 It seems that Thomas (husband of Mary Facer) died according to Blisworth
 Burial Records on 16th June 1811 with Thomas their son being born 5th Apl
 1812 baptised 13th July 1812 (according to the Baptism records). This would
 account for Mary Facer living with Thomas in the census records of 1851 when
 Mary was 68 and listed as a fund holder. This Thomas who married Prudence
 Palmer was by then a Baptist and not C of E. These records concur with those
 of Audrey Fader who has gone via the Baptist route!!
