parents were Thomas and Rebecca ?RADFORD WHITLOCK, she married William  
Chapman MCDONIEL/MCDONALD 14 Oct 1805 in Louisa CO., VA. Chapman and Polly  
lived in Franklin Co., TN then moved to Independence Co.,AR about 1850  
Chapman died there in 1856 but don't know when or where Polly died. She was  
not mentioned in his will in 1856 so she must have already been dead then.  
Just thought that you might run into her sometime a wonder where she went.  
Chapman & Polly's children were born in VA,NC back in VA, TN the last may  
have been in SC in 1825. Then their grandchildren were born in TN, IL, MO,  
AR and they may have been moved with these sons before settling in AR. So
