Hester Whitlock, a widow aged about 60 and her brother Henry West somewhat advanced in years who is, by some, reputed a papist but saith that tho' he formerly went sometimes to a popish chapel he has not done it for 7 years long past nor ever shall again.

These persons are poor labouring people, were born and have resided the greatest part of their lives in this parish. Returns for 1780 and 1783 make no mention of any Catholics at Box, but Hester Whitlock was still alive at the former date. She died in Dec 1781 d
