Also in my notes was the marriage of Thomas Whitlock to Rebecca Holman at Langtree on 3 April 1778, witness John Whitlock. I think this Thomas baptised 1755.

**WHITLOCKE [or WHITELOCKE], BULSTROD** 1616-20; b. 16.8.1605 in Fleet Street at the house of Sir George Croke, his mother's uncle; s. of Sir James (O.M.T.; barr.-at-law) and Elizabeth née Bulstrode; St. John's Coll. Oxf.; barr.-at-law, Middle Temple 1626; M.P. Stafford 1626, Marlow 1640; member of Council of State of Republic; Serjt.-at-Law 1648; Keeper of the Great Seal; d. 28.1.1676 at Chilton Park, Wilts. See D.N.B.

**WHITELOCKE [or WHITLOCKE], EDMUND** -1581; b. 10.2.1564/5; bapt. at St. Gabriel's, Fenchurch Street; s. of Richard (merchant) and Joan née Colte, of St. Dunstan's East; Ch. Coll. Camb. 1581; B.A. 1584/5; adm. Linc. Inn 1585; toured abroad; returned to England 1598; courtier at Queen Elizabeth's court; imprisoned for one night at The Tower and The Fleet for supposed complicity in the Gunpowder Plot; d. 1608 at Newhall, Essex, while visiting the Earl of Sussex.
