Hi, Thank you for your interesting information. Here is the obituary of Miles McCutcheon which appeared in the Albion Recorder newspaper, and was reprinted in the Friday April 1, 1887 issue of the Marshall Statesman (Michigan) newspaper, page. 1:

"Miles McCutcheon, an old and well known resident of South Albion, died at his home, near Faulkton, Faulk County, Dakota, of congestion of the liver. The deceased was born near Ithaca, Tompkins County, NY June 21, 1830. He was married to Harriet Dodge at Ethna N.Y. February 6, 1856. Soon afer his marriage he moved to Albion. In the fall of 1858 he settled on the farm that was his home for twenty-six years. In the early part of the winter of 1878 the home circle was broken by the death of the wife and mother. In the spring of 1884 he was married to Lucy Whitlock, of Ithaca, N.Y. Soon after his second marriage he removed to the west where he has a live a little less than three years. He leaves a wife, one son, and four daughters to mourn his loss.

FYI, the Robertson family which was also from Dryden, NY will be having their 100th family reunion this coming June, 2002 here in Albion.
