Children: John C., Sarah Hopper, Florabel Fuller, Lavinia P., Edmund H. and Mary Jane, born between 1876 and 1891. The family is listed in the 1880 and 1900 censuses of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. If you'd like, I can send you a GEDCOM file with more information on this family.
