I fear I have not been very active on the Whitlock line lately -hoping for a break through from either the 1851 or 1881 census. However, in checking my Whitlock file I am not sure I replied to your letter of 24 February 1992.

In case I did not the St Mary's Islington James Whitlock event on 25/12/1834 was a marriage. You are correct - taken from index so no wife's details. Same applies to All Saints Poplar Wm Jas Whitlock on 10/9/1837. The St John Hackney entries were births.

I also have a couple of 1851 census index L&NMFHS references I might not have sent

St Giles 1509 468v William Whitlock aged 41
St Giles 1507 397 Harriet " " 55

I noted the 1775 at KH Yorks, but as you have advised all we know about Henry

is that he :- m. Mary Ann Tagg Ady 24-5-1801 at St Luke Old St, London [both signed]; shoemaker; of 2 Bow Lane Bromley, Poplar, Mdx. [Wife's death certificate 12-4-1851 thus d > 1851.]

However Mary Ann Tagg was born in c.1775 (age given on D Cert - I must try for Hy's D cert) it is likely he was b 1770-5. Thus either the Yorks or Herts Hy could be right.

You last wrote on 7 April last year. Glad you liked the wills. By the way have you a list of Whitlock births from STC? If you have I would like a copy on a 3.5 disc if you could manage. I will reimburse you.
