Dear Peter

Thanks for your email. I have had a little more time to have a look through your site and at the Whitlock file you suggested.

Interestingly most of the names (and I have a lot) do not appear on there. In fact I have only found the odd reference. Because I did this research some time ago when I had more time, it was also before I had a computer, so all my work is written and not in any computerized format. It would take me some considerable time to put all the info I have onto my computer so I may only be able to send you 'snippets' at any one time!

I live less than a mile from the Northamptonshire Records Office and that is where I got my info from. So I have record numbers and the books that they appeared in i.e. Baptisms, Burials, Marriages etc. I also live only a few miles from Silverstone so I have given St. Michaels graveyard a good 'going over' too!

The easiest thing for me to do when confronted with so many Whitlocks and being informed that there were two major families in the same village, was to make a note of all the Whitlocks I came across, because I thought it would soon become apparent which ones were mine - WRONG!

Anyway here is my first snippet .....

Buried in St Michaels Churchyard at Silverstone - Northamptonshire are my great grandparents William WHITLOCK (died 12.12.1943 - 65yrs) & Sarah Elizabeth (died 05.01.1938 - 61yrs). I am not sure what Sarah's maiden name was. They do not appear to have married in the village but she may have been a DUNKERLEY.

Frances Lily was my grandmother. Whilst I am happy with all the girls and I am happy with Harold and Thomas William I am not so happy about some of the

other males, they were all born to Sarah Elizabeth and William - but were they the same Sarah Elizabeth & William? Time period is about right and as we know a lot of children died in infancy and their names were reused. My great grandmother would have been about 20 yrs old in 1897 so she could well have produced one child after another. So I am still seeking confirmation. I have baptism dates but not birth dates.

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Having found records for so many WHITLOCKS I have arranged a lot of them in Christian name order so I have 11 Johns's, 15 Thomas's & 13 Williams etc, all living at around the same time.

Finally I ought to mention that most of my research was for the 1800's and early 1900's, I never did go back any further because I wanted to sort out my correct lineage first. So I would really like to know what my great grandmothers maiden name was. Where my great grandparents were married and what their parents were named.

Hopefully I shall be able to help you with some of your queries.
