

MISCELLANEOUS COLEMAN INFORMATION

ROBERT COLEMAN left will in 1748, Caroline Co., VA. Son SPILLSBY COLEMAN is executor. His parents were ROBERT COLEMAN (will 1713) and ANN SPILLSBY of Essex Co., VA. (*VA Geneologist*)

ROBERT COLEMAN was summoned for nonpayment of taxes. Isle of Wight, VA Court 23 November 1693. (*VA Geneologist*)

A Commision o the peace for Essex Co., VA, dated 30 June 1705 from Francis Nicholson, Esq to Lieutenant & Governor Genl. of VA. ROBERT COLEMAN was listed, along with others, as a justice. He was also listed 16 May 1706.

ROBERT COLEMAN was granted land patent for 1500 acres December 2, 1723. (I failed to write down the County). I'll get it.
