My great grand father Benny had a brother named Walt, their father's name was Tyre (not sure on exact spelling), my grand father couldn't recall his grandmother's name, he just always called her granny, so if you could figure out who Tyre Whitlock married that would be great. The only other Whitlock name he could come up with was his dad's cousin William.

I got some more information on my grandfather's siblings, Betty Whitlock married Joe Moor and had one daughter, but Benny jr. never married. Betty died a while back, but Benny is still doing well. I'm going to see if I can talk to him about the family and see what he remembers.

Out of curiosity today I looked in the Marietta phone book to see just how many Whitlocks were listed and there were a lot more than I thought! Who knew! There were almost 2 1/2 columns. We live on Whitlock rd, it was named for my grandparents when they built their first house just down the street about 50 years ago. I asked my grandfather if he knew who they named Whitlock avenue for in down town Marietta, but he wasn't sure.

Any information you could give me about Georgia Whitlocks would be great. I decided that my last name, Jones, was a little to complex to research. There are probably millions of Jones families all over the United States. After I learn more about the Whitlock's I'm moving on to my Grandmother's maiden name Teague.
