He might be the James Whitlock who was the overseer for the plantation owned by John Christmas in the Fishing Creek District in Granville County, North Carolina in 1762.

He probably is also the James Whitlock who is a taxpayer in Rowan County in 1761 along with a Joseph and Mark Whitlock.

He is again listed in Rowan County in 1772 where he is listed as a taxable with one negroe.

He is listed as the executor of his father-in-law, Samuel Jones, last will and testament in 1775.

He refused or neglected to take the Oath of Allegiance to the State in 1778.

Rowan County, North Carolina land grants

His son is probably the James Whitlock who received State Grant #1596 on August 9, 1787 @ 50 shillings per 100 acres for 320 acres on Dutchman's Creek adjoining John Beeman.

His wife is listed as a taxpayer in Rowan County, North Carolina in 1782 which means he probably died before then.

His wife might be Sylvia Whitlock who as "Silvas" Whitlock received State Grant #1562 on August 9, 1787 @ 50 shillings per 100 acres for 300 acres adjoining James Whitlock, William Holmar, William Cook and John Gwaltney.

On March 13, 1790 a John Whitlock sold 320 acres to a John Beekman. Henry Johnston was the witness.

On February 6, 1784 "Letters of Administration on the Estate of James Whitlock, issue to Sylvia Whitlock, who qualified & gave Security Isaac Enochs - in the Sum of 1000." Book 10 page 417.
