Whitlock, brother of William, and he died in 1852. My James is not among them. In 1830, William has a son 15-20 and one that is 20-30. Both John and William were in Illinois in 1830 and Luther is listed in a separate household as is Ira. Thomas would be one them (probably the 15-20) so my James might be the other. He was still in Kentucky in 1834 (as was Ira) when William died in Illinois which may explain why he wasn't listed on the will. On the other hand, he may have still been in Kentucky and not listed on the will because he wasn't a son of William's. Do you know much about Woodson Whitlock's family origins. I also can't place the Robert who was in Russell co KY in the mid 1830s either. I'm still going through the Illinois material and some from Adair co KY. If I get a breakthrough, I will surely let you know
