Peter,

Before I begin, let me tell you where the documentation for the following information came from. From William Jones and Mary Whitlock down to William Bluford Jones, my information was derived from a book written and published by a Jones descendant. His name was Thomas Eugene Jones of Fountain Inn, SC and was published in 1956.

The information therein came from family records, memories, bible records and other sources. As with all family histories there is always a margin for human error. However, part of my total information came from records kept by my grandmother, my great aunt and my mother.

In Mr. Jones book, there is a great deal more information than is needed for this particular transmission. I am only going to send you my direct lineage as I know it to be true.

William Jones b. 1735 in Wales or England
married Mary Whitlock cir. 1760

They had 6 children, 4 sons and 2 daughters.

My lineage begins with their son John Jones.

John Jones b. July 28, 1777. Married Frances Brown b. Feb. 13, 1781. Both born in Virginia and later moved to upper SC and settled in the Durbin Creek area of Greenville County. Together they had 11 children. John Jones was killed by his slave, Peter, Feb. 26, 1844. John was buried in the old Jones cemetery on Durbin Creek. His father William is also buried there.

William Bluford Jones (son of John and Frances) b. Nov. 27, 1813. He married twice, first to Elizabeth Garrett. They had four children. John W., Amanda, James Madison, and Frances. Second wife, Mary League.

James Madison Jones (son of William Bluford) b. Dec. 21, 1840, d. July 24, 1874. Married Susan Owins on March 24, 1858.

Dock L. Jones (son of James Madison Jones) b. Mar. 3, 1860, d. Sept. 30, 1938. Married Corrie White b. Oct. 3, 1857, d. June 8, 1933

Reid A. Jones (son of Dock L. Jones) b. Feb. 27, 1887, d. April 18, 1947.

Married Kathryn Lucy Montgomery, daughter of John Myrick Montgomery and Martha Caroline Bramlett. Reid and Kate Jones had 2 sons and 2 daughters. Joe B. Jones, Reid A. Jones, Jr., Catherine Louise, Helen.

Catherine Louise Jones (daughter of Reid A. Jones) b. May 13, 1913, d. Feb. 2, 1979 (my mother) Married William Loyce Ivey

Kathryn Patricia Ivey (Frieler) living. Married Robert F. Frieler, living

Kathryn Louise Frieler Elmore, living

Christopher Graham Elmore, living

Whitney Brooke Elmore, living

As I said in the beginning, part of my information came from the book by Mr. Jones. However, other family records, obituaries and court documents have all contributed to my total knowledge.

I did not include all of the children of each descendant. I have them and will gladly send them but was not sure if you wanted all of it.
