Dear Mr. Whitlock:

It is time for us to exchange information again. I recently received a letter from an English correspondent (whom I have helped with research in US) named Carol Hutchison, which contained a large packet of your information, including your new address which I did not have. You can note my new address which you did not have as the county changed it for us a couple of years ago. Mrs. Hutchison is not a WHITLOCK descendant; she put the query in for me. I was interested to note that on the printout you sent her, which she enclosed, you have some new correspondents on WHITLOCK. You will want to take her off.

I note that you still have not found the parents of Hannah. I have not either, but I have had research information from England that it was not Bulstrode Whitlock and his wife. In today's mail came an interesting clue from another WHITLOCK researcher--Clifford J. Choquette, 12 Longmeadow Road, Chelmsford, MA 01824-2026. He had an inquiry in The Nugmegger, which I answered, about a Rose Whitlock who married Abraham Parker--you can find her in Torrey. He enclosed a letter from the Hertfordshire County record office indicating that a Rose Whitlock, daughter of Thomas, was baptised at Wheathamstead on 6 June 1624. In my analysis of LDS data on WHITLOCK, I found a Thomas Whitlock who m. a Margerie Barker in Bucks in 1613 and the researcher who eliminated Bulstrode for Hannah found connections with Tring, which is just across the border in Hertfordshire from the area

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of Bucks where Aylesbury, Amersham, Chesham, High Wycombe, etc are located. Perhaps we should look for Hannah in Hertfordshire, and perhaps that is where the family went after Rose was born as the letter from Hertfordshire says no more baptisms were found. The letter did say that this Thomas' wife may have been Joan since a Joan, wife of Thomas Whitlock, was buried 5 March 1636, Wheathampstead and that a marriage record at Harpenden in 1614 between Thomas Whitlocke and Joan Boyer might have been theirs. They also found a burial record of a Thomas Whitlock at Wheathampstead of 10 Jan 1638 and another on 24 Sep 1685. The letter from this record office is addressed to Ms Jeanne Weber, 24 Tunstall Road, Scarsdale, NY 10583 so you might want to contact this person, as well as Mr. Choquette.

I hope these additional bits of information will be helpful and that you will keep me informed if you find out any more about Hannah.
