Thanks for your e-mail. The information you have provided has been very helpful in confirming my grandmother's siblings details. As they were all baptized in Silverstone I have presumed that is where they were all born - but you never know!

Clearly the next thing for me to do is to establish the maiden name of my great grandmother and the name of my great grandfather's father then the fog may clear (or not as the case may be!).

The middle name of Hayle has proved interesting. Years ago I made a note of a marriage between two Hayles families (1904) purely because it was witnessed by an Adelaide WHITLOCK. I have also come across the baptism of a Lizzie Hayle WHITLOCK in 1904 - the daughter of a Sarah Ann WHITLOCK - no father's name given.

I've not actually come across William Hayle before - just plain old William and if he was born in 1878 (he died on 12.12.1943 aged 65 yrs) he might be the son of a Thomas and Mary - this is pure speculation (& hope) on my part as I only have one William born in 1878 (no mention of Hayle though).
