Thank you for your letter of July 1, 1993 with its enclosures which I found very interesting. Do you know if anyone has done any digging in the records to establish the connection between John Whitlock of Salem who neglected the watch in June of 1643 and Robert whom your records show was born in 1747?

My sister-in-law has put all of our information concerning the descendants of Jeremiah W. and Matilda Bracket on her computer and promises to get at it next Thursday. I have also asked her to try to get a photocopy of the family record in the family bible in my cousin's possession that I think may date back to Jeremiah's time. When obtained, I will forward that to you. When I get the lock box unlocked, I will send you copies of some of the more interesting letters containing family history (as it had been related to them) from the 1850's through the 1870's from Jeremiah, Matilda and their unmarried son and daughter, Abel Stanwick and Dorliska Frances Cecilia in New York, to their son and brother, Friend Jared ("the Judge") in Minnesota; the Judge's only daughter, also Dorliska, likewise did not marry.
