Peter,

Thanks for updating our branch. Unfortunately we do not have any of the wedding presents of James S. Whitlock. We were so glad to find as much information in him as we did, considering he died so young. Still trying to find out if the widow re-married.

Also trying to make a connection with Hannah Whitlock. Some of the dates seem to be real close with the first John. Per LDS, she was born in Cholesbury, Bucks, England around 1613, but died in Milford, New Haven, CT on 4/25/1661. She married Joseph Baldwin (born in England 1609-1612???) 11/1/1636 in Milford, CT. He died in Hadley, MASS on 11/2/1684, wonder if he remarried. There was a daughter, Mary Baldwin, born 6/23/1644 in Milford, CT and died on 4/9/1704 in Deerfield, MASS (a very well known historic town in New England) I've seen two possible birth dates for John Whitlock, 1585 (doesn't seem right) and 1611. Wonder if it's possible they could be brother and sister, particularly since there was a Hannah Whitlock the next generation, which would have been a niece.

Do you have any research in this area?

I'm trying a couple of other things. (1) just exactly who was Grace Burr related to? the infamous Aaron Burr?? (2) Still trying to find a connection between the Whitlock name and Scottish clan of Dalzeil. So far, nothing. But I have seen in several books of tartans that the name Whitlock can wear the Dalzeil tartan. Another curiosity.

Re snow: we've had our first this past weekend. 7-9 inches, but melted within two days. Ground is still too warm. Soon!!
