Greenwood, George Washington's dentist.

Charles was known for his roles as fathers both serious and tragic. He played some comedic roles but apparently not as successfully as his serious roles. An incorrect report of his death in 1799 lists him as a comedian. Again in 1804 when his son Edward died in Charleston, South Carolina at 14 Charles is known as a comedian. On April 15, 1804 Charles purchased two tracts of land on Sandy Lick Creek, Lycoming Co., Pennsylvania from Jeremiah Parker for \$1,184.33. The land was 1,182 acres (and 53 perches). In 1807 the family returned to England following the death of their son Henry E. Whitlock (1787-1806). Elizabeth's mother Sarah (Ward) Kemble also died in 1807 which was likely another reason for their return.

The Whitlocks returned to America in 1812 and by 1814 were back in England and eventually settled in Addlestone, Chertsey, Surrey where Charles died in 1822 and Elizabeth in 1836.

## WILL OF ELIZABETH (KEMBLE) WHITLOCK (1761-1836)

**This is the last Will and Testament of me *Elizabeth Whitlock* of Clapham Road, in the County of Surrey Widow** Whereas I am possessed of or entitled to a Copyhold Cottage Orchard and Garden situate at or near Addlestone in the County of Surrey and also to an annuity of one hundred and ten pounds payable by Sir Henry Mildmay for the life of the said Sir Henry Mildmay And also of another annuity of Sixty eight pounds payable by Mr. Paulet Saint John Mildmay for the life of the said Paulet Saint John Mildmay And also to seven shares in the American Philadelphia Insurance Company And also to one share in the Grand Junction Canal Company And to seven shares in the Globe Insurance Company And also to the sum of six hundred pounds Long annuities And also to divers Goods Chattels Furniture Trinkets wearing apparel and other personal Estate Now I so hereby direct all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to be paid out of the residue of my Estate hereinafter devised and bequeathed and I hereby give & bequeath unto William Loftus Lownes of Upper Bedford Place in the County of Middlesex Esquire and the Reverend William Harness of Heathcote Street in the said County of Middlesex (whom I hereby appoint my Trustees) their heirs executors admon' & assigns all my said Cottage, Garden, Orchard and premises at or near Addlestone aforesaid for all the residue of my estate and interest therein And also all the Fixtures Household and all other Goods Articles & things which shall be therein or thereupon at the time of my death Nevertheless upon the trusts and for the purposes and with the power hereinafter mentioned that is to say upon Trust that they the said William Loftus Lownes and William Harness or the survivor of them his executors administrators and assigns do and shall stand possessed thereof Upon Trust for the sole and separate use benefit of Maria Theresa Kemble (Wife fo my Brother Mr. Charles Kemble) for her natural life independant of her present of any future husband and to the interest either to permit her to occupy and enjoy the said Cottage Garden Orchard and premises or any part thereof without paying and rent for the same or at her election or request to be signified form time to time by any note or writing under her hand to demise or let the same or any part thereof for any term or any manner howsoever at the best rent that can be reasonably obtained for the same And upon further Trust in case the said premises or any part thereof shall at any time or times be devised or let as aforesaid that they the said William Lofus Lownes and William Harness and the survivor of them and the executors administrators and assigns of such survivor shall and do during the natural life of the said Maria Theresa Kemble pay the yearly rents and profits of the said Cottage and

premises unto the proper hands of the said Maria Theresa Kemble for her sole and separate use independant of her present or any future husband and not to be subject to his or their debts control contracts or engagements or to such person or persons as she by any note in writing unto her hand from time to time (but not by antisipation) shall direct the same to be paid and the receipt and receipts of the said Maria Theresa Kemble or of the person or persons to whom she shall direct the same from time to time to be paid shall at all times be a good discharge for the said rents and profits to the said Trustees and Trustee and every other person whomsoever and upon further Trust from and after the decease of the said Maria Theresa Kemble that the said William Loftus Lownes and William Harness and the survivor of them his executors administrators and assigns shall stand possessed of the said Cottage Garden Orchard and premises In Trust for such person or persons and for such estate or estates and in such manner in all respects as the said Maria Theresa Kemble by her last Will or any Codicil or testamentary paper (whether covert or sole) shall appoint and in default of such appointment In Trust to sell and dispose of the same Cottage Garden Orchard and premises and to pay or divide the money to arise by sale thereof to and amongst all and every the Children of the said Maria Theresa Kemble if more than one equally as Tenants in Common and if there shall be but one Child then to such only child Also I give and bequeath the picture of myself painted by Opie to my Brother Charles Kemble absolutely and I also give and bequeath all the wearing Apparel and Linen Trinkets Watches and Ornaments of the person of which I may die possessed to my Sister Jane Mason And as to for and concerning all the *Rest Residue and remainder* of my real and personal Estate and Effects not thereinbefore given and bequeathed (charged nevertheless with the payment of all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses) I hereby give devise and bequeath the same unto and amongst my Nieces Frances Ann Twiss Amelia Twiss and Elizabeth Twiss or such of them as shall be living at my decease their or her heirs Executors administrators and assigns according to the nature and quality of the same Estates respectively it being my will howsoever that in case two or more of my said nieces shall be living at my death that they and their respective heirs Exors and Admons shall have and be entitled to the said residue as tenants in common and not as joint tenants provided always and I hereby declare that the receipt and receipts of my said Trustees or either of them and the receipt or receipts of every new Trustee to be appointed as hereinafter mentioned shall at all times be good discharges for so much of the rents and profits or other monies to arise from the trust premises as in such receipt or receipts shall be expressed to be received And my Will further is And I do hereby declare that if my said Trustees or either of them his executors or administrators or any Trustees or Trustee for the time being of this my Will shall die demise or become incapable to act in the Trusts thereof then it shall be lawful for the Trustees or Trustee for the time being of my said Will by any writing under their or his hands or hand to appoint any other person or persons to be a Trustee or Trustees in the place of the Trustee or Trustees so dying declining or becoming incapable to act as aforesaid and that upon every such appointment the said trust estate and premises shall be forthwith assigned so as that the same may vest jointly in any new and old Trustees or solely in the new Trustee or Trustees as occasion shall require and every new Trustee and Trustees shall have and be entitled to all such powers as are hereby given to the said William Loftus Lowndes and William Harness and my Will is that my said Trustees or any new Trustee or Trustees shall not nor shall any or either of them or that any or either of their Executors or administrators be answerable for any monies which shall actually come to their or his hands by virtue of this my Will nor for any loss or damage which may happen to the said Trust estate unless the same shall happen by them or one of their wilful default nor shall any one Trustee be answerable for any monies which shall be received by nor for any act or default of any Cotrustee but each for himself and his own acts and defaults only And my will is that my said Trustees & each of them and every new Trustee to be appointed under the

power aforesaid and their respective executors and administrators shall and may out of the monies which shall come to their or his hands under the trusts aforesaid retain all such costs and expenses as they or he shall from time to time pay or incur in the execution of the said Trusts or otherwise under this my Will And lastly I hereby appoint my Nephew Horace Twiss and my said Brother Charles Kemble to be *Executors* of this my last Will & Testament *In Witness* whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of December One thousand eight hundred and thirty two *Eliz Whitlock (LS) Signed* sealed published and declared by the above named Testatrix Elizabeth Whitlock as and for her last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence at her request and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses thereto the several alterations against which our initials are placed having been previously made *R.W. Procter 25 Bedford Square London = Anne Benson Procter of the same place = Emily Monague of the same place.*

**This is a Codicil** to my Will I hereby revoke the Codicil before made thereto my Sister Jane Mason having departed this life I bequeath the property left her by my will and all other personal property of whatever kind whereof I may be possessed save as after mentioned to my Nieces Fanny Amelia and Elizabeth Twiss in the same manner as by my will provided with with respect to the bequests thereby given them And whereas since my said will was made I have become possessed of property in three and a half per Cents to the amount to one thousand three hundred pounds or thereabouts now I give to my Nephew Horace Twiss six hundred pounds of such 3 ½ per cent stocks for his own use absolutely And as to the remaining 700 such 3 ½ per Cent stock I bequeath the Dividends thereof to my Sister Ann Hatton of Park Street Swansea for her life and after her death I give the principal of such 700 stock to my Niece Jane Mason for her own use absolutely and each of the bequests of stock in Codicil contained shall bear its own proportionate expenses of transfer 18 December 1835 *Eliz Whitlock*

*In the Prerogative Court of Canterbury  
In the Goods of Elizabeth Whitlock deceased*

**Appeared Personally** *William Henry Bate* of No.7 Mortimer Street Cavendish Square in the County of Middlesex Esquire and *Louisa Maria Bate* (wife of the said William Henry Bate) and made oath that they knew and were well acquainted with the above named Elizabeth Whitlock late of Mortimer Street aforesaid Widow deceased for some time before and down to the time of her death and during such their knowledge and acquaintance with the said deceased they have frequently seen her write and write and subscribe her name to papers writing and are thereby become well acquainted with her manner and character of handwriting and subscription And the Deponents having now carefully viewed and inspected the paper writing now hereto annexed purporting to be a Codicil to the will of the said deceased the same beginning with "This is a Codicil to my Will" ending thus " and each of the bequests of stock in the Codicil contained shall bear its own proportionate expenses of transfer 18 December 1835" and thus subscribed "Eliz Whitlock" say they verily and in their consciences believe the said subscription to be of the proper handwriting subscription of the said Elizabeth Whitlock deceased *W.H. Bate - Louisa M. Bate - On the 7<sup>th</sup> March 1836* the said William Henry Bate and Louisa Maria Bate were duly sworn to the truth of this affidavit Before me *John Daubney Junr Prest Wm. Townsend Not'r Pub'c*

**Proved** at London with a Codicil 14 March 1836 before the Worshipful John Daubney Doctor of Laws & Surrogate by the Oath of Horace Twiss Esq'r Nephew and Charles Kemble Esq'r the Brother the Exor's to whom admon was granted having been sworn duly to administer.

Elizabeth (Kemble) Whitlock was born in 1761 the youngest daughter of Roger Kemble (1721-1802) and his wife Sarah Ward. Roger Kemble founded a theatre dynasty in London and most of his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren were stage actors or performers. Elizabeth's sister Sarah was the famous Mrs. Siddons the foremost actor of her day. Her niece Frances Anne Kemble the daughter of her brother Charles was both an actor and and Civil Rights author. Fanny's husband Pierce Butler was one the largest slave owners in Georgia and Fanny's books about life on a Georgia plantation in the 1830's are still in print today.

Elizabeth's career was always overshadowed by her famous sister but she spent many years in America from the 1790s and had considerable success there. She met Charles Edward Whitlock in Bath when she was a young girl and eventually married him when she was twenty-four and he was about forty. Charles managed several theatres and Elizabeth became his principle actor.

The Whitlocks returned from America for the last time in 1814 and settled in Addlestone, Surrey. Charles died there in 1822 and Elizabeth in 1836.

**In the Name of God Amen** I Isabella Whitlock Spinster of Beaufort Row in the Parish of Saint Luke Chelsea and County of Middlesex being of sound disposing Mind Memory and Understanding Praised be God for the same calling to mind the uncertainty of this mortal life so make this my last Will and Testament in manner following I resign my Soul to its Creator in all humble hope of its future happiness as in the disposal of a being infinitely good as to my body my Will is that it be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named and put into the same Grave with my dear sister in the North Isle of Chelsea Church as to my worldly possessions and Effects which it hath pleased God to bless me with after all legal debts and demands upon me being paid as also my Funeral expenses discharged by my Executors I give and bequeath to my Cousin Charles Edward Whitlock four hundred and fifty pounds four per cent Stock Consolidated Annuities and also such of my household Furniture Plate Linen and China as are not otherwise bequeathed by me also my books not otherwise bequeathed by me Also I give and bequeath to my Cousin Clementina Pattinson Wife of Mr. Chissam Pattinson of Addelston. Surry four hundred and fifty pounds four per cent Stock Consolidated Annuities also the four post bed bedstead and Furniture in the two pair of stairs fone worn and my Family pictures with the History of the Jews by Josephus also I give and bequeath to Mrs. Whitlock wife of my Cousin Charles Edward Whitlock my French Silk Gown and Coat and if she should be in London at the time of my decease to assist Mrs. Hannah Allwood in dividing my wearing Apparel to the best of their Judgement between my three Cousins equally viz my Cousin Clementina Pattinson my Cousin Hellen Spencer of Saint Edmunds Bury Suffolk and my Cousin Mary Hatchell if Mrs. Whitlock should be absent and in the Country then Mrs. Allwood to divide them herself Also I give to my Cousin Hellen Spencer fifty pounds Stock in the three per cent reduced Annuities Also I give to Mrs. Chissam Pattinson in trust Fifty pounds Stocke in the three per cent reduced Annuities for the use of my Cousin Mary Hatchell Also I give and bequeath to Mrs Martha Asby Wife of Mr. James Asby of Saint Johns Clerkenwell Glass Grinder one hundred pounds lawful money to be paid out of the three per cent reduced Annuities Also I give and bequeath to my God daughter Miss Isabella McKinley one hundred and fifty pounds Stock in the three per cent reduced Annuities together with my Gold Watch Also I give to her sister Margaret McKinley one hundred and fifty pounds Stock in the three percent reduced Annuities also I give to Mrs. Isabella Verers wife of Mr. Richard Verers Cyder Merchant at Richmond in the County of Surry Ten pounds of Stock in the three per cent deduced Annuities Also I give to Mrs. Susannah Stockman of Brompton Row Middlesex twenty pounds Stock of three per cent reduced Annuities Also I give and bequeath to my Servant Susannah Batten if she continued in my Service till my decease fifty pounds lawful money to be paid her by my Executors at the rate of five pounds a year till the fifty pounds is Paid but if a proposal of Marriage is made her by a sober discreet Person with the consent of my Executors and money is wanted to begin business then and in that case my Executors may advance the residue of the Fifty pounds that remains unpaid also such of my wearing apparel as Mrs. Whitlock and Mrs. Hannah Allwood shall judge suitable and proper for her Also I give and bequeath to Mr John Allwood of five field Row in the liberty of Westminster and County of Middlesex Gent my leasehold house I now reside in No.13 Situate in Beaufort Row Chelsea with all the fixtures such as Kitchin ranges Copper dressers and Stove Grates for the term of his and his Wifes natural life Afterwards if any of the lease should remain unexpired to go to Charles Edward Whitlock Also I give to the said John Alwood all my framed and Glazed Prints and Pictures in the fore parlour together with my large blue bound bible and Birket on the new Testament Also I give and bequeath to Hannah Allwood Wife of the above named John Allwood one hundred pounds lawful money to be paid in out of the three pr cent reduced Annuities and my will is that these my Legacies be paid by my Executors within three months after my decease and I hereby nominate and appoint the aforementioned John Allwood of Five Field Row Gent and Chissam Pattinson of Addleston Gent Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all other Will or Wills heretofore by me made and declare this to be my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have insomuch set my hand and Seal this third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two *Isabella Whitlock* (s) Signed Sealed and declared by the Testatrix as and for her last Will and Testament In the presence of us at her request and in her presence have subscribed our names as Witnesses thereto *William Kingham Thos Simpkin*

**This Will** was proved at London the nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and ninety two before the Worshipful William Baltime Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right Hon'ble Sir William Wynne Knight also Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the Oaths of John Allwood and Chissam by mistake in the Will called Chissam Pattinson the Executors named in the said Will to whom admon was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and credits of the said deceased having been first sworn duly to administer. Despite the fact Isabella mentions several cousins in her Will, we have not yet been able to determine which family she connects to. The most well known of her cousins is Charles Edward Whitlock who is the subject of a separate article in this issue of the Newsletter. Actor, dentist and married to Elizabeth Kemble a member of the London Theatrical Dynasty the Kemble family and sister to Sarah Kemble known as Mrs. Siddons. Charles was living in Addlestone, Parish of Chertsey, Surrey when he made his Will May 29,1821. His Will only mentions his wife.

There is cousin Clementina Whitlock who married Chisam Pattinson January 11,1773 at St.George's Hanover Square. In 1792 they lived in Addlestone, Chertsey, Surrey.

Another Cousin mentioned is Hellen Whitlock who is likely the Hellen Whitlock who married Maehin Spencer July 20,1770 at Bodney, Norfolk.

Cousin Mary Whitlock married Delmas Hassell Sep.12,1782 also at St.George's Hanover Square. She shows as Mary Hatchell in the Will.

## EDWARD F. WHITLOCK (1931-2017) MARATHON RUNNER

Ed Whitlock came to my attention in 2001 when at age 70 the press started to notice he was breaking some interesting records. He already held 21 Canadian masters records when he broke the world record for over 65 running a marathon at 69 in less than three hours (2:52:50). Over the next sixteen years Ed continued breaking records.

He was a shy man and really never understood the interest the press continued to give him. He ran most days in the cemetery near his home in Milton, Ontario. He liked that people drove slower in cemeteries. Over the years he found running a bit of a chore but liked winning and breaking records so kept at it.

Ed became a member of the Canadian Masters Athletic Association for athletes over 40. He used his computer to track his running performance and compared it to the Association charts. As expected he noticed over the years that his performance was declining but also that it was doing so at a much slower pace than the charts indicated he should expect. Ed allowed intrigued physiologists to conduct tests on him and at 81 was told his physical condition was that of a man in his mid twenties. The measurement of how efficiently he used oxygen showed a VO2 reading of 54 which was unheard of for an octogenarian.

Ed did not think of himself as a role model. He was just doing what he enjoyed. The fact that he threw out every textbook theory on the effects of aging was not his concern. Ed ran his last race in December 2016 in London when he ran in a cross-country race he had participated in as boy growing up in South London. He died March 13, 2017 a week after his 86<sup>th</sup> birthday in a Toronto hospital of prostate cancer.

Ed was part of our WHITLOCK77 family, The Whitlocks of Northamptonshire. He was born March 6, 1931 in London the son of Frederick Horace Whitlock (1893-1976) and his wife Kitty. His grandparents were George Whitlock and Elizabeth Fielder who were married at St.John's Chelsea December 16,1883. George's father Henry Whitlock was from Silverstone, Northamptonshire and with his wife Mary Ann Legg had made the move to London in the 1850's.

Ed grew-up in London and was a competitive cross-country runner in his teens becoming a member of the Walton Athletic Club. He attended the Royal School of Mines at Imperial College and graduated in 1952. Ed opted to take a job for a mining company in Sudbury, Ontario following graduation rather than enter National Service in England. He married Brenda and raised two sons Neil and Clive born in the 1960's. In his forties Ed supported his son Clive's goal to run a marathon and 1975 both completed the 26 mile course in 3 hours 9 minutes. Ed went on to win the World Masters 1500m in 1979. Following his retirement in the 1990's Ed went back to running again.

## DNA UPDATE

Our DNA project continues to grow and new YDNA and Family Finder results are coming in steadily. One of the theories with YDNA is that if you share a variance from the established base for a particular family then you are most likely more closely related to those with the same variance than to the others you share the same YDNA with. The recent YDNA results for Doug Whitlock of California illustrated this theory.

There are now twenty two members who share YDNA with the WHITLOCK02H family, the Whitlocks of Wokingham, Berkshire who descend from John Whitloke and Agnes de la Beche who were married about 1454. The paper research shows these members belong to several different branches of this family. W02H, W23, W25, W33, W84 & W87.

With Doug's results there are now four members who share a variance in marker 449. The base is 29 and all four show 30 for this marker. These four members are also the only four members tested so far that are part of the W25 family. (Unfortunately one of the four was a member of the original Sorenson DNA project and is not named but shows as a member of this family.) The other three all descend from three different sons of Charles Whitlock (1739-1814) and his wife Esther. This indicates the variance in marker 449 likely occurred with Charles as we have at least one other descendant of his father James Whitlock (1710's-1749) and his wife Agness Christmas who does not show this variance. We will need further tests to verify this but I think this is a particularly good indicator of how YDNA tests and variances can be used to pinpoint which part of a particular family a male descendant is likely connected to.
