I've discovered that William and Margie Whitlock had more children. I've had a postcard from my grandmother to a Zada Whitlock and I never could figure out who she was and then a few months ago I was looking in an old address book of my mother's and came across a G. Stick and a Becky Wilson. I remembered visiting with an Ann and Becky who were my Dad's aunt in Galesburg, IL in the late 60's or early 70's. I figured that all of these women were my grandfather's sisters, but it took me a while to figure it out. I then found a Kentucky Death Record for a Zada Whitlock in Clark County on Feb. 23, 1970 at age 63. And in the SSDI there is a death of Nancy Stick (she was called Ann), who was born on April 27, 1910, and died in Galesburg, IL in Nov. 1984. Rebecca Wilson was born Oct. 22, 1914 and died Jan. 1987 in Winchester, Clark, Kentucky. Ann and Becky were widows when I met them and I imagine after Ann died Becky left Galesburg and went back to Kentucky and died there.

I have just made a copy of the Kentucky 1920 Census and it shows William Whitlock, head of household age 65, Marjorie (spelled incorrectly), wife, age 44, Ida, daughter, 17; Anna M., daughter, 15; Zada, daughter, 13; Nancy J., daughter, 11; William (there is either an initial or Jr. there, I can't read it), son, 7; Rebecca M., daughter, 5; and Edward M., son, 12.
