TAKE NOTICE.

Vermont Statutes, Title 17, Chapter 130.

Sec. 2632.—Marriages may be solemnized by a justice, in the County for which he is appointed, or by a minister of the gospel, ordained according to the usage of his denomination, and who resides in this State or labors stably in the State as a minister of the gospel or missionary. Marriages among the Friends or Quakers may be solemnized in the manner heretofore used in such societies.

Sec. 2633.—Persons authorized by the preceding section to solemnize marriage, shall require of the parties, before solemnizing such marriage, a *certificate* issued from the office of the clerk of the town where the groom resides, or, if the groom is not a resident of the State, from the office of the clerk of the town where the bride resides, or, if she is not a resident of the State, from the office of the clerk of the town where the marriage is solemnized; and the certificate so required shall afford full immunity from all responsibility on the part of a person authorized to solemnize marriage who performs the marriage ceremony between the parties therein named.

Sec. 2637.—A town clerk shall not issue a marriage certificate to a minor, without the consent in writing of the parent or guardian of such minor, if there is one competent to act; nor when either of the parties to the intended marriage is insane or under guardianship, without the written consent of the guardian; nor in case of a town pauper, without the written consent of the selectmen or overseer of the poor of each of the towns where the parties reside, or which are liable for their support.

Sec. 2638.—The person solemnizing a marriage shall receive the certificate from the parties, *fill any blanks remaining therein*, add the date of marriage and his *official* signature, and *return the certificate* to the clerk's office from which it issued within *ten* days from the date of the marriage. If he fails so to do he shall be fined not less than ten dollars.

Sec. 2639.—A person who solemnizes a marriage, without first obtaining of the parties, the *certificate* required by law, shall be fined not less than ten dollars.

Sec. 2641.—If a person undertakes to join others in marriage knowing that he is not authorized so to do, he shall be imprisoned not more than six months or fined not more than three hundred dollars, and not less than one hundred dollars.
