I enclose more information about my descent from George W(ashington) WHITLOCK. I didn't include others in my generation, i.e. grandchildren of Mary Louise WHITLOCK dau of George W. WHITLOCK but can supply them with ^{some} names dates etc as well as further descendants if you want them.

And of course I'll be glad to forward copies of any Whit(e)lock(e)s material as I receive it. Your letter says "copies of any WHIT(B)LOCK(E) entires..." Is this a typo or do you mean 'entires'? If the latter would you please explain what you mean by an 'entire'? I presume it would be 'complete' but as I haven't encountered it so far in a genealogical context I am not sure.
