20036 says "unfortunately, although the name is Bennett, I am not part
of the Illinois Whitlock line.

My family is originally from Virginia and the name was
spelled WHITLOCKE. My particular line moved to South Carolina from
Virginia and the "e" was dropped from the name during the Revolutionary
War to distinguish it from the English family of the same name. Sincerely,
Bennett C. Whitlock, Jr." dated March 29, 1979 on his firm's letter head.
