The Whitlock/Fleet connection would probably have to do with this line:

John S. Frank, b. 1799, VA, married Annette Margaret Woods July 20, 1826, Jefferson Co., TN.

John S. Frank THEN married CATHERINE WHITLOCK, in 1860.

I DO know that Margaret Frank, born 1845 (daughter of John S. Frank & Annette Margaret Woods) WAS somehow the aunt of ALICE FLEET, born 1861. (Laclede County, MO. area - around Smith TWSP/or Osage area. Since ALICE FLEET was born in 1861, this leads me to believe of the possibility of Alice Fleet being kinned to the Whitlock line, since John S. Frank married Catherine Whitlock before the birth of Alice.

I've been unable to find a Fleet/Frank connection, so therefore I'm looking at the line of Catherine Whitlock/Fleet connection.
