Hi Peter--

I don't remember the message to Dale Johnson, but, yes, there has been an error in the past concerning G. W. 's wife. I had always believed it was Nancy Clements based on information from a distant cousin, Jenna Charles (you have been in contact with her before I believe; she actually got a stone for G.W.'s unmarked grave and had some kind of ceremony through the Daughters of the Confederacy). I was actually about to order a copy of Austin Clements' will (Nancy Clements' father).

Then about a month ago I received a copy of Joanna Davis Whitlock McAvoy's (my grgrandmother's) application to the Guion Miller Roll of 1906-9 (for benefits as a Cherokee) from the NARA. She lists her mother as Sarah Ann Whitlock (who never married; Joanna and her sister Nancy had their mother's last name) and Sarah's mother is listed as Nancy Barnes. This would've been G. W.'s wife. This information is repeated on an application reprinted in a volume of the set Cherokee By Blood, by Nancy Henderson, a descendant of Andrew Jackson Whitlock, brother to Sarah, son of G.W. In this application Nancy Barnes' sibilings are listed as Jim, Allen and Sarah (or Sally). Both applications only list matrilineal ancestry (as the Cherokees kept track of their family lines). Both applications say Milberry's mother was full blooded Cherokee.

Nancy Barnes' mother is listed as Millery or Milberry Tall(e)y, 1/2 Cherokee. I am working on the Talley line, and it looks like Milberry was the daughter of Prior and Elizabeth nee Henson Talley. Elizabeth Henson's mother was Betsy Walkingstick. I have yet to verify the relationship between Milberry and these Talleys. She is the correct age for an unnamed child in the household and there are no other Tallys in the area (Habersham County, GA) with a daughter that age. Also, these Talleys have documented Cherokee blood in the mother (Elizabeth--correct generation). In 1830 the Tallys and G.W. Whitlock are both listed in Habersham. I am also looking for any record of a Barnes/Talley marriage, no luck so far. This would've been before 1820. Well, I probably told you more than you wanted to know. I didn't think of notifying you of the news, sorry. Glad someone else is paying attention. Thanks again for all your input,
