Many thanks for the copy letter etc. I believe that the William Whitlock that married Sarah Hutchings is my ancestor even though the marriage took ~~place~~ place 7 days after the baptism of their eldest son Thomas (see Langtree August 5, 1810). It could be that the vicar at Langtree did not know that they were not married? Anyway see what you think. Until another set of candidates are uncovered I must assume that these are the two I am after. You already hold the death cert for Sarah and I would think that it is the same William Whitlock that married Catherine Scriggins in 1839.

Any luck with the Mormon records regarding William Whitlock's baptism ? circa 1787.

I may write to your correspondent re the Sarah Hutchings' birth and family. He may have something if he has studied The Peteres Marland registers.

I saw in the Bideford and North Devon Gazette last week that a man called Coligny John Wallace Whitlock died aged 77 years. He was living with his sister Catherine in Aylesbury in Buckinghamshire. I have some details about him from the Somerset house records.

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Perhaps he may be some relation to Mrs Coehoe. His sisters address is 7 Parsons Fee, Aylesbury, Bucks. (no married name given). He left a widow and 2 daughters.

I was rather surprised when I saw mine in there as it was only meant as covering note when I sent for society publications. I did ask them to print a query about William and Sarah but they havent printed that yet.
