Thank you so much for all the information which you have so generously shared with us. My husband is really enjoying looking thru it. I have not as yet had a chance to check it all out. I am an accountant and this is a busy time of year. All the family Bibles went to my husband's sister, but I have copies of the info. However, after nearly twenty-five years of geneology research, I am learning that the info in the Bibles is not always correct. The family Bible showed Felix Gaines Whitlock as being married to Mary E. Kirk daughter of George Kirk. Their children were listed as Johnnie, Samuel, Willie A. married to Jane, Frank, Delilah married to Walter Moorhead, Belle married to Samuel Davis Gondelock, and Ella.

In the past I have found a William Moorhead in the 1790, 1800, 1810 Census of Union County, SC. I have also pulled up the Moorheads at the LDS Family History Center and pulled the line from William moorhead, born in the Atlantic, etc., going back through John Moorhead, 1730 in Monagham, Ireland and his mother as Elizabeth Dunn, (1730, Monagham, Ireland). Then William Moorehad (1694) married to Eleanor Cathy Monagam. Then another John (1668).

Although I have been doing geneology for sometime, it has only been in recent months that I have been using the internet for geneology, so I am trying to get my records in order so that I can share over the net. I will be very happy to share what research I have done, etc., as quickly as I can get it handled. And if it is of use, I will be glad to share with others.

Again, thank you, thank you. I will study what you have and see if I can follow up on the leads you have given me.
