Dear Peter;

Thanks for your letter of October 3rd. I'll try to answer all of your questions, in the order you listed them.

1) I am enclosing a copy of the Granville county N. C. will of George Whitlock, d. 1774.

2) Re: William Whitlock, ca. 1740-1818, and Mildred Gentry. There were two such couples, believe it or not! 1st was my William, Sr. and his wife Mildred, daughter of Nicholas Gentry. The 2nd Mildred Gentry was the daughter of David Gentry, brother of the 1st Mildred, and Elizabeth Whitlock, sister of the 1st William. Pair No. 2 were married 6-23-1783, while the first William and Mildred were married circa 1767. Incidentally, Elizabeth is the one mentioned in the will of Thomas Whitlock, dated March 20, 1776, listed on page 17 of my book, as his sister "Elizabeth Gentry", and her husband David Gentry was a witness to the will. In other words, the 1st Mildred Gentry was the aunt of the 2nd Mildred Gentry. I do not know where the 2nd William came from. But cousins did marry a lot in those days. *(Achilles had a son Wth.)*

3) John^W Whitlock (1818-1899) was born in Augusta county. I can not find the place in my book where I incorrectly said he was born in Louisa county. Let me know what page it is on, so I can correct it.

4) Re: The inventory of James Whitlock, 1757. You are correct and I have made corrections. (Revised page enclosed)

5) Ethel Whitlock, daughter of John Copins Whitlock and Sarah Alexander, never married.

I am enclosing some more revised pages, including my hand drawn map, to be inserted in their place. I am, also, enclosing a copy of a letter of mine to Lucy W. Atkins, which, I believe, is self explanatory. I'm still working on this John of King William county, to see if there is a connection.

Which leads to my next question. In your Main Lines file ML5, revised 5/28/1985, as shown in your June '85 News Letter, you list a John Whitlock 1625-1708, m. to Mary Stone 1683. Do you have any other information on him? Such as where he was born? Buried? Children?

Thanks again, Peter, for your help and for keeping in touch. I need that help!!
