My Whitlock information to date is only one marriage. I discovered this just before I sent my 'interests' into the Cheshire FHS quite expecting by the time it was printed I should know much more. Unfortunately I have made no further visits to the Record Office to follow it up. The detail I have is as follows:

Potterspury P.R.

1807 15 Oct. marriage : George Irons = Hannah Whitlock

George was buried at Towcester aged 72 years on the 20 February 1853 having been run down by a horse and gig.

Hannah was also buried at Towcester on the 29 December 1851 aged 79


I do hope that I shall be visiting the Record Office again in 1994 and when I discover any further Whitlock details I will most certainly let you know. 1772
