Dear Mr. Whitlock,

Please forgive me for taking so long to answer your letter concerning my query on the WHITLOCK family. I placed several queries on various family lines about the same time and was overwhelmed with the response. I unfortunately got behind with my correspondence.

I really do not have much information on my WHITLOCK line. My great-great-great Grandmother was SARAH WHITLOCK who according to census records was born circa 1802 in Virginia. On March 23, 1823 she married THOMAS JEFFERSON HOODENPYLE of North Carolina. I do not know in which state they were married. Sarah died in Sequatchie County, Tennessee February 12, 1857 and is buried in an old camp grounds burial plot. Her oldest son, Phillip, is buried next to her.

An older relative told me that Sarah Whitlock's father was JOHN WHITLOCK of southern Virginia. Since it appears that Sarah and her husband, Thomas, followed the custom of naming the first son after the paternal grandfather and the second son after the maternal grandfather John Whitlock must have been her father. I have found a Whitlock family in the area from which she was said to have come but as yet have been unable to connect my Sarah to them.
