I understand that you met my Brother-in-law Harold Whitlock and late Sister-in-law, May when you were in England doing research of your own and I wonder whether you might be able to assist me?

I am only interested in the direct male line of my late wife's forebears and the information I have to date is as follows:-

- HER FATHER: CHARLES ROBERT OCTAVIUS WHITLOCK  
BORN REHUSH TOWN LONDON 23.2.1874
- " GRAND FATHER: OCTAVIUS WHITLOCK.  
BORN TURNHAM GREEN, LONDON 23.5.1840
- " GREAT GRAND FATHER HENRY WHITLOCK  
MARRIED GEORGINA OR ANGEZINA HERR  
AT ST. BRIDES, FLEET ST, LONDON 2.5.1829

Presumably Henry was born about 1786 as his age is given as 77 on the headstone of the family grave at Brompton Cemetery, <sup>WEST</sup> London. Date of death 10.3.1863.

At this point my leads seem to have

come to an end. Have you any information  
please on this particular Whitlock line  
that might assist me in determining the  
actual date of Henry's birth, his  
parent's names and if possible details  
of his grandparents. This is as far  
back as I felt I should be able to reach,  
though it seems a distinct possibility  
I may be disappointed.

Should you be able to help, I would  
be most grateful and trust you will  
not feel at all presumptuous on my part  
in writing to you on this matter.
